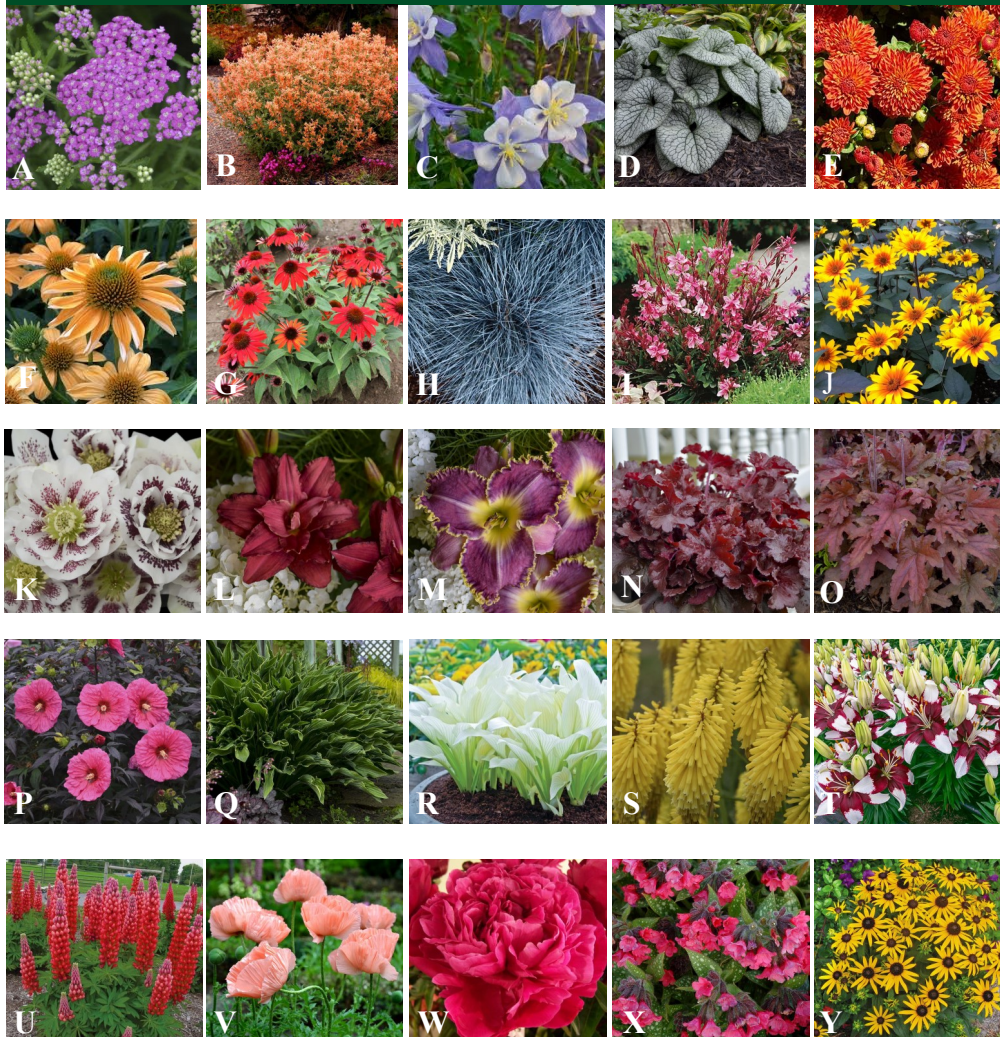

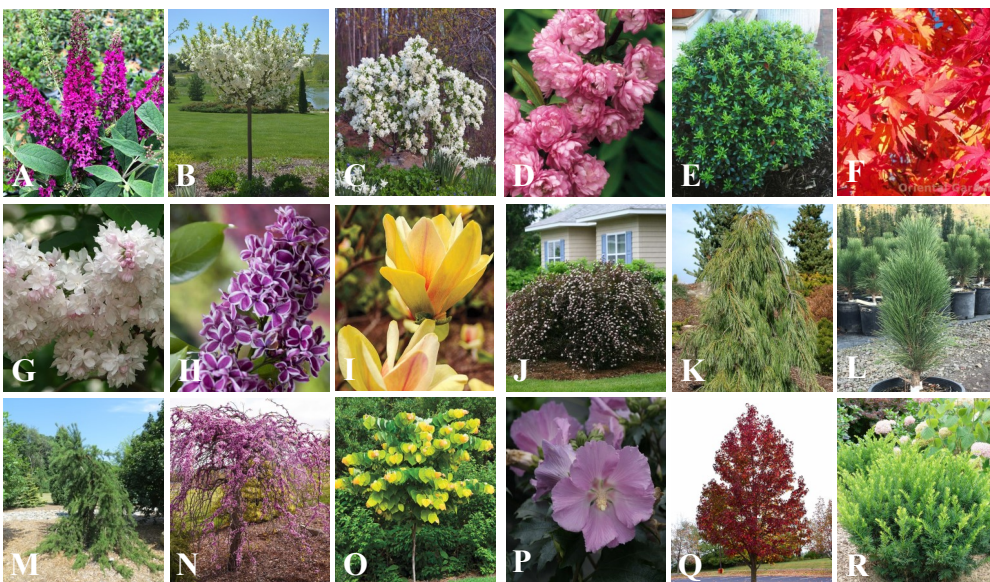

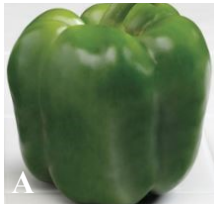

Kennebec – Midseason. Very reliable and productive. Good storage. Oblong shape, shallow eyes, smooth buff skin, white flesh. Good for baking and creaming. **\$1.50 / lb.**

Red Pontiac – Midseason to late. Oblong to round shape, medium deep eyes, dark red, smooth skin, white flesh. Good for baking. **\$1.50 / lb.**

Blackberry	‘Chester’ – hardy thornless blackberry. Firm fruit does not leak or fade in sunny weather. Resistant to cane blight. Ripens mid-August.
Blueberry	‘Blueberry Glaze’ - deep blue, almost black, fruit with the flavor like a wild blueberry. Ripens in July. Great for containers. ‘Bluecrop’ – hardy & productive plants. Large bright blue berries in July. ‘Blueray’ – largest berry on the market! Ripens in July. ‘Perpetua’ - produces in mid summer and again in fall. Mild and sweet blue berries. ‘Bluegold’ - Compact plant habit perfect to use in large pots. Great for baking or fresh. Ripens all at once in June. ‘Jelly Bean’ - great for containers.
