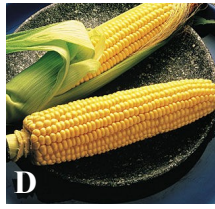
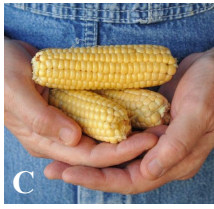
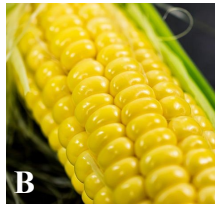

Katahdin – *Late season*. Excellent storage. Drought tolerant. Large round shape, shallow eyes, smooth buff skin, bright white flesh. Good boiling variety. **\$1.80 / lb.**

Kennebec – *Midseason*. Very reliable and productive. Good storage. Oblong shape, shallow eyes, smooth buff skin, white flesh. Good for baking and creaming. **\$1.80 / lb.**

Red Pontiac – *Midseason to late*. Oblong to round shape, medium deep eyes, dark red, smooth skin, white flesh. Good for baking. **\$1.80 / lb.**

Yukon Gold – *Early to midseason*. Excellent storage. Very reliable and productive. Oval shape, shallow eyes, yellow skin, creamy yellow flesh. All-purpose potato, especially good for creaming and baking. **\$1.80 / lb.**

Day-neutral varieties:

- **AAS Candy F1** – 85 days. A breakthrough in onions and our most popular onion plant! Plant early for a big onion with a sweet and mild flavor. Golden brown outer skin with thick white rings inside. Planted later, they are still milder than regular yellow onions. Excellent storage quality.

Blackberry	‘Chester’ – hardy thornless blackberry. Firm fruit does not leak or fade in sunny weather. Resistant to cane blight. Ripens mid-August.
Blueberry	‘Blueberry Glaze’ - deep blue, almost black, fruit with the flavor like a wild blueberry. Ripens in July. Great for containers. ‘Bluecrop’ – hardy & productive plants. Large bright blue berries in July. ‘Blueray’ – largest berry on the market! Ripens in July. ‘Perpetua’ - produces in mid summer and again in fall. Mild and sweet blue berries. ‘Bluegold’ - Compact plant habit perfect to use in large pots. Great for baking or fresh. Ripens all at once in June. ‘Jelly Bean’ - great for containers. Medium to large sweet berries ripen late July. ‘Peach Sorbet’ - tastes like a combination of a homemade peach cobbler with traditional, sweet blueberries. Suitable for large pots. 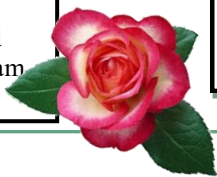
