## 40 Loads of Farm Produce at 12.30 pm

Ten loads less on offer this week and a serious shortage of straw. Only five loads of big bale straw this week. The lowest entry for many months saw prices rising to the dizzy heights of £92 per tonne for a mixed load of round and square bale barley with other barley straw £68 to £78 per tonne. A single load of round bale wheat straw, marked, made £40 per tonne.

Four loads of small bale barley straw were on offer making £92 to £120 per tonne, a 10-mile mileage restriction making a £10 to £20 per tonne difference in price.

Big and small bale hay sold at late rates with best quality small bale hay up to £158 per tonne and best big bale hay up to £80 per tonne. Only one load out of fifteen failed to make vendor's expectations.

There is still plenty of haylage about, sixteen loads, but obviously still wanted with turnout still some weeks off. Best quality made £56 to £68 per tonne, most loads in the £40's with only three loads less than £40 per tonne today.

A wonderful sight to see the Sheep-shed full to overflowing (and into the Calf shed and outside!), and even more to preside over such a lively trade from start to finish.

Starting with the Annual Show of Easter Lambs, we saw female dominance this year, as Claire Tomlinson took 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prizes in all 3 Classes, judged by quality producer Ron Eyre from Hathersage, Sheffield.

A full report is attached, but suffice to say Claire's Champion Lamb at 41.1kg, made a record price of 500P/KG (£205), being bought by C Webb & Sons, Butchers, for Mrs. Cunningham, The Swettenham Arms Inn and Restaurant, Swettenham, Congleton (which I happen to know, from personal experience, also stocks an excellent range of local ales!).

Terrific trade on all New Season Lambs saw them average 309p/kg (see full report)- but it was a cracking day for all the Old Season producers as well, with 49 pens making over 200p/kg; 16 pens over 220p/kg; to a top of 245p/kg, twice, for Roger and Simon Bailey's Texel/Beltex Crosses. As well as the Bailey's, Messrs Robinson, Booth, Brough and Sidebottom all saw their best pens over 220p/kg.
