Characteristics

Genus & Species: Diascia hybrida.

Protection Status: EU Plant Breeders Right 10,170. **USDA Zone:** USDA Zone 9. (20°F or -6°C).

Bloom: Large sterile soft apricot flowers, giving masses of flowers over an extended season.

Bloom Period: Long blooming period. Early spring—fall.

Foliage: Small fresh green foliage.

Habit: Compact rounded habit. 10" x 12".

Propagation: Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.

Additional Comments: Excellent cool season crops. Trim when young to encourage strong basal branching. Trim back &

feed to encourage strong re-blooming.
