Hosta 'Barbara Anne'

- <u>Use:</u> Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage. Hostas also grow well in city environments where the air may be polluted by car exhaust, etc. A sport of H. sieboldiana 'Elegans'
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Will grow 18-20" tall and spreads up to 20-24" wide. Vigorous, large grower.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Forms a stunning clump of thick, corrugated, blue-green leaves with a broad, cream margin that lightens to white
- **Flower:** Near-white flowers appear on 24" scapes in midsummer
