**Blackberry** 'Baby Cakes' - dwarf thornless blackberry. Classic large, sweet berries in summer and fall.  
'Chester' - hardy thornless blackberry. Firm fruit does not leak or fade in sunny weather.  
Resistant to cane blight. Ripens mid-August.

**Blueberry** 'Berrybux' - wild and aromatic tasting berries. Boxwood-like foliage.  
'Bluecrop' - hardy & productive plants. Large bright blue berries in July.  
'Blueray' - largest berry on the market! Ripens in July.  
'Jelly Bean' - great for containers. Medium to large sweet berries ripen late July.  
'Midnight Cascade' - abundant summer crop of blueberries. Foliage has hints of red.  
'Peach Sorbet' - tastes like a combination of a homemade peach cobbler with traditional, sweet blueberries. Suitable for large pots. Unique fall foliage. Ripens mid-July.  
'Perpetua' - produces in mid summer and again in fall. Mild and sweet blue berries.

**Currant** *Self-pollinating, thornless shrubs bearing tart abundant berries, used for jams and jelly.*  
'Consort' - medium size black berries with black berry flavor.  
NEW! 'Pink Champagne' - flavorful translucent berries. Great for cooking and preserves, as well as fresh eating.  
'Red Lake' - large, juicy, tart berries. Very high in Vitamin C.

**Elderberry** *Large shrub or small tree. The berries when cooked make jelly and syrup and can be used for health benefits. Varieties available: 'Adams' and 'John'*

**Gooseberry** 'Hinnomaki Red' - large red fruit with outstanding flavor. Favorite of home gardeners.  
'Pixwell' - hardy, medium-to-small pale green fruit becomes pink when ripe. Few thorns.

**Grape** 'Concord Seedless' - smaller than regular Concord, slightly sweeter.  
NEW! 'Fredonia' - the best of black grapes! Large fruit is early to ripen. Has seeds.  
'Himrod' - yellow-fruited, early seedless grape with fine quality.

**Black Raspberry** 'Jewell' - early, large, glossy berries; vigorous & productive.  
'Ohio's Treasure' - Everbearing! Medium sized berries in early summer and fall.

**Golden Raspberry** 'Fall Gold' - sweet, self-fertile. Produces two crops each season.

**Red Raspberry** 'Heritage' - vigorous, ever bearing. Large firm berries in July & September.  
'Encore' - late season, summer bearing & productive. Nearly spineless fruit.  
'Raspberry Shortcake' - dwarf, thornless. Perfect for containers.

**Rhubarb Plants** 'Crimson Red' - rich red large stalks. Flavor is sweet with a pleasing tartness.  
'Green Victoria' - thick green upright stalks with zingy flavor. Hardy, heavy producer.




