Benara Nurseries is accredited to the Australian Plant Production Standard (APPLS), the overarching framework for the Australian nursery industry's Best Management Practice programs. APPLS includes on-farm systems for production nurseries, growing media manufacturers, and greenlife markets, emphasizing compliance in Plant Protection, Biosecurity, Environmental, and Natural Resource Management.

To be an accredited production nursery under APPLS, adherence to the Australian Plant Production Standards Best Practice Guidelines is essential. These guidelines, crafted over years by industry experts, outline the 'Best Management Practices' encompassing technical and managerial requirements.

THE STANDARD

Benara Nurseries grows trees to meet the Australian standard AS-2303 Tree stock for landscape use. The goal of the standard is to help set a baseline to which trees can be quality assured.

WHAT WE DO

Adhering to national tree standards entails evaluating essential factors that determine tree quality. At Benara Nurseries, we take pride in cultivating trees that meet these standards and specifications for each tree in our production.

THE ADVANTAGES

Incorporating national tree standards into our tree production ensures the acquisition of top-quality trees at the time of purchase.
