



**Abelia grandiflora 'Francis Mason'**  
*Glossy Abelia* (Code: 4070)  
 Bright golden-yellow-green foliage along red stems brings a sophisticated edge to the garden. Fragrant light pink flowers bloom late spring to fall. (5' x 5') Zn6.



**Achillea 'Brass Buttons'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 5338)  
 Fresh green, ferny foliage forms a low mat. Small cream-colored buds open to golden-yellow flowers in the spring. Although delicate-looking, it is tough and durable. (3" x 12") Zn4.



**Achillea 'King Edward'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 2014)  
 Cream-hued flowers grace this lovely, tufting, evergreen rock garden plant. A wonderful choice for the dry garden site. Requires good drainage. (4-6" x 10") Zn5.



**Achillea 'Moonshine'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 2010)  
 Clusters of sulfur-yellow flowers top soft gray foliage most of the summer. This wonderful evergreen selection is a long time favorite with designers. (24" x 16") Zn4.



**Achillea 'Walter Funcke'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 7483)  
 Brick-red flowers gradually fade to numerous lighter shades of orange-red. Silvery, drought tolerant foliage is the perfect foil for the long blooming flowers. (24" x 24") Zn3.



**Achillea millefolium 'Appleblossom'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 5113)  
 Bright lilac-pink flowers fade to pastel pink on this long-blooming and easy to grow garden favorite. It makes an excellent cut flower. (2' x 2') Zn3.



**Achillea millefolium 'Fireland'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 6423)  
 Drought tolerant perennial featuring orange-red flowers with prominent golden centers. The flowers fade to salmon pink, then tawny gold, creating a fiery effect. (20" x 24") Zn3.



**Achillea millefolium 'Lilac Beauty'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 4565)  
 Lovely lilac pink flowers appear all summer. The flowers become lighter as they age, creating a multicolored effect that is very pleasing to the eye. It's perfect for the middle of the border. (18-24" x 18-24") Zn3.



**Achillea millefolium 'Oertel's Rose'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 6795)  
 Bright orchid-pink blossoms slowly fade to nearly white. Hardy, drought tolerant and easy to grow. Showy all summer! (28" x 24") Zn3.



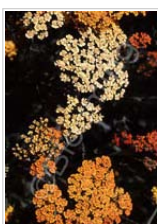
**Achillea millefolium 'Paprika'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 2021)  
 Clusters of bright scarlet flowers with yellow centers fade beautifully to salmon-rose. Drought tolerant, easy to grow and good for bouquets. Long-blooming when deadheaded. (18-24" x 18-24") Zn3.



**Achillea millefolium 'Salmon Beauty'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 2024)  
 Large, flat clusters of tiny blooms open in hues of deep salmon which brighten to soft pink. This drought tolerant and easy to grow selection also makes a great cut flower! (24-30" x 18-30") Zn3.



**Achillea millefolium 'Summerwine'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 4871)  
 Stunning wine-red flowers glow over feathery green foliage in early summer. It's perfect for sunny locations. (24-28" x 24") Zn3.



**Achillea millefolium 'Terra Cotta'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 6146)  
 Masses of dark salmon flowers mature to russet hues; the color of red clay! The fine feathery foliage is evergreen, easy to grow, and drought tolerant. (24-30" x 24-30") Zn3.



**Achillea ptarmica 'Angel's Breath'**  
*Yarrow* (Code: 2025)  
 Masses of 1/2" wide, pure white, double flowers appear in early summer and fade to ivory. The deep green, "ferny" foliage is extremely drought tolerant. (16" x 24") Zn4.





**Achillea tomentosa 'Lemon'** (aka 'Lemon Yellow Form')  
*Yarrow* (Code: 2020)  
 Lovely lemon yellow flowers are set off by ferny, evergreen foliage. Excellent in rock gardens or as a groundcover. (3-4" x 16") Zn4.



**Aconitum henryi 'Spark's Variety'**  
*Monkshood* (Code: 5233)  
 Tall and dramatic dark purple-blue spikes have deeply-cut leaves. Makes an impact in the mixed border. Does not require staking. Stunning late-season color for partly shaded areas of the border. (3-5' x 2') Zn4.



**Aconitum paniculatum 'Roseum'**  
*Monkshood* (Code: 4809)  
 Elegant spikes of palest pink hooded flowers climb tall stalks. Bright green, glossy foliage adds handsome contrast. Excellent late summer bloomer for cut arrangements. (36" x 24") Zn4.



**Aconitum septentrionale 'Ivorine'**  
*Monkshood* (Code: 5818)  
 Lovely spires of ivory flowers on a bushy 2-3' plant. Does best in moist soil with some shade during the hottest parts of the day. (4-5" x 20") Zn5.



**Acorus gramineus 'Oborozuki'**  
*Striped Sweet Flag* (Code: 4326)  
 Grassy evergreen leaves with bright yellow stripes glimmer in the landscape. A graceful choice for moist soil or water's edge. (12" x 12") Zn6.



**Acorus gramineus 'Ogon'**  
*Sweet Flag* (Code: 4254)  
 The tufting, golden, evergreen foliage makes a striking border or accent plant. It even tolerates standing water. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (12" x 12") Zn6.



**Agastache 'Blue Fortune'**  
*Anise Hyssop* (Code: 6204)  
 Long lasting, deep lilac-blue flower spikes top fragrant foliage. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! One of the hardiest and dependable Agastache. (30" x 24") Zn6.



**Agastache aurantiaca 'Apricot Sunrise'**  
*Anise Hyssop* (Code: 2009)  
 Delicate spikes of orange sherbert-colored flowers top shrubby gray-green foliage. Excellent for attracting butterflies and hummingbirds, and perfect for the middle of the mixed border! (24-30" x 12-18") Zn6.



**Agastache aurantiaca 'Navajo Sunset'**  
*Anise Hyssop* (Code: 3257)  
 Citrus-scented foliage and bright orange-red tubular flowers bloom in summer. A hummingbird magnet. (12-18" x 12-18") Zn6.



**Agastache barberi 'Firebird'**  
*Anise Hyssop* (Code: 4730)  
 Rosy sunset-coral flowers dazzle summer to frost, above aromatic foliage. Hummingbirds adore this stunning plant. Excellent for cutting and requires good drainage. (30" x 18") Zn6.



**Agastache barberi 'Tutti Frutti'**  
*Anise Hyssop* (Code: 6777)  
 One of the showiest varieties of agastache. Masses of deep pink flowers on tall stalks make a vivid backdrop. Has a wonderful fruity aroma! (36-48" x 18") Zn6.



**Agastache foeniculum 'Golden Jubilee'**  
*Anise Hyssop* (Code: 2678)  
 New foliage emerges gold, then turns bright lime-green. Lavender-blue flowers make this a standout in the garden. Leaves release a mint scent when lightly crushed. (20" x 15") Zn5.



**Agastache mexicana 'Sangria'**  
*Anise Hyssop* (Code: 4051)  
 From July to October clusters of arching, red-purple blooms appear whorled around stems, one stacked on top of another. It grows up to 4' tall with lemon-scented foliage. A favorite of hummingbirds. (4' x 2-3') Zn7.



**Agastache mexicana Acapulco 'Orange'**  
*Anise Hyssop* (Code: 3848)  
 Vibrant orange, tubular flowers add incredible color all summer to mixed containers and landscape plantings. A favorite of hummingbirds. (24-30" x 18") Zn7. PP16308 Propagation Prohibited.



**Agastache mexicana Acapulco 'Salmon & Pink'**  
*Anise Hyssop* (Code: 3849)  
 Stunning multi-colored pink and salmon-hued flowers bloom all summer and are wonderful for landscape use and in mixed containers. A favorite of hummingbirds. (24-30" x 18") Zn7. PP16023 Propagation Prohibited.



**Agastache rupestris**  
*Anise Hyssop* (Code: 7361)  
 Beautiful salmon orange flowers with lavender purple calyxes last from late summer until frost! Fine gray-green, licorice-scented foliage adds interest. It thrives in a hot spot with good drainage. (18-24" x 18") Zn5.





**Ajuga 'Chocolate Chip'**  
*Bugleweed* (Code: 4468)  
 Bright blue flower spikes top miniature chocolate colored foliage in spring. This marvelously-dense, vigorous, spreading groundcover is excellent in containers or rock gardens. (3" x 18") Zn4.



**Ajuga reptans 'Black Scallop'**  
*Bugleweed* (Code: 3940)  
 Very attractive jet-black scalloped leaves are covered with deep violet-blue flower spikes in spring. The foliage color intensifies in cold and full sun. (3-6" x 30-36") Zn3. PP15815 Propagation Prohibited.



**Ajuga reptans 'Burgundy Glow'**  
*Bugleweed* (Code: 2032)  
 In spring, blue flower spikes rise above a colorful low mat of burgundy-rose, white and green-variegated foliage. An eye-catching selection! (6" x 24") Zn6.



**Ajuga reptans 'Catlin's Giant'**  
*Bugleweed* (Code: 5166)  
 Unusual large-growing Ajuga with dramatic thick foliage and tall blue flower spikes. The leaves grow even larger with rich soil. It's stunning planted en masse, as border edging, or over bulbs. (9" x 36") Zn3.



**Allium schoenoprasum**  
*Chives* (Code: 8050)  
 A mild onion flavor makes this herb a favorite for topping baked potatoes and other savory dishes. Edible pale purple flowers appear in summer. (12-24" x 30-36") Zn3.



**Allium schoenoprasum 'Forescate'**  
*Chives* (Code: 4231)  
 This low-growing form has lovely blue-green blades and pretty ball-like clusters of rosy-pink flowers. Used both in the garden for ornamental flowers, and in the kitchen for flavoring food. Performs well in containers also. Deer resistant. (4-10" x 12") Zn3.



**Allium senescens 'Glaucum'**  
*Ornamental Onion* (Code: 5084)  
 Soft lavender-pink, ball-shaped flowers top interesting curly blue foliage. Lovely and long-blooming, it is great for rock gardens. (6" x 12") Zn3.



**Allium tuberosum**  
*Garlic Chives* (Code: 8060)  
 A mild onion & garlic flavor enhances this herb's versatility. Flattened grassy foliage is topped with attractive edible white flowers. (18" x 12") Zn3.



**Aloysia triphylla**  
*Lemon Verbena* (Code: 8090)  
 Green leaves have a wonderfully crisp lemon flavor and fragrance. It can be used for cooking, teas, potpourri, and topiary. Protect it from freezing over winter. (28" x 24") Zn8.



**Anacyclus depressus 'Silver Kisses'**  
*Mt. Atlas Daisy* (Code: 2076)  
 Gray, filigreed leaves form a prostrate mat. Pretty white daisies with maroon reverse sides appear in abundance May to August. An excellent groundcover or rockery specimen. (4" x 8-10") Zn6.



**Anemone hupehensis 'Prince Henry'**  
*Japanese Anemone* (Code: 2089)  
 Charming semi-double, rose-red flowers on wiry stems adorn this old-fashioned garden favorite. It adds a bright touch of color to the fall garden. (24" x 18") Zn5.



**Anemone tomentosa 'Robustissima'**  
*Grape Leaf Anemone* (Code: 2097)  
 Soft-pink flowers 3" across bloom profusely on long stems in late summer and fall. This robust grower is the hardest fall-blooming anemone. (3-4' x 3') Zn4.



**Anemone x hybrida 'Alba'**  
*Japanese Anemone* (Code: 2094)  
 This pristine Japanese anemone boasts single, slightly cupped, white flowers atop tall, wiry-stemmed sprays. (3-5' x 2') Zn4.



**Anemone x hybrida 'Bodnant Burgundy'**  
*Japanese Anemone* (Code: 7502)  
 Rose-burgundy flowers shine in late summer and fall. The individual blooms have numerous narrow petals surrounding a yellow center. (3-4' x 3') Zn5.




**Anemone x hybrida 'Honorine Jobert'**
*Japanese Anemone* (Code: 5804)

Sparkling single white flowers dance atop very long stems in fall. A beautiful perennial, perfect for cutting, it adds a bright touch to the late-season garden. (4' x 3') Zn6.


**Anemone x hybrida 'Kriemhilde'**
*Japanese Anemone* (Code: 5803)

Pink, semi-double flowers dazzle in the late season garden. It also makes a gorgeous cut flower bouquet and the foliage provides excellent fall color. (48" x 24") Zn5.


**Anemone x hybrida 'Lady Gilmore'**
*Japanese Anemone* (Code: 7002)

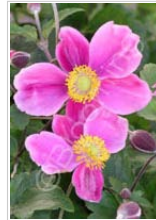
An outstanding cultivar renowned for its large 4" semi-double, rosy-pink blossoms. This fall bloomer brings loads of color to the garden. (30-36" x 2-4") Zn5.


**Anemone x hybrida 'Margarete'**
*Japanese Anemone* (Code: 2087)

Deep purple-pink, double flowers have showy yellow stamens and bloom in fall. The stalks can reach 2-3' tall. (24-36" x 24-30") Zn5.


**Anemone x hybrida 'Pamina'**
*Japanese Anemone* (Code: 2088)

Deep rose-colored, semi-double flowers rise above elegant foliage in late summer and fall. Excellent for cut flowers and easy to grow. (24-36" x 24") Zn5.


**Anemone x hybrida 'Praecox'**
*Windflower* (Code: 7335)

This early blooming, deep pink windflower produces masses of blossoms throughout fall. It prefers part shade and moist conditions, but can tolerate full sun if there is ample moisture. (3' x 3') Zn5.


**Anethum graveolens**
*Dill* (Code: 8330)

Aromatic leaves and seeds are used in pickles, vinegars, sauces, salads and seafood recipes. Large, flattened umbels of yellow flowers appear midsummer. Butterflies love it. Annual. (3-4' x 1') Zn10.


**Aquilegia 'Biedermeier'**
*Columbine* (Code: 2118)

Compact grower with spurred flowers in a bright mix of colors including carmine, lilac, blue, pink and cream. A great spring bloomer for front of the border or rock garden. (8-12" x 12") Zn4.


**Aquilegia 'Winky Purple-White'**
*Columbine* (Code: 4715)

Short-spurred, upward facing, purple sepals with white petals appear in spring. It may rebloom if spent flowers are removed. (18-24" x 18-24") Zn4.


**Aquilegia alpina**
*Alpine Columbine* (Code: 2128)

Sturdy deep azure-blue flowers grace this tight dignified plant. A wonderful, delicate accent for the border, rockery, or woodland. (18-24" x 20") Zn5.


**Aquilegia canadensis 'Little Lanterns'**
*Columbine* (Code: 4234)

This dwarf columbine has flowers with long bright red spurs and yellow corollas. Adored by hummingbirds, it is a native cultivar of the eastern U.S. (8" x 8") Zn3.


**Aquilegia chrysantha 'Yellow Queen'**
*Columbine* (Code: 2129)

Masses of fragrant, long-spurred, sunny-yellow flowers adorn ferny foliage. This heavy bloomer is an excellent choice for dappled shade. It prefers well-drained soil. (2-3' x 2') Zn3.


**Aquilegia flabellata 'Blue Angel'**
*Columbine* (Code: 6909)

Bright violet-blue flowers with sparkling-white centers grace this compact charmer. A wonderful early spring bloomer for containers or the rockery. (10" x 12") Zn3.


**Aquilegia skinnerii 'Tequila Sunrise'**
*Columbine* (Code: 7447)

Orange and yellow, long-spurred blossoms make a wild and wonderful garden display late spring through summer. (18-28" x 12-18") Zn5.


**Aquilegia vulgaris 'Clementine Blue'**
*Columbine* (Code: 4053)

This compact form has double, spurless, blue flowers in late spring. The divided, blue-green leaves resemble clover. A Fleuroselect Winner. (12-18" x 12") Zn3.


**Aquilegia vulgaris 'Clementine Dark Purple'**
*Columbine* (Code: 4713)

Upward-facing dark purple, double, spurless flowers resemble clematis and bloom from late spring to early summer. Compact form. (12-18" x 12-18") Zn4.




**Aquilegia vulgaris 'Clementine Red'**
*Columbine* (Code: 4060)

Compact form with double, spurless, fuchsia-red flowers in late spring. Divided, blue-green leaves resemble clover. A Fleuroselect Winner. (12-18" x 15") Zn3.


**Aquilegia vulgaris 'Clementine Salmon Rose'**
*Columbine* (Code: 4061)

Compact form with double, spurless, salmon-rose flowers in late spring and early summer. Divided, blue-green leaves resemble clover. A Fleuroselect Winner. (12-18" x 12-18") Zn3.


**Aquilegia vulgaris 'Clementine White'**
*Columbine* (Code: 4064)

Compact form with double, spurless, white flowers in late spring and early summer. Divided blue-green leaves resemble clover. A Fleuroselect Winner. (12-18" x 12-18") Zn3.


**Aquilegia vulgaris 'Leprechaun Gold'**
*Columbine* (Code: 3737)

Striking gold and green marbled foliage brightens the perennial border all season. Beautiful granny bonnet violet-purple flowers appear in spring. A "must have" for any garden. (24" x 18") Zn4.


**Aquilegia vulgaris 'Nora Barlow'**
*Granny's Bonnets Columbine* (Code: 5089)

Unique perennial with fully double flowers that resemble small Dahlias. Reddish-pink sepals with white and green margins make a charming display in late spring. (18-24" x 16-24") Zn3.


**Aquilegia vulgaris 'Ruby Port'**
*Columbine* (Code: 5780)

Gorgeous, double, dark ruby-red flowers top long stems that are perfect for bouquets. A wonderful perennial accent for shaded woodland gardens. (36" x 18") Zn3.


**Aquilegia vulgaris 'Winky Blue-White'**
*Columbine* (Code: 4714)

Flowers are short-spurred, upward facing, and have violet-blue sepals with white petals in spring. It may rebloom if spent flowers are removed. (18-24" x 18-24") Zn4.


**Aquilegia vulgaris 'Winky Double Dark Blue-White'**
*Columbine* (Code: 4892)

Double violet-blue flowers with white tips are short-spurred and upward facing. It blooms in spring and will repeat bloom if spent flowers are removed. (18-24" x 18-24") Zn4.


**Arabis caucasica 'Pixie Cream'**
*Rock Cress* (Code: 4067)

Creamy-yellow flowers with bright yellow eyes cover velvety gray-green foliage in spring. This rock garden plant prefers well-drained soil, and moderate temperatures. (3-4" x 12") Zn3.


**Arabis caucasica 'Snowcap'**
*Rock Cress* (Code: 2140)

This low-growing perennial is great for rock gardens or cascading over walls. Beautiful pure white flowers sparkle in spring. (4" x 12") Zn3.


**Arabis caucasica 'Variegata'**
*Rock Cress* (Code: 5356)

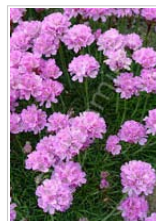
Striking emerald and cream, felted evergreen leaves are topped with pure white flowers in spring. The late season foliage is very attractive. A collector's plant. (8" x 24") Zn3.


**Arabis ferdinandi-coburgi 'Old Gold'**
*Rock Cress* (Code: 5720)

This vigorous low spreader has great evergreen leaves with wide chartreuse margins. White flowers appear in May. (4" x 18") Zn4.


**Arabis x arendsii 'La Fraicheur'**
*Rock Cress* (Code: 4069)

Rose-pink flowers cover gray-green foliage in April. This rock garden plant prefers well-drained soil and moderate temperatures. (3-4" x 12") Zn3.


**Armeria 'Victor Reiter'**
*Sea Thrift* (Code: 5090)

This small, tufting Armeria resembles a dwarf Dianthus. A profusion of tiny pink ball-shaped flowers bloom for a long time over grassy evergreen leaves. (3-5" x 12") Zn4.


**Armeria maritima 'Dusseldorf'**
*Sea Thrift* (Code: 2151)

Deep rose-pink, global flowers grace this compact evergreen perennial from spring into summer and again in fall. Perfect for the alpine or rock garden. (6-8" x 12") Zn4.


**Armeria maritima 'Rubrifolia'**
*Sea Thrift* (Code: 2938)

Grassy burgundy foliage forms a tight evergreen clump, topped by numerous rose-pink clusters of flowers from spring into summer. (6" x 9") Zn4.





**Artemisia 'Huntington'**  
*Wormwood* (Code: 2157)  
 Silvery gray, finely-cut foliage adorns this bushy plant. Excellent for either containers or flower beds and borders. An excellent perennial for areas with poor, dry soil. (30-42" x 30") Zn3.



**Artemisia 'Powis Castle'**  
*Wormwood* (Code: 2159)  
 Soft, sturdy, gray leaves form a mound of finely-divided foliage. A wonderful textural accent for the garden. It can also be used as small evergreen hedge. (24-36" x 24-36") Zn6.



**Artemisia dracunculus 'Sativus'**  
*French Tarragon* (Code: 8230)  
 Choice culinary herb boasts slender, dark green, anise-scented leaves. Marvelous used fresh or dried. It needs full sun and excellent drainage to thrive. (2' x 2') Zn4.



**Artemisia labrotanum limoneum**  
*Lemon Southernwood* (Code: 8215)  
 Large-growing, shrubby perennial with ferny, gray-green, citrus-scented leaves. Tiny yellowish flowers appear in fall. The leaves can be dried and used to make a fragrant sachet said to repel moths. (36" x 36") Zn4.



**Artemisia lactiflora 'Guizhou'**  
*White Mugwort* (Code: 5907)  
 Dark green, nearly-black, foliage has a red-tinted reverse. Sprays of pearly-white flowers appear in early summer. (48" x 24-36") Zn3.



**Artemisia ludoviciana 'Valerie Finnis'**  
*Wormwood* (Code: 2166)  
 Broad, jagged silvery-white foliage provides a foil for bright or dark colored companion plants in the border. Native to the Pacific Northwest. (30" x 30") Zn5.



**Artemisia pycnocephala 'David's Choice'**  
*Wormwood* (Code: 2167)  
 Delicate silver foliage forms attractive soft mounds. This beautiful dwarf evergreen selection makes an excellent addition to the rock garden. (12" x 24-36") Zn7.



**Artemisia schmidtiana 'Silver Mound'**  
*Wormwood* (Code: 2162)  
 Attractive fern-like, silvery foliage has a dumping habit that is perfect as a rock garden plant or for edging. A great companion for geraniums or roses. (12-16" x 24") Zn3.



**Astilbe 'Delft Lace'**  
*False Spirea* (Code: 7438)  
 The foliage is a deep blue-green with a unique silver overlay. It flowers in midsummer with clusters of deep salmon pink buds that open to a soft warm pink. (24-36" x 18-24") Zn3. pp19839



**Astilbe chinensis 'Pumila'**  
*False Spirea* (Code: 2222)  
 This dwarf, spreading perennial has lavender-pink spikes from July to September. It will form a groundcover in moist shade. (8-12" x 18-24") Zn3.



**Astilbe chinensis var. taquetii 'Purpurkerze'**  
*False Spirea* (Code: 2218)  
 Very vigorous, clean foliage is topped by long rosy-purple columnar panicles from June to July. It prefers full shade, but it can tolerate some sun if kept moist. (30-36" x 18-24") Zn3.



**Astilbe simplicifolia 'Hennie Graafland'**  
*False Spirea* (Code: 5515)  
 Clear pink flowers top bronze-green leaves. The flower plumes are excellent for bouquets. Similar to A. 'Sprite', the glossy foliage is very attractive even when not in flower. (12" x 18") Zn3.



**Astilbe thunbergii 'Betsy Cuperus'**  
*False Spirea* (Code: 5265)  
 Fountain-like, arching, light pink panicles top fresh green foliage. This tall Astilbe is very effective as a focal point when grown in moist shade. (40" x 24") Zn3.



**Astilbe thunbergii 'Ostrich Plume'**  
*False Spirea* (Code: 2213)  
 Gracefully-weeping, deep dusty rose plumes add an air of elegance for moist, shade. The pretty plumes make gorgeous cut flowers. (30" x 20") Zn3.



**Astilbe thunbergii 'Professor Van der Wielen'**  
*False Spirea* (Code: 2265)  
 Large, arching white plumes top fresh green foliage in summer. The impressively large and elegant flowers illuminate the shade. The flowers are wonderful for bouquets too. (40" x 24") Zn3.



**Astilbe x arendsii 'Amethyst'**  
*False Spirea* (Code: 2264)  
 Lavender-pink plumes top this shade-loving perennial in summer. It can tolerate some sun if it's in a moist location. (20" x 24") Zn3.




**Aster x arendsii 'Bridal Veil'**
*False Spirea* (Code: 5095)

Elegant, airy sprays of clear white flowers appear from late spring through early summer. The ferny foliage adds a touch of class to the shade garden. (24" x 18") Zn3.


**Aster x arendsii 'Bumalda'**
*False Spirea* (Code: 2225)

Creamy-white flowers with a pink flush top pretty green foliage. Adds a note of elegance to the shade garden. (24" x 24") Zn3.


**Aster x arendsii 'Cattleya'**
*False Spirea* (Code: 2210)

Tall and loosely-clustered, rose pink plumes glow above dark foliage. It can tolerate some sun if kept moist. (3-4' x 2') Zn3.


**Aster x arendsii 'Fanal'**
*False Spirea* (Code: 2212)

Deep pomegranate-red flower plumes grace this show-stopper from June to July. It's easy to grow with ample moisture. (2' x 2') Zn3.


**Aster x arendsii 'Hyacinth'**
*False Spirea* (Code: 2228)

Fresh glossy green foliage holds graceful plumes of lilac colored flowers from June to July. If provided with rich, moist soil, it produces wonderful cut flowers. (24" x 30") Zn3.


**Aster x arendsii 'Lilli Goos'**
*False Spirea* (Code: 6210)

Dark pink plumes rise atop distinctive dark green foliage. Prefers a shady site, but can tolerate some sun if kept moist. (20" x 24") Zn3.


**Aster x arendsii 'Red Charm'**
*False Spirea* (Code: 3931)

Growing 3-4' tall, it has graceful arching plumes of true red that appear in June. It is wonderful for making a big impact in the back of the shady border. (36-48" x 24-30") Zn3. Propagation prohibited.


**Aster x arendsii 'Snowdrift'**
*False Spirea* (Code: 5825)

**Aster x japonica 'Avalanche'**
*False Spirea* (Code: 2209)

Short, airy plumes of pristine white adorn this shade garden favorite. Elegant green foliage adds contrast for the flowers. Nice for cut flower arrangements. (18" x 18") Zn3.


**Aster x japonica 'Peach Blossom'**
*False Spirea* (Code: 2224)

**Athyrium filix-femina x niponicum 'Branford Rambler'**
*Running Lady Fern* (Code: 4963)

This vigorous, spreading deciduous groundcover fern has purplish-red stems and short green fronds. Dependable and adaptable in shady locations, but never invasive. (18-24" x 24-36") Zn4.


**Athyrium niponicum 'Pictum'**
*Japanese Painted Fern* (Code: 6968)

Silvery-gray, metallic-appearing fronds have garnet veins extending to the tips. Long-lived and reliable in moist, humus-rich soil. 2004 Perennial Plant Association Plant of the Year and a "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (12-18" x 18-24") Zn3.




**Aubrieta 'Dr. Mules Variegata'**
*Rock Cress* (Code: 2107)

This wonderful perennial has violet-purple flowers in spring that brightly contrast creeping cream and green-variegated foliage. (4" x 12") Zn4.


**Aubrieta 'Dr. Mules'**
*Rock Cress* (Code: 2235)

Stunning blue-violet flowers smother a carpet of foliage in spring. This old-time variety is perfect for the alpine garden or tumbling over rock walls. (5" x 18") Zn4.


**Aubrieta 'Red Flowering Variegated'**
*Rock Cress* (Code: 2108)

Variegated cream and green foliage has a trailing habit perfect for the rock garden or edge of the border. Red flowers appear in early spring. (4-8" x 10-16") Zn4.

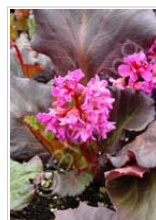

**Bergenia 'Abendglocken'**
*Elephant Ears* (Code: 5097)

This clump form has large glossy, leathery evergreen foliage which turns a beautiful maroon color in fall and winter. Flower spikes are a rich magenta. (14" x 14") Zn3.


**Bergenia 'Abendglut'**
*Elephant Ears* (Code: 5629)

This improved form has lovely deep-magenta, semi-double bells lining upright red stems, March to May. The evergreen foliage adds substance to the border and turns maroon in winter. An excellent selection! (18" x 12") Zn3.


**Bergenia 'Glockenturm'**
*Elephant Ears* (Code: 5098)

Sturdy evergreen leaves turn purple-maroon in winter. Deep magenta flowers appear in spring, then sporadically through summer & fall. A wonderful textural accent for the late season garden. (18" x 18") Zn3.


**Bergenia 'Pink Dragonfly'**
*Elephant Ear* (Code: 4073)

This Bergenia forms a low clump of tidy narrow green leaves, that develop rich plum-red tones in the winter. Taller stems of bell-shaped pink flowers rise above the shiny foliage in mid spring. (12-15" x 15") Zn3.







**Bergenia 'Ruby Elf'**  
*Dwarf Elephant Ears* (Code: 5901)

*Elephant Ears* (Code: 2390)

**Bouteloua gracilis 'Blonde Ambition'**  
*Blue Gramma, Mosquito Grass* (Code: 7804)  
 The brush-like flowers rise up out of the blue-green foliage in mid-summer and are suspended horizontally for months on stiff, weather-resistant stems. The flowers turn chartreuse by fall and then mature to long-lasting blonde seed heads. Larger-growing than the native Blue Gramma. (24-36" x 24-36") Zn4. PPAF



**Brachycome dilatata**  
*Swan River Daisy* (Code: 6307)  
 A profusion of starry, lavender-blue 1" daisies with yellow centers bloom profusely spring to fall on this low-growing, mounding plant. (4" x 12") Zn9.



**Brunnera macrophylla**  
*Siberian Bugloss* (Code: 5101)  
 Small azure-blue flowers (reminiscent of forget-me-nots) rise above attractive heart-shaped foliage. Able to tolerate full shade, it makes an excellent groundcover when planted en masse. (18" x 18") Zn3.



**Brunnera macrophylla 'Hadspen Cream'**  
*Siberian Bugloss* (Code: 4617)  
 Heart-shaped leaves have a somewhat fuzzy texture and narrow, irregular variegation. Sprays of blue forget-me-not flowers emerge in early spring. A sweet addition the woodland garden or grow in light shade. (12" x 18") Zn3.



**Brunnera macrophylla 'Jack Frost'**  
*Siberian Bugloss* (Code: 7389)  
 The leaves have frosty-silver overlay and light green veining. Tiny clusters of pretty forget-me-not flowers appear in spring. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest that is perfect for the woodland garden! (12-15" x 15") Zn3. PP13859 Propagation Prohibited.



**Brunnera macrophylla 'Looking Glass'**  
*Siberian Bugloss* (Code: 3896)  
 This sport of Brunnera 'Jack Frost' has even larger, more-silvery leaves. With a mounding habit, it really brightens shady areas. Blue forget-me-not flowers appear in spring. (18" x 15") Zn3. PP17829 Propagation Prohibited.



**Brunnera macrophylla 'Variegata'**  
*Siberian Bugloss* (Code: 4294)  
 Large heart-shaped leaves have bold white margins. Bright blue, forget-me-not flowers appear in early spring. This is a good deer-resistant alternative to Hosta! (12-18" x 18") Zn3.



**Calamagrostis arundinacea brachytricha**  
*Feather Reed Grass* (Code: 2278)  
 Upright fluffy flower spikes emerge briefly in early summer in Oregon, then bloom again in fall. A graceful and arching grass that grows well in moist locations. (3-4' x 3') Zn5.



**Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Avalanche'**  
*Feather Reed Grass* (Code: 5999)  
 Medium-sized clumps showcase dramatically-stripped foliage. Airy, rose-tinged plumes take on warm golden hues later in the season. (3-5' x 3-5') Zn5.





**Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Karl Foerster'**  
*Feather Reed Grass* (Code: 5160)  
 Upright soft green leaves are topped by tall, vertical, rose-colored plumes that mature to a golden-wheat color. This 2001 Perennial Plant Association Plant of the Year is also a "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (5' x 2') Zn4.



**Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Overdam'**  
*Feather Reed Grass* (Code: 6007)  
 Arching, green and white-striped leaves are topped by upright bronze flower spikes that gradually fade to buff. The foliage takes on a green-to-red tinge in the fall. (3' x 2') Zn5.



**Calluna vulgaris 'Lady in White'**  
*Heather* (Code: 7796)  
 This small evergreen shrub has bushy, upright branches covered with white flowers from August until January. Flowering branches make a wonderful addition to garlands and wreaths. Prefers cool summers and moist, but well-drained acidic soil. (8-18" x 8-14") Zn5. PP20530



**Carex buchananii**  
*Leather Leaf Sedge* (Code: 2328)  
 Copper-bronze leaves with curly tops make a dramatic accent in the mixed border or container. The graceful, upright form looks best contrasted with silver foliage or with brightly colored flowers. (24" x 18") Zn7.



**Carex buchananii 'Viridis'**  
*Leather Leaf Sedge* (Code: 5655)  
 This graceful, finely-textured, evergreen grass forms an upright clump of curly-topped light green leaves. It makes a striking accent for the perennial border or container. (18-24" x 18") Zn7.



**Carex comans 'Frosted Curls'**  
*New Zealand Hairy Sedge* (Code: 2511)  
 Very graceful, finely-textured, pale silver-green leaves form a low arching mound of foliage. It makes a beautiful, soft-textured evergreen groundcover when planted in groups. (12" x 16") Zn7.



**Carex comans 'Milk Chocolate'**  
*New Zealand Hairy Sedge* (Code: 4236)  
 Delicious milk chocolate-colored, evergreen grass with long thin blades that curve gracefully outward. Similar to C. 'Frosted Curls' but with a rich brownish-red hue. (12" x 12-24") Zn7.



**Carex dolichostachya 'Kaga nishiki'**  
*Gold Fountain Sedge* (Code: 4805)  
 Fine green leaves have a gold stripe along each edge. Low and fountain-like, this sedge works well in drifts, as a formal border or specimen. Tolerant of many conditions and exposures. (12" x 24") Zn5.



**Carex elata 'Bowler's Golden'**  
*Golden Sedge* (Code: 6285)  
 This incandescent, golden grass makes a gorgeous foliage accent for the mixed border or pond perimeter. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (24-36" x 24-36") Zn5.



**Carex flacca**  
*Blue Sedge* (Code: 3734)  
 Evergreen chalky-blue blades spread to form a groundcover that will tolerate shade. Blue flowers on blue stems appear in early summer. (15" x 15") Zn4.



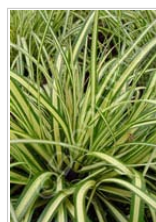
**Carex flacca 'Blue Zinger'**  
*Carex* (Code: 4239)

*Weeping Brown Sedge* (Code: 2281)

*Sedge* (Code: 4941)

**Carex morrowii 'Aureovariegata'**  
*Variiegated Sedge* (Code: 2329)  
 This easy-to-grow evergreen grass forms a mounding clump of butter-yellow-striped leaves with green edges. A truly beautiful sedge, useful as an accent, in groups as a groundcover, or as a container subject. (12" x 15") Zn5.




**Carex morrowii 'Ice Dance'**
*Variegated Sedge* (Code: 6653)

Dark green leaves with white edges form arching mounds of evergreen foliage. It will spread to form a groundcover that's easy to control. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (12" x 18") Zn5.


**Carex morrowii 'Silver Sceptre'**
*Sedge* (Code: 4752)

Green leaves with silver-white edges form dense, creeping tufts. Pale and wispy flowers appear in late spring. An excellent evergreen groundcover among Hostas, ferns or bamboo. (18" x 42") Zn6.


**Carex muskingumensis 'Ice Fountains'**
*Palm Leaf Sedge* (Code: 6190)

**Carex nigra 'Variegata'**
*Variegated Sedge* (Code: 6297)

Light green blades to 12" are softly edged in yellow. This vigorous groundcover is good for partial shade. It will also tolerate drier soils. (12" x 18") Zn5.


**Carex oshimensis 'Evergold'**
*Sedge* (Code: 3890)

This popular clump-forming sedge has light yellow blades with green edges. The evergreen foliage is a standout in the garden any time of year. (10-12" x 12") Zn5.


**Carex phyllocephala 'Sparkler'**
*Sedge* (Code: 4528)

Whorls of boldly variegated green and white blades will literally stop traffic. Exciting and exotic, this tough garden jewel will add a bright spot to any landscape or mixed planter. (12-18" x 12-18") Zn7.


**Carex subfusca**
*Rusty Sedge* (Code: 7419)

Very narrow bright green blades form evergreen clumps. Use as a groundcover under trees or in moist areas. It reseeds readily. Native to the Pacific Northwest. (12" x 18") Zn7.


**Caryopteris incana 'Sunshine Blue'**™

*Bluebeard* (Code: 3262)

Bright golden foliage is accented by stunning deep blue flowers, late summer through fall. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (3' x 3') Zn6. PPAF Propagation Prohibited.


**Caryopteris x clandonensis 'Blue Mist'**
*Bluebeard* (Code: 2347)

Beautiful, compact, drought tolerant flowering shrub with a profusion of vivid smoky-blue flowers in late summer on small grayish-green foliage. (24" x 30") Zn5.


**Caryopteris x clandonensis 'Dark Knight'**
*Bluebeard* (Code: 2349)

Compact and showy deciduous shrub with profuse clusters of the deepest blue flowers late in the season. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (2-3' x 2-3') Zn5.





**Caryopteris x clandonensis 'First Choice'**  
*Bluebeard* (Code: 4072)  
 Dense, dark green foliage contrasts beautifully with black buds which open to deep cobalt-blue flowers. This herbaceous shrub has a compact, upright habit. (2-3' x 2-3') Zn5. PP11958 Propagation Prohibited.



**Caryopteris x clandonensis 'Summer Sorbet'**<sup>®</sup>  
*Bluebeard* (Code: 3960)  
 Variegated shrub with blue-green leaves that have a distinct creamy-yellow edge. Bright blue flowers make a breathtaking contrast in late summer. (30-36" x 30-36") Zn5. PP15935 Propagation Prohibited.



**Catananche caerulea**  
*Cupid's Dart* (Code: 2350)  
 Lavender to lilac-blue daisy-like flowers bloom for many weeks in summer above strap-like, hairy leaves. The flowers are displayed on long stems, perfect for either cut or dried flowers. (18" x 12") Zn5.



**Ceanothus 'Centennial'**  
*California Lilac* (Code: 6670)  
 This low-growing, spreading, evergreen shrub has dark blue flowers in spring. A native cultivar of the Pacific coast, it is tolerant of summer heat and drought. (8-12" x 72") Zn7.



**Ceanothus 'Dark Star'**  
*California Lilac* (Code: 6748)  
 A beautiful evergreen shrub with very nice, small and slightly cupped deep green leaves. Cobalt-blue flowers completely cover the foliage in late spring. (6' x 8-12') Zn7.



**Ceanothus 'Italian Skies'**  
*California Lilac* (Code: 3743)  
 This stunning evergreen shrub has a dense mounding habit with small dark green leaves. Luminous deep blue flowers cover the shrub in spring. Award of Merit, RHS 1984. (6-8' x 6-10') Zn7.



**Ceanothus 'Joyce Coulter'**  
*California Lilac* (Code: 6745)  
 Sky-blue fragrant flowers, held in 3-5" spike-like clusters, cover this evergreen shrub in spring. With a low-growing, spreading habit, it makes a good groundcover or low hedge. (30-36' x 4-8') Zn7.



**Ceanothus 'Julia Phelps'**  
*California Lilac* (Code: 2116)  
 This large, mounding, evergreen shrub puts on a spectacular display of indigo-blue flowers in spring. This drought tolerant and deer resistant shrub has remained popular for over 50 years. (5-8' x 6-9') Zn7.



**Ceanothus 'Victoria'**  
*California Lilac* (Code: 6712)  
 Masses of vivid dark blue flowers appear mid-spring. It grows into a lovely medium sized shrub with glossy evergreen leaves. Tough and trouble-free, it is a "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (4-6' x 6') Zn7.



**Ceanothus gloriosus (Pt Reyes)**  
*Point Reyes Ceanothus* (Code: 7050)  
 Lavender-blue flower clusters in spring top shiny evergreen foliage on a nice low-spreading shrub. It makes an excellent groundcover when planted en masse. (2' x 4') Zn7.



**Ceanothus griseus var. horizontalis 'Diamond Heights'**  
*California Lilac* (Code: 6833)  
 Gorgeous lime-green foliage has dark pine-green detail down the spine of each leaf. Lovely bright blue flowers appear in spring. Great for mild coastal gardens, it prefers partial shade when grown in hot locations. (8-12" x 24-36") Zn8.



**Ceanothus impressus 'Vandenberg'**  
*California Lilac* (Code: 6907)  
 Very small crinkled, deep green leaves set this unusual compact selection apart. Bright blue flowers appear in late spring. An unusual and choice evergreen shrub for the garden. (3-5' x 4-8') Zn7.



**Ceanothus Tuxedo**  
*California Lilac* (Code: 7043)  
 The dark bronze-purple foliage is a real breakthrough in breeding! This distinctive evergreen shrub has an open, upright habit that responds well to pruning. Lavender-blue flowers appear in abundance in late summer and fall. (6-8' x 6-8') Zn8. PPAF

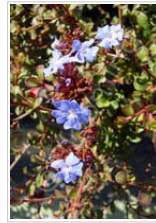


**Ceanothus x pallidus 'Marie Simon'**  
*California Lilac* (Code: 3745)  
 Rose-pink flower buds open to 3-5" pink panicles, blooming for several weeks in summer. This deciduous, bushy shrub has showy, contrasting red stems. (5' x 5') Zn7.





**Cerastium tomentosum 'Silver Carpet'**  
*Snow-in-Summer* (Code: 2365)  
 The silvery-white mat of foliage is smothered with white flowers from April to May. Lovely as a groundcover in well drained soil. (3-6" x 18") Zn3.



**Cerastostigma griffithii**  
*Plumbago* (Code: 2372)

*Double-Flowered Roman Chamomile* (Code: 8044)  
 Aromatic white, double, flowering herb makes a long-blooming groundcover. Mow while flowers are fresh to maintain as a lawn. Blooms can be used for teas. (2-8" x 18-24") Zn4.



**Chamaemelum nobile 'Treneague'**  
*Roman Chamomile* (Code: 3786)  
 Dense green foliage on this non-flowering chamomile makes a nice lawn, path or carpeting around garden seats. Aromatic when walked upon. (2-8" x 18-24") Zn4.



**Chasmanthium latifolium**  
*Woodland Sea Oats* (Code: 2374)  
 Clusters of flattened, nodding spikelets top arching stems. The attractive seedheads persist through winter. In the Pacific Northwest, it needs a sunny site that stays moist in summer. Despite the name, it is not a dune grass. (3' x 2-3') Zn5.



**Chasmanthium latifolium 'River Mist'**  
*Woodland Sea Oats* (Code: 6648)  
 The striking green and white variegated foliage makes this a great specimen plant. Late summer and early fall brings dangling oat-like spikelets that provide interest well into the winter as they dry out. (30-36" x 24-30") Zn5. PPAF Propagation Prohibited



**Choisya arizonica 'Aztec Pearl'**  
*Mexican Orange Blossom* (Code: 6906)  
 Blush-hued buds open to fragrant white flowers in late spring. Glossy deep green leaves are finely cut. This is a knockout compact evergreen shrub! It prefers full sun in well-drained soil; protect from cold winds. (3-4' x 4') Zn7.



**Choisya ternata 'Sundance'**  
*Mexican Orange* (Code: 6876)  
 This striking foliage plant features brilliant golden-yellow leaves and citrus-scented white blossoms, late winter to early spring. Protect from cold winds. (4' x 4') Zn7.



**Cistus 'Blanche'**  
*Rockrose* (Code: 4706)  
 Fragrant, large white blossoms with large yellow centers bloom in late spring and early summer. Medium-sized evergreen shrub with bright green, wavy-edged leaves. Drought tolerant. (4-5' x 4-5') Zn7.



**Cistus 'Elma'**  
*Rockrose* (Code: 5618)  
 Very large, white single flowers top lustrous dark green foliage in early summer. A wonderful, drought-tolerant evergreen selection with an upright habit. (4-5' x 4-5') Zn7.



**Cistus 'Silver Pink'**  
*Rockrose* (Code: 4192)  
 Lovely pale salmon-pink flowers cover this small, rather open bush in late spring and early summer. The evergreen leaves have grayish undersides. It tolerates poor soil, dry slopes and maritime conditions. (2' x 2') Zn8.





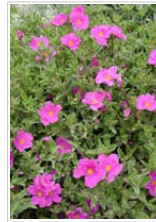
**Cistus incanus 'Creticus'**  
*Rock Rose* (Code: 7063)  
 This evergreen shrub has wavy silver foliage highlighted by rose-pink flowers in early summer. Great for the rockery, it is an excellent drought-tolerant selection. (36" x 30") Zn8.



**Cistus salvifolius 'Prostratus'**  
*Prostrate Rockrose* (Code: 7065)  
 White flowers with yellow centers cover sage-like evergreen leaves in spring. The low spreading habit makes it a great shrub for use as a groundcover. It tolerates poor soil, dry banks and maritime conditions. (10-18" x 72") Zn7.



**Cistus x corbariensis**  
*White Rockrose* (Code: 5680)

*Rockrose* (Code: 6804)  
 Large flowers of deep rose-pink top silvery-gray leaves from early to mid summer. This dense, low spreading evergreen shrub is quite drought tolerant. (2' x 3-5') Zn7.



**Cistus x purpureus**  
*Orchid Rockrose* (Code: 6885)  
 Spectacular large blooms of rose-pink have a maroon-red spot on each petal and bloom in early summer. An elegant and underused Mediterranean shrub, it tolerates poor soil, dry banks and maritime conditions. (3-4' x 3-4') Zn8.



**Cistus x skanbergii**  
*Pink Rockrose* (Code: 7064)  
 This tough and graceful dwarf, evergreen shrub features soft pink flowers in late spring. Highly recommended, it tolerates poor soil, dry banks and maritime conditions. (2-3' x 3-4') Zn8.



**Convallaria majalis**  
*Lily of the Valley* (Code: 2420)  
 Clusters of extremely-fragrant, dainty white bell-shaped flowers adorn this old-fashioned favorite in spring. It spreads freely to form a low maintenance groundcover under deciduous trees. (6-10" x 24-36") Zn3.



**Convallaria majalis 'Rosea'**  
*Lily of the Valley* (Code: 6010)  
 This carefree groundcover has dainty, fragrant, pink bell-shaped flowers in spring followed by tiny orange berries. (6-10" x 18-24") Zn3.



**Convolvulus cneorum**  
*Silverbush* (Code: 2423)  
 Glistening silver foliage forms a compact evergreen shrub displaying loads of 2" ivory flowers with yellow centers for many months. It performs best in gritty soils with sharp drainage. (18" x 18") Zn8.



**Coreopsis 'Snowberry'**  
*Snowberry Coreopsis* (Code: 3965)  
 Large, creamy-white flowers with dark raspberry eyes bloom profusely all summer on 26" stems. With a mounding habit, this versatile plant fits into just about any landscape design. (15-24" x 18-24") Zn6. PP18560, PVR Propagation Prohibited.



**Coreopsis auriculata 'Elfin Gold'**  
*Mouse Ear Coreopsis* (Code: 3659)  
 Beautiful golden-yellow, daisy-like flowers appear in late spring and summer on a compact plant with small leaves. It is excellent for borders, containers and rock gardens. (6" x 10") Zn4.



**Coreopsis auriculata 'Jethro Tull'**  
*Tickseed* (Code: 3644)  
 Unusual fluted, golden-yellow flowers bloom from mid spring through summer. The compact habit makes it suitable for containers as well as the front of the border. (12-15" x 18") Zn5. PP18789 Propagation Prohibited.



**Coreopsis grandiflora 'Baby Sun'**  
*Tickseed* (Code: 2428)  
 This compact, free-flowering form is enhanced by single gold flowers with maroon markings. A lovely, carefree selection. (15" x 12") Zn5.



**Coreopsis grandiflora 'Flying Saucers'**  
*Tickseed* (Code: 6805)  
 Large single, golden-yellow flowers are profuse and long-blooming summer through fall. An excellent selection for sunny locations. (24" x 18") Zn4. PP10299 Propagation Prohibited.




**Coreopsis grandiflora 'Sunray'**
*Tickseed* (Code: 2432)

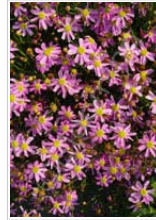

**Coreopsis verticillata 'Moonbeam'**
*Thread-Leaf Tickseed* (Code: 2435)

Pale yellow flowers bloom most of the summer on finely-textured, linear foliage that forms a low, rounded mound. 1992 Perennial Plant Association Plant of the Year. (18" x 18") Zn3.


**Coreopsis verticillata 'Zagreb'**
*Thread-Leaf Tickseed* (Code: 2437)

Very showy golden-yellow, star-shaped flowers bloom on and off, summer to frost, with little attention. An excellent addition to the perennial border! (15" x 12") Zn3.


**Coreopsis x 'Full Moon'**
*Tickseed* (Code: 4514)

Soft canary-yellow flowers are up to 3" across and appear from late summer into fall! The very floriferous plants are well branched with deep green foliage. (24-30" x 30-36") Zn5. PP19364 Propagation Prohibited.


**Cortaderia selloana 'Icalma'**
*Blue Pampas Grass* (Code: 5576)

This wonderful garden-sized pampas grass grows only 3-4' tall and blooms in late summer above blue-green foliage. The feathery white plumes make great fresh or dried cut flowers. (3-4' x 3-4') Zn7.


**Cortaderia selloana 'Pumila'**
*Pampas Grass* (Code: 3895)

This smaller, hardier pampas grass has very showy, fluffy, white flowers. It creates an excellent 6' tall focal point near walls and corners from fall through winter. (6' x 6') Zn6.


**Corydalis 'Canary Feathers'**
*False Bleeding Heart* (Code: 3966)

The showiest and most vigorous corydalis to date! Soft blue-green, fern-like foliage is topped by large canary-yellow flowers in spring and summer. Unlike other corydalis, this sterile cultivar will not re-seed throughout the garden. (8-10" x 14") Zn6. PP18909 Propagation Prohibited.


**Crocosmia 'Emily McKenzie'**
*Montbretia* (Code: 5556)

Gorgeous deep orange blossoms marked with maroon centers, grace this hummingbird magnet in late summer. It adds a touch of the exotic to the mixed border, but is very easy to grow. (30" x 24") Zn6.


**Crocosmia 'Lucifer'**
*Montbretia* (Code: 2455)

Dramatic, deep red flowers line tall stately stems, with a strong upright, clumping habit. This late-blooming hummingbird favorite is a "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (36" x 24") Zn6.


**Crocosmia 'Norwich Canary'**
*Montbretia* (Code: 8306)

Profuse apricot-yellow flowers top green strap-like foliage in summer. Perfect for the middle of the border, it is an excellent selection for the cutting garden. (24-30" x 24") Zn5.




**Crocosmia 'Woodside Select'**
*Montbretia* (Code: 6809)

Solid red, tubular blooms are grouped in tight clusters along sturdy stems above sword-like foliage in summer. An enchanting addition to the sunny border. Hummingbirds love it! (30" x 24") Zn5.


**Crocosmia masoniorum 'Bressingham Beacon'**
*Montbretia* (Code: 5835)

This vigorous cultivar has arching panicles of bicolored, scarlet-orange and yellow flowers in summer. A favorite of hummingbirds, it adds an exotic touch to any garden. (3' x 3') Zn6.


**Cymbopogon citratus**
*Lemon Grass* (Code: 6524)

Fabulous lemon flavor for Asian dishes and teas! Harvest leaves from the outside of the clump. Overwinter indoors as it is very sensitive to frost. It rarely flowers. (4-5' x 2') Zn9.


**Delosperma 'Mesa Verde™' ('Kelaidis')**
*Hardy Ice Plant* (Code: 4275)

This vigorous, compact form blooms spring to fall in iridescent hues of salmon-on-pink. It is perfect for the carefree sunny border or rock garden. (2" x 18") Zn5. PP13876 Propagation Prohibited.


**Delosperma 'Oberg'**
*Ice Plant* (Code: 6274)

A profusion of small daisy-like flowers first open pink then fade to white, producing a bicolor effect in summer. The low growing mat of succulent gray-green leaves is very drought tolerant. (1-2" x 6-12") Zn7.


**Delosperma 'Table Mountain' ('John Proffitt')**
*Hardy Ice Plant* (Code: 4954)

Fast spreading groundcover with thick succulent leaves topped by small, fuchsia colored, daisy-like blooms all summer. (2-3" x 12-16") Zn5.


**Delosperma basuticum**
*White-eyed Hardy Ice Plant* (Code: 4339)

Glossy bright yellow flowers with white centers cover congested mats of succulent foliage in summer. This is an excellent choice for the rock garden. (1" x 8") Zn6.


**Delosperma congestum 'Gold Nugget'**
*Ice Plant* (Code: 3903)

Low-growing succulent leaves with bright gold, daisy-like flowers bloom in summer. This is a great plant for dry soils and rock gardens. (1-2" x 12") Zn5.


**Delosperma cooperi**
*Cooper's Hardy Ice Plant* (Code: 2459)

Vivid magenta daisies cover succulent evergreen foliage, July to September. It requires sharply drained soil to avoid damage from prolonged wet winters. (2-4" x 18") Zn6.


**Delosperma dyeri 'Red Mountain'™**
*Ice Plant* (Code: 4460)

Brilliant scarlet-red, daisy-like flowers bloom throughout summer on this succulent, low-growing groundcover. Very drought tolerant, it prefers gritty, well-drained soil. (2" x 18") Zn5. PPAF Propagation Prohibited.


**Delosperma floribundum 'Starburst'**
*Hardy Ice Plant* (Code: 7373)

Succulent foliage has shimmering bright pink flowers with eye-catching white centers. It blooms June through fall and does best in full sun and well-drained soil. (2-4" x 12") Zn6.


**Delosperma nubigenum**
*Hardy Ice Plant* (Code: 2460)

Succulent, bright green foliage has red tints in the fall. Single, yellow daisy-like flowers appear late spring and early summer. This is an excellent low growing evergreen for the rock garden. (1-2" x 32-36") Zn5.


**Delosperma nubigenum 'Basutoland'**
*Hardy Ice Plant* (Code: 3904)

From the higher elevations in Africa, this hardy Delosperma has thick fleshy leaves and brilliant yellow flowers in late spring and early summer. Very drought tolerant, it forms a low growing evergreen mat of foliage. (1-3" x 6") Zn5.


**Delphinium elatum 'Guardian Blue'**
*Larkspur* (Code: 3791)

Spikes of vivid dark blue flowers with white centers bloom on strong stems. The Guardian series is the best for cut flower production or for growing in hot climates as a winter annual. It blooms dependably the first year. (30-36" x 24-36") Zn4.






**Delphinium elatum 'Guardian Lavender'**
*Larkspur* (Code: 3793)

Lavender flowers edged in light blue make a stunning display in the garden or for flower arrangements. The Guardian series is the best for cut flower production or for growing in hot climates as a winter annual. It blooms dependably the first year. (30-36" x 24-36") Zn4.


**Delphinium elatum 'Guardian White'**
*Larkspur* (Code: 3794)

Double, pure white flower spikes on strong stems make excellent cut flowers for arrangements. The Guardian series is the best for cut flower production or for growing in hot climates as a winter annual. It blooms dependably the first year. (30-36" x 24-36") Zn4.


**Delphinium grandiflorum 'Blue Butterfly'**
*Chinese Delphinium* (Code: 2470)

Bright cobalt-blue flowers appear repeatedly when spent flowers are removed. Compact and heat tolerant, it needs no staking and is fabulous for smaller bouquets! (12-18" x 18") Zn3.


**Delphinium Pacific Giants 'Black Knight'**
*Larkspur* (Code: 2468)

Tall spires have deep violet-purple, semi-double flowers with black eyes. Stately and elegant, this classic English perennial is well worth the effort! (5-6' x 2') Zn3.


**Delphinium x belladonna 'Connecticut Yankee'**
*Delphinium* (Code: 2479)

A mix of light blue, dark blue, and white-spurred flowers borne singly on branched stems. This cottage garden classic has an open, delicate habit and blooms later than other Delphiniums. (4' x 3') Zn4.


**Deschampsia caespitosa**
*Tufted Hair Grass* (Code: 5161)

Attractive arching green blades are topped with large, pendulous panicles which turn from green to yellow through the season. It grows best when temperatures are moderate. (2-4' x 3') Zn4.


**Deschampsia caespitosa 'Fairy's Joke'**
*Tufted Hair Grass* (Code: 6219)

Arching slender green leaves sport tiny plantlets at the tips in place of seeds. The inflorescences are weighted down by the plantlets, and can root if contacting soil. (2-4' x 3') Zn4.


**Deschampsia caespitosa 'Northern Lights'**
*Tufted Hair Grass* (Code: 4214)

Glowing green and white-striped leaves take on a pink blush in cool weather and when new. It has a nice clumping habit with airy flower panicles that appear in summer. (12" x 12") Zn4.


**Deschampsia caespitosa 'Schottland'**
*Tufted Hair Grass* (Code: 4212)

Huge, light & airy flower panicles rise 3' above evergreen blades, providing an enjoyable display from early summer through winter. The evergreen foliage looks best when temperatures are moderate. (3' x 2-3') Zn4.


**Deschampsia flexuosa 'Aurea' ('Tatra Gold')**
*Crinkled Hair Grass* (Code: 5715)

Finely-textured, arching, golden foliage tufts are topped by nodding purple-tinged panicles in June and July. Lovely specimen for the border or woodland garden. It performs best in rich soil and partial shade. (20" x 12") Zn4.


**Dianthus 'Devon Cottage', Miss Pinky'**
*Pinks* (Code: 7696)

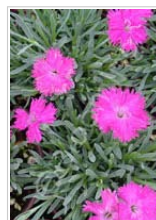

**Dianthus 'Neon Star'**
*Pinks* (Code: 4957)

Hot neon-pink, single flowers bloom all season when spent flowers are removed. The compact habit is ideal for the front of the border. (7-12" x 12") Zn5. PP14549 Propagation Prohibited.





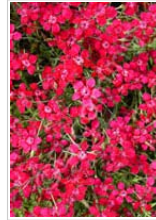

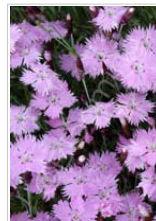

**Dianthus gratianopolitanus 'Bath's Pink'**  
*Cheddar Pink* (Code: 5252)  
 Soft pink, single, fringed flowers bloom profusely in spring. Tough, heat tolerant, gray-green, evergreen foliage is attractive even when not in flower. This is the best Dianthus for groundcover. (6-8" x 24-30") Zn3.



**Dianthus gratianopolitanus 'Bewitched'**  
*Cheddar Pinks* (Code: 3371)

**Dicentra 'King of Hearts'**  
*Bleeding Heart* (Code: 4828)

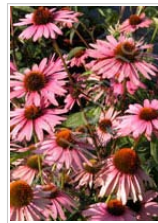

**Echinacea purpurea 'Ruby Star' ('Rubinstern')**
*Coneflower* (Code: 4478)

**Echinacea Summer Sky™ (Katie Saul)**
*Coneflower* (Code: 3669)

Large (5-6") fragrant, orange-colored flowers blend to rose around a central cone. Tallest of the Big Sky™ Echinacea, with strong stems that make it resistant to stormy weather. (36-42" x 18-24") Zn5. PP18783 Propagation Prohibited.


**Epimedium 'Purple Pixie'**
*Bishop's Hat* (Code: 7660)

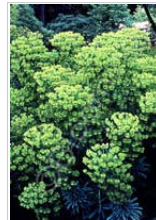
**Euphorbia amygdaloides var. robbiae**

**Euphorbia characias 'Bruce's Dwarf'**

**Euphorbia x martinii 'Redwing'**

**Euphorbia x martinii 'Rudolph'**  
*Spurge* (Code: 4203)

**Festuca 'Silver Heron'**  
*Blue Fescue* (Code: 2173)

**Festuca californica**

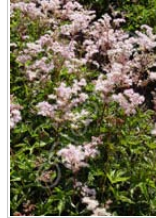

**Filipendula purpurea 'Alba'**
*Meadowsweet* (Code: 3449)

**Filipendula purpurea 'Elegans'**
*Meadowsweet* (Code: 2660)

Tiny red-purple flowers with red stamens are produced in large foamy masses in summer. It needs moist soil if planted in sun. (3' x 2') Zn5.


**Filipendula rubra 'Venusta'**
*Queen of the Prairie* (Code: 2661)

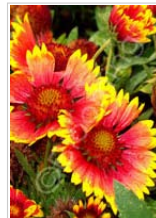

 Graceful bicolor blooms feature pale wine-red standards and true wine-red falls. Blooms are elegant and attractive. Performs best in cool site with slightly moist acidic soil. (36" x 24") Zn3.



**Iris sibirica 'Liberty Hills'**  
*Siberian Iris* (Code: 6098)  
 Attractive blue-violet flowers with darker centers top rich green foliage. Blooms late spring to early summer. Performs best in a cool site with slightly moist acidic soil. (32" x 24") Zn3.



**Iris sibirica 'Lilting Laura'**  
*Siberian Iris* (Code: 6176)  
 Sophisticated blossoms feature pale violet standards that deepen at the midrib and violet falls. Performs best in a cool site with slightly moist, acidic soil. (36" x 36") Zn3.



**Iris sibirica 'Ruffles Plus'**  
*Siberian Iris* (Code: 6317)  
 Heavily-ruffled blooms are a lovely shade of deep violet. Wonderful vertical border accent. Prefers a cool site with slightly moist, acidic soil. (3' x 2') Zn3.



**Iris sibirica 'Serenade in Blue'**

 This stunning Iris features breathtaking blooms of blue-violet with turquoise styles and ruffled, flaring falls. (34" x 24") Zn3.

 Deep lavender-pink flowers top chartreuse, heart-shaped leaves in late spring and summer. It creates a bold contrast in shady areas where bright color is often needed. (6-8" x 12-18") Zn4. PP20723



**Lamium maculatum 'Anne Greenaway'**  
*Deadnettle* (Code: 4690)  
 Showy lavender flowers grace dramatic gold, green, and silver foliage. It makes a wonderful groundcover for shady spots. (6" x 24") Zn3.



**Lamium maculatum 'Elizabeth de Haas'**  
*Deadnettle* (Code: 5582)  
 The green leaves have silvery markings in the midrib. Dark lavender-pink flowers appear in summer. It's beautiful when trailing from pots or as a groundcover for shade. (6" x 24") Zn4.



**Lamium maculatum 'Ghost'**  
*Deadnettle* (Code: 7662)

**Lavandula x intermedia 'Grosso'**  
*Lavandin* (Code: 8074)  
 Violet-blue flowers bloom repeatedly on this vigorous, disease resistant cultivar. It makes excellent dried flowers and is one of the best Lavenders for producing essential oil. (24-36" x 24") Zn5.



**Lavandula x intermedia 'Hidcote Giant'**

**Leucanthemum x superbum 'Aglaia'**

**Lupinus Russell Hybrids 'My Castle'**  
*Lupine* (Code: 3063)  
 Spires of brick-red flowers appear above palmate foliage in late spring. It makes a vibrant cut flower and grows best in dry, sunny locations. (3' x 2') Zn3.



**Lupinus Russell Hybrids 'The Governor'**  
*Lupine* (Code: 3060)  
 Beautiful spikes of blue and white flowers appear late spring and early summer. It makes an excellent addition for the cut flower garden. (3' x 2') Zn3.



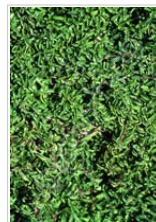
**Lupinus Russell Hybrids 'The Pages'**  
*Lupine* (Code: 3064)  
 Cherry-red flowers on tall stalks adorn this lovely late spring bloomer. It makes a marvelous and vibrant cut bouquet, perfect for dry, sunny locations. (36" x 24") Zn3.



**Melissa officinalis 'All Gold'**  
*Golden Lemon Balm* (Code: 5665)

**Mentha piperita citrata**

**Mentha spicata 'Moroccan'**  
*Moroccan Mint (Spearmint)* (Code: 4284)  
 This hardy herb is well-known for its very fragrant, clear spearmint flavor. Excellent culinary herb for teas, salads and sauces. (Restricted in some areas) (2' x 2') Zn5.



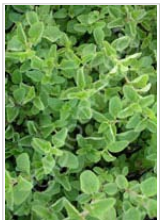
**Mentha spicata 'Spanish'**

**Miscanthus oligostachyus 'Purpurascens'**  
*Flame Grass, Eulalia* (Code: 3117)

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Zebrinus'**

**Molinia caerulea 'Strahlenquelle'**  
*Purple Moor Grass* (Code: 6816)  
 Airy, radiating flowerheads create a graceful fountain-like effect in late summer. Buttery-yellow fall color adds to the show. It prefers moderately moist soil. (3' x 3') Zn4.



**Molinia caerulea 'Variegata'**  
*Purple Moor Grass* (Code: 6110)  
 Dark green and cream leaves give off a golden glow, accented by ochre flower plumes in late summer. A compact grass and excellent for containers. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (24" x 12") Zn5.




**Monarda 'Mahogany'**
*Bee Balm* (Code: 5922)

**Monarda 'Raspberry Wine'**

**Monarda didyma 'Aquarius'**
*Bee Balm* (Code: 2007)

Fragrant, dark mauve flowers with rosy-pink overtones emerge from purplish bracts in summer. A striking mildew resistant selection! (48" x 36") Zn4.


**Monarda didyma 'Coral Reef'**
*Bee Balm* (Code: 5894)

Glowing coral-pink summer blooms shine on tall, sturdy stems. This lovely border accent has good mildew resistance. (36-42" x 24-30") Zn3. PP16741 Propagation Prohibited.


**Monarda didyma 'Jacob Cline'**
*Bee Balm* (Code: 6239)

Large true red blooms top tall, green, mildew resistant foliage on this vigorous growing cultivar. The flowers are very attractive to hummingbirds and butterflies. (4-5' x 2-3') Zn3.


**Monarda didyma 'Marshall's Delight'**
*Bee Balm* (Code: 3125)

The stunning vivid pink flowers and shiny light green leaves make this Monarda a striking perennial border addition. Mildew resistant too! (2-3' x 2-3') Zn3.


**Monarda didyma 'Petite Delight'**
*Bee Balm* (Code: 3140)

**Monarda didyma 'Petite Red' (Fireball)**

**Nassella (Stipa) tenuissima**
*Mexican Feather Grass* (Code: 3690)

Silky creamy-gold inflorescences undulate like waves with any breeze. This marvelous grass contributes grace and elegance to the garden or container. (2' x 2') Zn7.


**Nepeta 'Joanna Reed'**
*Catmint* (Code: 5579)

This lovely catmint has larger blooms that flower profusely, late spring through fall. The large leaves form a nice green, mounding base under luminous cornflower-blue blooms. (24-36" x 24") Zn3.


**Nepeta 'Pink Pixie'**
*Catmint* (Code: 4894)

**Nepeta x faassenii 'Dropmore'**
*Catmint* (Code: 6537)

Dark violet-blue flowers appear in abundance throughout summer. Shear hard after initial bloom for a second long-lasting flush of color. (18" x 18") Zn4.







**Nepeta x faassenii 'Walkers Low'**  
*Catmint* (Code: 6362)  
 A profusion of violet-blue flowers top soft gray-green foliage repeatedly late spring through fall. An excellent plant to soften hot colors in the border. 2007 Perennial Plant Association Plant of the Year. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (15" x 18") Zn5.



**Nepeta yunnanensis 'Blue Dragon'**  
*Catmint* (Code: 7410)  
 Large showy "dragon head" blooms on this Catmint makes it a must-have in the garden. Shorter than *N. yunnanensis*, it will stay upright in a sunny border. (28-30" x 24-30") Zn6. PPAF Propagation Prohibited



**Oenothera fremontii 'Shimmer'**  
*Evening Primrose* (Code: 7694)  
 Bright lemon-yellow saucer-like blooms appear in spring, then bloom again mid summer and fall! The fine textured silver and green variegated foliage is showy even when not in flower. Compact habit. (10" x 18") Zn4. PPAF Propagation Prohibited



**Origanum 'Amethyst Falls'**  
*Oregano* (Code: 4453)  
 Large sprays of pendulous, chartreuse bracts with protruding bright purple flowers appear in summer. Attractive, fragrant leaves enhance this amazing, long-blooming ornamental Oregano. It performs best in well-drained soil. (8-12" x 24") Zn5. PPAF Propagation Prohibited.



**Origanum 'Barbara Tingey'**  
*Ornamental Oregano* (Code: 4355)

**Origanum vulgare 'Dark Leaf'**  
*Oregano* (Code: 5932)

**Origanum vulgare 'Dr. Letswaart'**

**Paeonia Itoh 'Sequestered Sunshine'**  
*Itoh Peony* (Code: 7683)  
 Large, bright canary-yellow blossoms with showy stamens stand above the lush, dark green, deeply dissected foliage. An especially vigorous plant, the sturdy flower stems require no staking and make good cut flowers. (36-42" x 36-42") Zn3.



**Paeonia Itoh 'Visions of Sugar Plums'**  
*Itoh Peony* (Code: 7684)

Enormous 6" double, pink blooms have attractive lavender overtones with flares of darker lavender in the center. Strong stems hold the blooms above dark green foliage. A cross between a tree peony and an herbaceous peony. (3' x 3') Zn3.



**Paeonia x 'Itoh Going Bananas'**

*Itoh Peony* (Code: 4217)

This cross between a tree peony and an herbaceous peony has resulted in large 6" single yellow flowers; a new color for herbaceous peonies. Strong stems hold the enormous flowers upright. (2-3' x 2-3') Zn3.



**Paeonia x 'Itoh Hillary'**

*Itoh Peony* (Code: 4493)

Loose double, 6" red flowers fade to cream on the outside of each petal while inner petals remain vibrant red. Strong stems hold the flowers upright above dark green foliage. A cross between a tree peony and an herbaceous peony. (3' x 3') Zn3.



**Paeonia x 'Itoh Julia Rose'**

*Itoh Peony* (Code: 4206)

Single to semi-double 6" blooms open rose-red and quickly turn to an apricot-yellow hue. Strong stems hold the flowers above dark green foliage. A cross between a tree peony and an herbaceous peony. (30-36" x 30-36") Zn3.



**Paeonia x 'Itoh Kopper Kettle'**

*Itoh Peony* (Code: 4219)

Semi-double to double, multi-color 6" blooms of red, yellow and orange give this peony a copper-hued effect from a distance. Handsome dark green foliage is supported by a sturdy well-shaped plant. A cross between a tree peony and herbaceous peony. (24-36" x 30-36") Zn3.



**Paeonia x 'Itoh Magical Mystery Tour'**

*Itoh Peony* (Code: 4222)

Blooms are semi-double in a creamy-pink blend and can reach up to 6-7" across, in late spring. Strong stems hold the flowers upright above dark green foliage. A cross between an herbaceous peony and a tree peony. (3' x 3') Zn3. Propagation prohibited.



**Paeonia x 'Itoh Morning Lilac'**

*Itoh Peony* (Code: 4223)

Semi-double, lavender-pink flowers have white and fuchsia striping with red-tipped carpels. Very floriferous with medium-sized (up to 6") blooms on strong plants, with excellent foliage. A cross between a tree peony and an herbaceous peony. (2-3' x 2-3') Zn3.




**Paeonia x 'Itoh Singing in the Rain'**
*Itoh Peony* (Code: 4207)

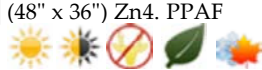

**Paeonia x 'Itoh Yankee Doodle Dandy'**

**Panicum 'Huron Solstice'**
*Switchgrass* (Code: 7637)

The blue-green foliage begins turning a deep burgundy-wine color in early summer, and by fall is almost totally burgundy, providing a stunning accent with its blazing fall color. Dainty, airy, purplish inflorescences appear atop the foliage in late August. (48" x 36") Zn4. PPAF


**Panicum virgatum 'Cheyenne Sky'**
*Switchgrass* (Code: 7635)

The blue-green foliage turns deep red-purple from late summer through autumn. By late summer wine-red flower panicles appear just above the foliage. One of the hardest purple foliage grasses available! (2-3' x 2-3') Zn4. PPAF


**Panicum virgatum 'Cloud Nine'**
*Switch Grass* (Code: 6689)

Airy golden inflorescence create a soft transparent effect for the back of the border in late summer. Lovely light blue blades turn golden in fall. (6-8' x 3') Zn4.


**Panicum virgatum 'Dallas Blues'**
*Switch Grass* (Code: 7553)

This robust grower has incredible blue foliage! Lofty plum colored panicles emerge in late summer or early fall and can grow to over 22" long! Good winter color. (5-6' x 3') Zn4. PP11202 Propagation Prohibited.


**Panicum virgatum 'Dwarf'**
*Switch Grass* (Code: 4877)

**Panicum virgatum 'Haense Herms'**

**Papaver nudicaule 'Gnome'**
*Iceland Poppy* (Code: 5036)

Large, papery flowers of mixed colors appear on slender stems in summer and fall on this dwarf plant. The flowers can be yellow, orange, scarlet, white or pink. (1' x 1') Zn2.





**Papaver nudicaule 'Wonderland Pink'**  
*Iceland Poppy* (Code: 3188)  
 Vibrant pink to salmon and coral flowers grace this beautiful, compact perennial. Excellent for the front of the border or rockery. (16" x 12") Zn2.



**Papaver nudicaule 'Wonderland Yellow'**  
*Iceland Poppy* (Code: 3190)  
 Large, delicate yellow flowers appear on slender, upright, sturdy stems. Invaluable for early season color. It is best suited for the rockery or alpine gardens. (16" x 12") Zn2.



**Papaver orientale 'Brilliant'**  
*Oriental Poppy* (Code: 3168)  
 Large, brilliant orange-scarlet flowers appear in June. It often goes dormant in summer, so combine it with companion plants that will cover the spent foliage. Drought tolerant. (2-3' x 2') Zn3.



**Papaver orientale 'Fatima'**  
*Oriental Poppy* (Code: 3163)  
 Large flamboyant flowers are ruffled light salmon with a clear pink edge. Eye-catching and beautiful. May go summer dormant. (18" x 24") Zn3.



**Papaver orientale 'Juliane'**  
*Oriental Poppy* (Code: 3175)  
 Large soft pink, spotless flowers on strong stems glow in the late spring border. May go dormant in summer. (24-30" x 18") Zn3.



**Papaver orientale 'Picotee'**  
*Oriental Poppy* (Code: 5639)  
 Delightful and distinctive poppy with white papery petals edged in brilliant orange. Beautifully detailed, silky blooms are ideal for adding a distinctive splash to the garden. Summer dormant. (28" x 18") Zn3.



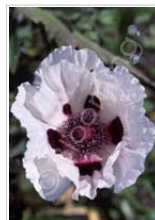
**Papaver orientale 'Pizzicato'**  
*Oriental Poppy* (Code: 6371)

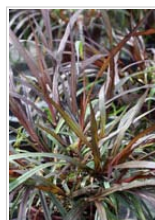

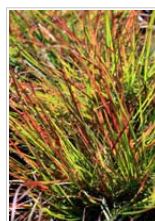

**Pennisetum 'Princess Molly'**

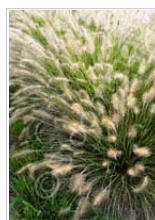
**Pennisetum alopecuroides**  
*Fountain Grass* (Code: 3202)

**Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Burgundy Bunny'**  
*Fountain Grass* (Code: 7687)

**Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Cassian'**  
*Fountain Grass* (Code: 6042)

**Pennisetum messiacum 'Red Buttons'**  
*Fountain Grass* (Code: 4712)  
 This compact grass has stunning inflorescences that emerge red, then mature to cream. The narrow foliage is green, touched with burgundy. It's superb as a groundcover or specimen in the garden border. (2-3' x 3-4') Zn6.



**Pennisetum orientale 'Karley Rose'**  
*Fountain Grass* (Code: 4436)

**Phormium 'Dusky Chief'**  
*New Zealand Flax* (Code: 6975)  
 1.5" wide smokey maroon-red, sword-like foliage has gracefully-curved tips. Striking alone or mixed in containers. (3-4' x 3-4') Zn8.



**Phormium 'Evening Glow'**  
*New Zealand Flax* (Code: 3824)  
 Brightly colored reddish-pink leaves are erect when young and become an upright, arching cluster of foliage when older. (3-4' x 3-4') Zn8.



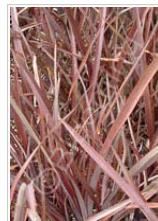
**Phormium 'Jester'**  
*New Zealand Flax* (Code: 3822)

**Pulmonaria angustifolia 'Azurea'**

**Pulmonaria longifolia**  
*Longleaf Lungwort* (Code: 5529)

**Salvia guaranitica 'Black and Blue'**

**Santolina incana 'Lemon Queen'**
*Lavender Cotton* (Code: 8201)

Soft lemon-yellow buttons top aromatic evergreen silver foliage. An excellent choice for edging or a knot garden, it takes shearing well. (30" x 36") Zn6.


**Santolina rosmarinifolia 'Morning Mist'**
*Rosemary-Leaved Santolina* (Code: 6734)

**Saponaria ocymoides**
*Soapwort* (Code: 3418)

**Satureja montana 'Nana'**
*Dwarf Winter Savory* (Code: 8266)

A wonderful evergreen container accent! Neat emerald-green foliage drapes nicely and is covered by small pale mauve or white flowers in summer. It has a spicy aroma and flavor. (4" x 18") Zn6.


**Sedum nevi 'Pink Form'**
*Stonecrop* (Code: 7699)

Tiny, blue-green, succulent leaves form evergreen rosettes with starry light pink flowers with purple anthers on 4 inch stalks. Although delicate in appearance, it's really quite tough if given very good drainage and sun. (2-3" x 6-12") Zn4.


**Sedum rupestre 'Variegata'**
*Stonecrop* (Code: 6334)

Mat-forming, blue green needle-like foliage has bright yellow growing tips. Yellow flowers appear in early summer. This evergreen, drought tolerant succulent can be used in rock gardens, borders or containers. Easy to grow in well-drained, average soil. Attractive to butterflies and is deer resistant. **Senecio greyi**
*Daisy Bush* (Code: 7250)

**Sesleria autumnalis**

**Sesleria caerulea**

**Sisyrinchium californicum 'Yellow Stone'**
*Golden Blue-eyed Grass* (Code: 5585)

This easy-care West Coast native has grass-like leaves and yellow star-like flowers in summer. Thrives in poor soil and stays neat and compact. (5-6" x 6") Zn7.


**Sisyrinchium striatum**
*Yellow-Eyed Grass* (Code: 3560)

The Iris-like leaves are arranged like a fan. 1" cream-colored flowers with yellow centers are arranged up and around sturdy stems. Very showy when in bloom. (30" x 18") Zn7.


**Solanum crispum 'Glasnevin'**
*Potato Bush* (Code: 6692)

Clusters of yellow-eyed, purple "shooting star" flowers adorn this attractive shrub throughout summer. It needs winter protection in colder areas. (10' x 9') Zn7.


**Solanum jasminoides 'Album'**
*White Potato Vine* (Code: 6150)

Graceful and vigorous twining vine with billowing clusters of yellow-eyed, white "shooting star" flowers. Profuse and long blooming, it needs a protected spot. (15' x 4") Zn8.


**Solidago 'Crown of Rays'**
*Goldenrod* (Code: 6828)

Impressive late bloomer with large sprays of tiny golden-yellow flowers. Beautiful and easy to grow, it makes a great cut flower! (24" x 18") Zn4.





**Solidago canadensis 'Baby Gold'**  
*Goldenrod* (Code: 3567)  
 Golden sprays of flowers in large curving panicles make this an essential garden addition for late summer color. Easy to grow. (24" x 18") Zn4.



**Solidago rugosa 'Fireworks'**  
*Goldenrod* (Code: 7280)  
 The golden-yellow flowers arch gracefully downward like glittering trails from exploding fireworks! This late summer/early fall bloomer is a very easy plant to grow provided it has regular moisture. (30-36" x 24-30") Zn4.



**Solidaster x luteus 'Lemore'**  
*Golden Aster* (Code: 5707)  
 Hundreds of tiny lemon-yellow flowers in dense panicles cover deep green lanceolate leaves. A lovely late bloomer for cut flowers. (36" x 12-24") Zn6.



**Stachys b. 'Countess Helen von Stein Zeppelin'**  
*Lamb's Ear* (Code: 5717)  
 Felted silver, evergreen leaves resist rot more than many in this group and have distinct veining. Leaves are longer and broader than the species. It rarely blooms. (12" x 18-24") Zn4.



**Stachys byzantina 'Primrose Heron'**  
*Lamb's Ear* (Code: 5716)  
 Large, soft, chartreuse foliage is delightful in spring. The foliage later fades to silver. It adds a wonderful touch of color to the garden year-round. (12" x 18") Zn4.



**Stachys byzantina 'Silky Fleece'**  
*Lamb's Ear* (Code: 3672)  
 A dwarf form of lamb's ear, it forms a soft dense evergreen mat that will carpet well-drained soils. Short spikes of tiny plum-colored flowers appear in summer. (4-10" x 12-18") Zn4.



**Stachys byzantina 'Silver Carpet'**  
*Lamb's Ear* (Code: 3573)  
 Fuzzy, silvery, evergreen leaves are invaluable for providing nice foliage contrast in the mixed border. This variety rarely blooms, but has a nice low & spreading habit. (8" x 24") Zn4.



**Stachys monieri**  
*Betony* (Code: 3760)  
 Grown for its flower, this Stachys has erect stems to 8", rising from neat low mounds of green foliage. Medium-pink flowers bloom over a long period. (8" x 10") Zn5.



**Stipa lessingiana 'Capriccio'**  
*Needle Grass* (Code: 4848)  
 This finely-textured green grass creates a soft, delicate appearance in mixed containers or the landscape. (14-16" x 24-30") Zn6.



**Tanacetum vulgare 'Crispum'**  
*Tansy* (Code: 3587)  
 Luxurious, finely-cut, bright green foliage makes a lovely foil for spring and summer blossoms. Small yellow button-like flowers emerge late summer. It may require staking. (30" x 24") Zn4.



**Teucrium chamaedrys**  
*Germander* (Code: 6522)  
 Neat little evergreen sub-shrub that can take trimming into mini-hedges or knot gardens. Glossy, deep green leaves and pretty lilac-pink flowers complete the picture. (15" x 15") Zn5.



**Teucrium chamaedrys 'Nanum'**  
*Germander* (Code: 8237)  
 This lovely dwarf edging plant is an excellent addition to the herb garden. The glossy, evergreen, scallop-edged foliage is aromatic and contrasts beautifully with rosy-purple flowers. (6" x 12") Zn5.



**Teucrium chamaedrys 'Summer Sunshine'**  
*Germander* (Code: 3764)  
 Beautiful bright golden, evergreen foliage has purple-pink flowers. A real eye-catcher that's sure to get lots of attention. Drought tolerant once established. (6-8" x 12-16") Zn5.



**Teucrium fruticans 'Azureum'**  
*Silver Germander* (Code: 6684)  
 Vivid blue flowers contrast nicely against silvery-white leaves on this small evergreen shrub. It prefers a sunny, sheltered position in well-drained soil. (3-4' x 3') Zn7.



**Thymus 'Gold Transparent'**  
*Creeping Thyme* (Code: 3603)  
 Shimmering gold and green foliage grows low and fast for a sun-loving, hardy, evergreen groundcover. Lilac blooms appear late summer. (3" x 12") Zn5.



**Thymus doerfleri 'Bressingham'**  
*Creeping Thyme* (Code: 5943)  
 A carpet of fuzzy gray-green, evergreen leaves and soft pink flowers makes it a dainty accent for the rockery, between pavers, or at borders edge. Best in full sun with good drainage. (4" x 18") Zn4.






**Thymus herba-barona**  
*Caraway Thyme* (Code: 8245)  
 Dark green leaves have a delightful caraway scent and flavor. Good in culinary dishes; especially stir fry and meat. It's ideal for the rock garden. (4" x 16") Zn6.





**Thymus hyemalis**



**Thymus praecox 'Coccineus'**

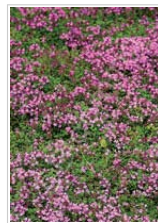

**Thymus praecox 'Minus'**  
*Miniature Creeping Thyme* (Code: 3615)

**Thymus praecox 'Nutmeg'**  
*Creeping Thyme* (Code: 8256)  
 A profusion of deep purple-carmine blooms cover this tight, deep green, evergreen groundcover in summer. It is drought tolerant and sun loving. (1" x 12") Zn4.





**Thymus praecox 'Pink Chintz'**  
*Creeping Thyme* (Code: 3609)  
 Soft, hairy, gray-green, evergreen foliage is topped by pale pink flowers in summer. It's drought tolerant and sun loving. (1-3" x 12") Zn4.


**Thymus praecox 'Reiter's Red'**

**Thymus pseudolanuginosus**  
*Woolly Thyme* (Code: 3606)  
 Soft, completely prostrate, silvery-green, evergreen foliage has pink flowers in summer. It handles foot traffic well and is excellent for use between pavers. (1" x 12") Zn4.




**Thymus pulegioides 'Foxy'**  
*Variegated Thyme* (Code: 4448)  
 Mounds of soft, shiny, cream & green-variegated evergreen foliage contrasts nicely with dark pink blooms in summer. Perfect in rockeries, along paths or the herb garden. (8" x 12") Zn7.




**Thymus thracicus 'Lavender'**  
*Lavender-Scented Thyme* (Code: 5461)  
 Wonderful needle-leaved culinary thyme has a rich fragrance similar to lavender. It can also be used as a drought tolerant, evergreen groundcover. (10" x 18") Zn5.




**Thymus vulgaris 'Dot Wells'**  
*French Thyme* (Code: 3759)  
 An upright grower ideal for the culinary garden. Pale pink flowers bloom from summer to fall over the very fragrant foliage. (6-12" x 12") Zn4.





**Thymus vulgaris 'English Wedgewood'**  
*French Thyme* (Code: 5412)  
 This lovely mound-forming, evergreen thyme has good flavor and is excellent for the culinary herb garden. Pink flowers appear in early summer. (9" x 14") Zn6.



**Thymus vulgaris 'Narrow Leaf French'**  
*French Thyme* (Code: 5460)  
 Fine gray leaves hold small white flowers during the summer. Excellent flavor for cooking. It may also be used as an evergreen groundcover or rockery accent. (12" x 18") Zn6.



**Thymus vulgaris 'Orange Balsam'**  
*Orange Thyme* (Code: 5531)  
 Wonderful orange fragrance and flavor! Small gray, evergreen leaves are topped by the tiniest, palest lavender flowers. It's both ornamental and edible. (12" x 18") Zn5.



**Thymus vulgaris 'Silver Posie'**  
*Variegated Thyme* (Code: 6860)  
 This beautiful thyme features fragrant deep green, evergreen leaves, each edged with a wide silvery-white margin. New growth appears with a nice rosy tinge. (6-10" x 18-24") Zn6.



**Thymus x 'Pink Ripple'**  
*Pink Ripple Thyme* (Code: 5430)  
 Light green, lemon-scented foliage creates a spreading evergreen carpet topped by pink flowers in summer. An excellent choice for pathways, between pavers, or in the rockery. (6" x 12") Zn5.



**Thymus x citriodorus 'Archer's Gold'**  
*Lemon Thyme* (Code: 3602)  
 Creeping thyme with brilliant golden, evergreen foliage that is especially bright in winter and spring. Excellent between pavers or spilling around stones. (2" x 12") Zn5.



**Thymus x citriodorus 'Argentus'**  
*Silver Variegated Lemon Thyme* (Code: 8253)  
 Glossy ivory and gray-green foliage adds interest to the rockery. This slow-growing variety has an excellent lemon flavor. (8" x 12") Zn5.



**Thymus x citriodorus 'Aureus'**  
*Gold Variegated Thyme* (Code: 8251)  
 Small evergreen thyme with bright gold and gray-green foliage. Wonderful strong lemon flavor combines well with many chicken or fish dishes. Perfect in containers. (8" x 12") Zn6.



**Thymus x citriodorus 'Doone Valley'**  
*Variegated Thyme* (Code: 5173)  
 Green foliage has irregular golden patches, which become red-tinted in winter. Fragrant lavender flowers appear from August through September. (4" x 12") Zn5.



**Thymus x citriodorus 'Lemon Frost'**  
*Lemon Thyme* (Code: 4160)  
 This excellent selection exudes the sweet and pure fragrance of lemons when walked upon. Profuse white flowers provide the "frost" in June and July. An excellent choice for an evergreen groundcover or between pavers. (4" x 12") Zn6.



**Thymus x citriodorus 'Lime Gold'**  
*Thyme* (Code: 7779)  
 Creeping evergreen lime-gold foliage has a citrus fragrance. Pink flowers appear in summer. Excellent when used between flagstone or in the rock garden. (2-4" x 12-18") Zn5.



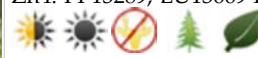
**Thymus x citriodorus 'Lime'**  
*Lime Thyme* (Code: 3761)  
 Bright chartreuse leaves brighten up any garden. It has a lovely citrus scent and pink flowers. A nice plant to border pathways or as an evergreen groundcover. (4" x 12-16") Zn5.



**Thymus x citriodorus 'Spicy Orange'**  
*Citrus-Scented Thyme* (Code: 6896)  
 This prostrate, needle-leaved thyme makes an excellent evergreen groundcover. Releasing a refreshing scent of oranges when crushed, it is perfect between pavers. (4" x 24") Zn5.



**Tiarella 'Neon Lights'**  
*Foam Flower* (Code: 4852)  
 Neon-green foliage has very black central markings topped by glowing large white flowers in spring. Leaves turn almost completely green in summer. (6-8" x 18-24") Zn4. PP13289, EU13669 Propagation Prohibited.






**Tiarella 'Sugar and Spice'**
*Foam Flower* (Code: 4142)

Glossy leaves with burgundy markings appear in summer and last through winter. Pink buds open to blush-pink flowers in spring, turning white and lasting for several weeks. (8-12" x 12") Zn4. PP16738, EU20614 Propagation Prohibited.


**Tibouchina urvilleana**
*Princess Flower* (Code: 6360)

Exotic Brazilian beauty with regal purple 3" wide blossoms and velvety, ribbed leaves. Blooms sporadically from May until frost. This tender shrub requires winter protection. (5-10' x 3-6') Zn9.


**Uncinia rubra 'Belinda's Find'**
*Red Hook Sedge* (Code: 7609)

Rich cherry-red leaf margins brighten the colorful bronze foliage. Ideal as a specimen at the front of the perennial border. It's also especially useful to brighten autumn & winter containers. (12" x 12-16") Zn8.


**Verbascum 'Dark Eyes'**
*Mullein* (Code: 4143)

Pale yellow spikes with large dark red centers bloom repeatedly. Large silver-green leaves have a rough texture and combines easily with other plants for the front of the border. (10-12" x 12") Zn5. PP16986, EU19206 Propagation Prohibited.


**Verbascum 'Jackie in Pink'**
*Mullein* (Code: 4029)

18" spires of pure pink blooms appear above large rosettes of foliage in summer and will rebloom if deadheaded. It performs best in well-drained soil. (18" x 12") Zn5. PP15735 Propagation Prohibited.


**Verbascum 'Lavender Lass'**
*Mullein* (Code: 3626)

An abundance of velvety lavender flowers top compact ruffled foliage. Loads of color! Requires good drainage and will rebloom if deadheaded. (9-24" x 14") Zn5. PP16658, PVR Propagation Prohibited.


**Verbascum phoeniceum 'Violetta'**
*Mullein* (Code: 4482)

Stunning dark purple candles rise above rosettes of fresh green leaves. Will rebloom all summer if spent flowers are removed. Prefers sun in well-drained soil. (3' x 2') Zn6.


**Veronica 'Giles van Hees'**
*Speedwell* (Code: 8015)

This dwarf variety has deep pink flower spikes from midsummer until frost. Introduced by Carroll Gardens. (6-10" x 12") Zn5.


**Veronica 'Waterperry Blue'**
*Speedwell* (Code: 7370)

Profuse sky-blue flowers bloom all spring and summer on this low-growing creeper. An excellent evergreen groundcover, the foliage turns purple in winter for added interest. (4" x 18") Zn5.


**Veronica liwanensis**
*Turkish Speedwell* (Code: 3671)

Clusters of bright blue flowers top tiny, round, glossy, evergreen leaves in summer. An excellent prostrate Veronica well suited to gardens in the Rocky Mountains and west coast. (1-3" x 24") Zn5.


**Veronica montana 'Corrine Tremaine'**
*Speedwell* (Code: 6742)

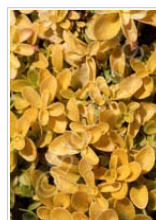
Beautiful low-growing groundcover with creamy-white and green-variegated leaves and tiny lilac flowers. Excellent selection for rockery or edge of the border. (3" x 12") Zn3.


**Veronica prostrata 'Aztec Gold'**
*Speedwell* (Code: 4041)

Bright gold, spreading mat of foliage forms a groundcover with 6" violet spikes in the spring. The foliage will turn chartreuse in partial shade. (4-6" x 12") Zn3. PP13354, EU13144 Propagation Prohibited.


**Veronica repens**
*Speedwell* (Code: 4425)

Dainty flowers of palest blue last all spring. It forms a deep green, spreading evergreen mat. An excellent lawn substitute; it fills in fast and suppresses weeds. (1" x 18") Zn5.


**Veronica repens 'Sunshine'**
*Speedwell* (Code: 4756)

Tiny yellow leaves form an incredible golden carpet similar in habit to baby tears. Dainty ice-blue flowers appear in June. It makes an excellent groundcover. (1" x 18") Zn5.





**Veronica spicata 'Royal Candles'**  
*Spike Speedwell* (Code: 8119)  
 Crowned with incredible deep violet-blue flower spikes in summer, this princely perennial is compact and floriferous. (15" x 18") Zn3. PP18932 Propagation Prohibited.



**Viburnum propinquum**  
*Chinese Viburnum* (Code: 6479)  
 Elegant compact shrub with evergreen, glossy dark green foliage. White summer flowers bloom on red stems and turn to metallic-blue berries in fall. (10-12' x 6') Zn7.



**Vinca minor 'Bowler's Variety'**  
*Periwinkle* (Code: 3790)  
 Large, deep periwinkle-blue flowers top shiny green foliage in spring. This attractive, trouble-free, spreading, evergreen groundcover can handle a variety of soils and conditions. (4-6" x 18-24") Zn4.



**Vinca minor 'Illumination'**  
*Periwinkle* (Code: 7364)  
 In spring, periwinkle-blue flowers provide bold contrast to brilliant gold leaves edged in green. Use it as trailing foliage in mixed containers or as an evergreen groundcover. (4" x 18") Zn4. PP12132 Propagation Prohibited.



**Vinca minor 'Ralph Shugert'**  
*Periwinkle* (Code: 6455)  
 Dark green foliage is edged with distinctive cream margins that set off bright blue flowers in spring. This is a marvelous evergreen groundcover. (4-6" x 18-24") Zn4. PP6960 Propagation Prohibited.



**Yucca filamentosa 'Bright Edge'**  
*Adam's Needle* (Code: 4328)  
 Succulent green leaves have sunny-gold margins and form large, spiky, drought tolerant rosettes. Tall, dangling clusters of white blooms are dramatic and showy. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (4' x 3') Zn4. PPAF Propagation Prohibited



**Yucca filamentosa 'Color Guard'**  
*Adam's Needle* (Code: 3247)  
 A brilliant gold stripe accentuates the center of each broad green leaf. At its best in late summer. Fragrant creamy-white flowers appear late spring above rose-blushed leaves. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (3' x 3') Zn5.
