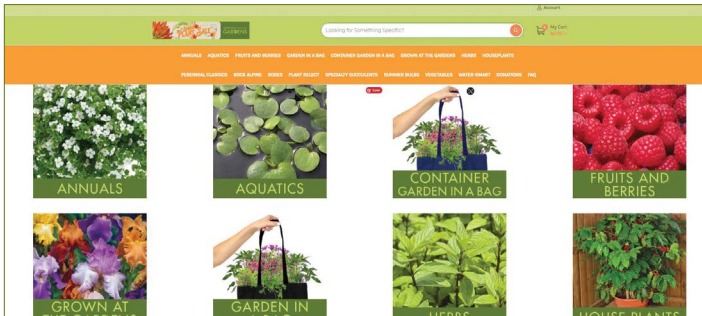


WHAT TO EXPECT FROM A VIRTUAL PLANT SALE

ONLINE STORE BASICS

- We anticipate a high volume of traffic to our online store on Tuesday, April 27. All sale selections are limited, and popular items will sell quickly.
- Items in your cart are not confirmed until the purchase is complete; on Tuesday morning, please consider making multiple purchases if you have a long shopping list.
- At checkout, enter your email address and click "CONTINUE AS GUEST." Existing Gardens membership or the Shop at the Gardens login details will not work.
- Any items no longer available will be listed near the top of the screen at checkout.

HOW TO SEARCH FOR PLANTS

- Browse each category to see all available plants in that category listed alphabetically.
- Use the search bar at the top of the page to look for individual plants (type in scientific or common name).
- You can also search by other criteria to find common traits amongst plants (low water, full sun, sweet peppers, etc.)
- Can't find something you are looking for?
 - Check the spelling!
 - Try entering only a portion of the plant name.
 - Items that are sold out will not appear when searched.

OTHER ONLINE SHOPPING TIPS

- Details such as the pot size or number of bulbs can be found beneath the name and price of each item.
- If you receive a "Page Not Available" error, refresh the page or open a new tab.
- Right-click on the image of the plant information sign to save it for future reference.

- We invite you to browse the **Shop at the Gardens**, but please note that your purchase will be made through a separate store. You can work with our staff in the Shop to coordinate your pick-up time to align with your Spring Plant Sale order pick-up.

HOW WE FULFILL ORDERS

- After the online store closes, purchases are organized in the order they will be picked up. This allows your plants to be packaged only a day or two before you come to collect them.
 - If you place multiple orders, we will prepare all your orders at the same time.
- Each order is hand-picked by a staff member or volunteer.
- We will do our best to fill every order completely. However, there are sometimes factors outside of our control that prevent us from doing so.
 - Last-minute substitutions or inventory changes from our vendors.
 - Plants arrive in a condition that does not meet our standards.
 - We will issue you a refund for any items we are unable to fulfill within two weeks of the sale.
- Plants are packed in cardboard flats or reusable bags. They are stored in tented areas to protect them until you arrive to pick up your order.

TIME TO PICK UP YOUR ORDER!

- You will receive an email on May 3 outlining details for your pick-up date and time between May 6-9.
- Pick up your order on the top deck of the parking structure at the Gardens' York Street location during your designated pick-up time.
- When you arrive, park in the designated area based on your last name. A staff member will take your first and last name and will load plants into your vehicle.
- Masks covering the mouth and nose are strongly encouraged at all times during the pick-up process.

BEACON IN SHADE



MORNING SUN/AFTERNOON SHADE

Adding a chartreuse plant to shade is like lighting up a dim room — suddenly the space glows — and when that plant is the centerpiece of a container, it invigorates everything around it. We've chosen the best of the best to be that focal point — *Aralia cordata* 'Sun King,' the 2020 Perennial Plant of the Year. Then we've encircled it with annuals that pop, including a cascading begonia that covers itself in jewel-like flowers. Add in the striking plum foliage of a Persian shield and *coleus* and the effect is a shining combination — a beacon in shade.

FOLLOW THAT NECTAR!



FULL SUN

Plant nectar-rich flowers and they will come! We've selected five plants that have what it takes to pull in pollinators. Not only are the plants eye-catching, but their flowers are shaped just right for pollinators to sip nectar and take naps between flight. They include a perennial that's so rich in nectar it was named after a pollinator, the hummingbird mint, aka *Agastache*, and another that's a favorite rest stop for traveling butterflies, *Achillea*, commonly known as yarrow.

GOES WITH EVERYTHING



PART SUN

Bold and elegant, this color combination would do Coco Chanel proud. The smoky black *Colocasias* at the center, like the fashion designer's iconic black dress, is simple and eye-catching while the white blossoms and variegated leaves accessorize it like strands of pearls. The magic of a monochromatic design is that it goes with whatever color you put near it, making it ideal for any house color. Plus, black and white draw the eye to the structure of the plants — their shapes, textures and patterns — and intensify each other.

PARADISE FOUND



AFTERNOON SHADE

Tropical leaves set the mood for this design, inspired by artist Henri Rousseau's dreamy jungle paintings. Just as Rousseau sought to paint the jungle world of his imagination, we hope to stir thoughts of paradise with this design. Red Abyssinian banana, a cousin of the banana, holds its lance-shaped leaves above a trunk-like stalk and vigorous mix of annuals. These include a *coleus* that has three distinct colors on each of its leaves and a variegated loosestrife with mango-yellow blooms. The only thing missing from the design is the face of a monkey or lion peeking out from the leaves.

THE PUNCH BOWL



FULL SUN 

Nothing screams summer like a glass of sangria, and this design, with its fiery reds and citrusy yellows, feels as bright and refreshing as the fruited drink. At the center rises a heat-loving *canna* with blood-orange blossoms and leaves so dark they could have been steeped in red wine. Encircling the *canna* is a fruity concoction of mango-colored *celosia* and a striped *thunbergia* reminiscent of sliced oranges. Like the tasty refresher, this design says cheers to summer – and, if you aren't careful, you might just reach for a punch bowl to plant it in.

THE GOLDEN HOUR



FULL SUN 

Ever wish the last hour before nightfall would never end? When clouds glow orange against a blue sky? Then this design is for you. No two colors contrast more with each other or better represent ambient light than pure orange and azure blue. We've chosen a prolific cobalt-blue *salvia* to be that sky and surrounded it with orange blossoms, lit up with tips and streaks of yellow. Then we've added in starry blooms of an *Euphorbia* and a breezy variegated grass. The result is a design that cheers the soul – and, if we're lucky, brings memories of a golden hour.

THE RELAXED SPECTATOR



FULL SUN 

Borrowing from the colors in Van Gogh's *Café Terrace at Night*, this container celebrates slowing down and taking stock of what is immediately in front of you. It uses chartreuse to soothe and enliven the design and subdued orange blends and deep purple to add warmth and depth. A variegated apple-green euphorbia with rusty leaf tips glows like Van Gogh's illuminated café, while an apricot-peach *Petchoa*, a cross between a Petunia and *Calibrachoa*, stretches out below, as if delineating the painter's terrace.

GARDEN IN A BAG

"PAINTED DESERT" WATER-SMART GARDEN ☀

Spring in the desert Southwest is all about color, form and drama! The vivid colors and strong textures can stop you in your tracks, even among the vast blue skies and red rocks of wild landscapes. Hummingbirds won't be able to resist this buffet of penstemons and *Hesperaloe*. Butterflies, moths and bees will linger all season among the long-flowering *Gaillardia* and globemallow. Lavender may not be native to the Southwest, but it's unrivaled in fragrance and enduring color. The strong forms of claret cup cactus, red yucca and New Mexico agave will just get better every year. Add a few boulders to truly echo the spirit of Southwestern landscapes. This lively mix of resilient plants will thrive in hot difficult locations with minimal water once established.

DRY SHADE WATER-SMART GARDEN ☀

Most gardeners have a few areas that are shady and dry, and just a bit more difficult to grow in. Maybe it's that area under a large evergreen, or an old silver maple, or maybe it's just a challenge to stretch a hose to as often as you'd like. Once you get this refined selection of perennials established, their requirements will be few compared to the satisfaction of your success. Relax in the shade and watch the bleeding heart and coral bells lure hummingbirds closer. Bold, mounding leaves of *Hosta* will add a lush focal point, with soft lavender flower spikes in the height of summer. Delicate leaves and flowers of *Galium* and tufts of *Carex* will soften the edges. You can trim the creamy blooms of *Anaphalis* for dried arrangements, and the evergreen leaves of the *Heuchera*, *Bergenia* and *Liriope* will endure through the winter months.
