Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Anemone hupehensis</i> 'September Charm'</p>	<p>Anemone</p>	<p>Light pink flower, yellow center –Beautiful Fall bloomer!! Great for late color in garden, every garden should have one. Part sun; tolerant of wide variety of soils Height 36 inches Zones 5-9 Late-season pollinator plant.</p>	
<p><i>Anemone</i> 'Wild Swan'</p>	<p>Anemone</p>	<p>UNIQUE!! Pure white flower with amazing blue reverse Free flowering variety; compact growing habit Part sun Height 24 inches Zones 5-9</p>	
<p><i>Aquilegia vulgaris</i> 'Black Barlow'</p>	<p>Aquilegia</p>	<p>Fully double, dark violet near black flowers. Stunning like velvet!! Shade-part shade Height 30 inches Attracts butterflies and hummingbirds Deer resistant Zones 4-8</p>	
<p><i>Aralia racemosa</i> (native)</p>	<p>Spikenard (native)</p>	<p>Very hardy, "tidy" native plant for woodland borders and even a full sun exposure. Adorned with tiny blossoms that result in tiny nodes that are very attractive. A favorite of our native plant growers. 3ft tall Very deer resistant!! Zone 4-8</p>	




<p><i>Aralia</i> 'Sun King'</p>	<p>Golden Japanese Spikenard</p>	<p>Hardy, tropical-looking beauty brightens up the shade garden with large compound bright gold leaves. A must for any garden!! Part shade 3ft tall Deer resistant Zones 4-8</p>	
<p><i>Asclepias incarnata</i> 'Cinderella'</p>	<p>Swamp Milkweed</p>	<p>Hassle free perennial offering long-season of vanilla scented rose pink flowers, followed by typical milkweed seed pods. Full sun 3-5ft tall Deer resistant; attracts butterflies, pollinators and hummingbirds. Zones 4-10</p>	
<p><i>Asclepias incarnata</i> (native)</p>	<p>Swamp Milkweed (native)</p>	<p>Hassle free perennial offering a long-season of vanilla scented rose pink flowers, followed by typical milkweed seed pods. <p><i>Asclepias tuberosa</i> (native)</p>	<p>Butterfly Weed (native)</p>	<p>Hassle free perennial offering several months of tangerine orange blooms, followed by green fruits filled with silvery white, silky seeds. Full sun 24 inches tall Deer resistant; attracts butterflies, hummingbirds and other pollinators. Zones 3-9</p>	





<p><i>Aster cordifolius</i> (native)</p>	<p>Heart Leaved Aster (native)</p>	<p>Clouds of blue flowers in early fall Tolerates more shade than most other native asters. Drought tolerant. Nice ground cover. Part sun to full shade 1-3ft tall Zones 3-8</p>	
<p>Aster Kickin 'Carmine Red'</p>	<p>Aster-Dwarf</p>	<p>Magenta red flowers with gold button center Full dense mound, blanketed with flowers late summer into fall. A “mighty mouse” in the fall garden!!! More resistant to powdery mildew than other asters. Full sun 2-3ft tall Attracts butterflies and late-season pollinators. Zones 5-9</p>	
<p>Aster Kickin 'Lilac Blue'</p>	<p>Aster-Dwarf</p>	<p>Lilac blue flowers with gold button center. Full dense mound, blanketed with flowers late summer into fall. Spectacular color!! More resistant to powdery mildew than other asters. Full sun 2-3ft tall Attracts butterflies and late-season pollinators Zones 5-9</p>	
<p>Aster 'Blue Autumn'</p>	<p>Hybrid Aster</p>	<p>Deep blue flowers with yellow center, dark green foliage. Full sun 20 inches Attracts butterflies Zones 3-8</p>	





<p><i>Aster</i> 'Alma Potschke'</p>	<p>New England Aster</p>	<p>Tall growing, hot pink flowers with yellow centers. Blooms September-October Full sun 36-48 inches tall Zones 4-8</p>	
<p><i>Astible c.</i> 'Amber Moon'</p>	<p>Aster</p>	<p>Radiant chartreuse yellow foliage with a tinge of red in spring. Best NEW Astilbe in years!! In summer the foliage turns to chartreuse green. Tall strong blush red stems topped with rose pink flowers are excellent for cutting. Part shade to shade 34-38 inches Heat tolerant, but best in shade. Zones 3-8</p>	
<p><i>Astilbe</i> 'Mighty Chocolate-Cherry'</p>	<p>Astilbe</p>	<p>Eye-catching new tall Astilbe Robust strong velvety-red flower spikes. Divided, dark-green and chocolate-brown to reddish foliage. Striking!! Blooms Mid-season Part shade to shade Height 45 inches Zones 3-8</p>	
<p><i>Astilbe</i> 'Younique Salmon'</p>	<p>Astilbe</p>	<p>Best re-flowering floriferous Astilbe. Strong fluffy salmon pink flowers plumes. Compact form excellent for container or front of border. Blooms early season. Shade 18 inches tall Zones 3-8</p>	





<p><i>Astrantia</i> 'Red Joyce'</p>	<p>Astrantia</p>	<p>Dark red flowers from late spring up to end of summer. Great cut flower and dries well. Will re-flower if cut back. Part shade to shade 20 inches Zones 4-7</p>	
<p><i>Baptisia a.</i> 'Pixie Periwinkle'</p>	<p>Dwarf False Indigo</p>	<p>Compact and rounded habit, unique bloom color - light lavender periwinkle blooms. Sun to part shade, drought tolerant, long lived perennial 24-28 inches Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Baptisia</i> 'Grape Taffy'</p>	<p>False Indigo</p>	<p>One of the most compact Baptisias to date! Dark purple flowers look like grapes on a vine. Each flower accented by a buff yellow keel. You will fall in love with this one. Full sun 2-2.5 ft tall Deer resistant, attracts butterflies, drought tolerant, long-lived perennial Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Bergenia</i> Dragonfly 'Sakura'</p>	<p>Heart Leaf Bergenia 'Sakura'</p>	<p>Flowers open light pink and mature to medium pink with dark pink veining. Oval shaped, thick green leaves. Full sun to full shade 16 inches Deer-rabbit resistant; attracts butterflies. Zones 4-9</p>	





<i>Bergenia cordifolia</i>	Pig Squeak	<p>Early blooming hardy perennial. Tough and drought resistant!! Glossy green leaves, rose pink blooms. Adds great texture to the part shade garden. Easy to grow. Part shade 10-15 inches Deer resistant Zones 2-9</p>	<p>Also try: Dwarf cultivars like</p>  <p>'Sakura'.</p>
<i>Brunnera m. 'Variegata'</i>	Siberian bugloss	<p>Green foliage with broad creamy white edges, a staple for the shady garden!! Tiny sky blue flowers that resemble forget-me-nots. Blooms May to June Part shade to shade 12-15 inches Rabbit resistant Zones 3-9</p>	
<i>Buddleia 'Little Nugget'</i>	Butterfly Bush	<p>Impressive NEW Buddleia with brilliant gold foliage, and contrasting magenta purple flowers. 5-6 inch long flowers will deepen to blue purple with age and will appear earlier than typical buddleia. Full sun 2-2.5 ft tall Deer resistant; attracts butterflies and hummingbirds Zones 5-9</p>	
<i>Buddleia 'Magenta Munchkin'</i>	Butterfly Bush	<p>Name says it all—a compact form with 7-8 inch fuchsia red flowers! Produces tons of flower panicles when in boom Full sun 2.5 -3 ft Deer resistant; attracts butterflies and hummingbirds Zones 5-10</p>	<p>What's not to love? –RF☺</p> 

<p><i>Campanula americana</i> (native)</p>	<p>American (tall) Bellflower (native)</p>	<p>Biennial, or short lived perennial, native to moist open woods, moist meadows, stream banks or ditches. Blue flowers from June to August Self-seeds. Full sun to part shade. Zones 3-8</p>	
<p><i>Campanula glomerata</i> 'Genti Blue'</p>	<p>Clustered Bellflower</p>	<p>Compact habit, clustered bell shaped, beautiful violet blue flowers bloom profusely from late spring to mid-summer. A garden favorite!! Sun to part sun 15-16 inches Zones 3-9</p>	
<p><i>Campanula rotundifolia</i> (native)</p>	<p>Harebell (native)</p>	<p>Delicate looking, with beautiful blue-violet bell shaped flowers, opening over several weeks. Blooms in summer Tough and drought tolerant Full to part sun 1-2 ft tall Zones 3-7</p>	






<p><i>Cimicifuga</i> 'James Compton'</p>	<p>Black Snake Root</p>	<p>Young foliage is bronze-green darkens to deep purple as it matures. Deliciously fragrant bottlebrush flowers are white with a hint of pink. Blooms late summer to mid fall. One of the BEST late-fall pollinator plants!! Shade to part shade 3 ft tall, Deer, rabbit resistant, attracts butterflies Zones 3-8</p>	
<p><i>Clematis r.</i> 'Serious Black'</p>	<p>Bush Clematis</p>	<p>Bush type that can stand on its own. Extraordinary dark purple new foliage that matures to deep olive green. Antique ivory colored blossoms, appears in clusters. Blooms late spring to early summer, re-blooms in mid-summer. Full sun to part shade. 4-6 ft tall Attracts butterflies. Zones 2-9</p>	<p>New!! Amazing clematis!</p> 
<p><i>Coreopsis a.</i> "Nana"</p>	<p>Mouse Ear Coreopsis</p>	<p>Bright orange yellow blooms with dark green oval evergreen foliage. Full sun 6-12 inches Blooms May to July Great Pollinator plant! Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Coreopsis</i> Big Bang 'Mercury Rising'</p>	<p>Tick Seed</p>	<p>Hardy reliable showy plant, with deep wine red blooms throughout the summer. Blooms from June to October. Full sun 6-18 inches Deer resistant; attracts butterflies and other pollinators Zone 5-9</p>	





<p><i>Coreopsis</i> 'Red Satin'</p>	<p>Tick Seed</p>	<p>Solid deep wine red to ruby red flowers cover the deep green thread leaf tightly mounded foliage. A grand plant even in containers!! Blooms early to late summer Full sun 15-18 inches Deer resistant; attracts butterflies Zones 5-9</p>	
<p><i>Delphinium</i> 'Million Dollar Bush'</p>	<p>Hybrid Bee Delphinium</p>	<p>Large sturdy spikes of semi double to double light rose flowers with white central bees. Dark green foliage, very heat tolerant. Blooms early summer to early fall Full to part sun. 2.5-3 ft tall Deer and rabbit resistant; attracts butterflies and hummingbirds. Zones 3-8</p>	
<p><i>Dianthus</i> 'Raspberry Swirl'</p>	<p>Pinks</p>	<p>Vibrant pink flowers with a spicy clove like fragrance cover the compact mound of evergreen glaucous, blue gray leaves in early summer. Often re-blooms in early fall. Full to part sun. 7 inches Deer resistant; attracts butterflies. Zones 5-9</p>	
<p><i>Echinacea</i> Big Sky 'Harvest Moon'</p>	<p>Coneflower</p>	<p>Well branched and vigorous selection with deep gold flowers. Blooms July to September Full sun 24-30 inches Zones 4-9 Pollinator magnet!!</p>	





<p><i>Echinacea</i> 'Cheyenne Spirit'</p>	<p>Coneflower</p>	<p>Incredible color range on first year flowering cultivars including tomato red, near fluorescent orange, magenta, golden yellow and white. Height varies by color. All are well branched bushy plants. Blooms early summer to early fall Full sun 22-30 inches Deer resistant, attracts butterflies and other pollinators. This plant just GLOWS!! Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Echinacea</i> 'Fatal Attraction'</p>	<p>Coneflower</p>	<p>Deep magenta flowers on strong stems. Blooms July and August Full sun 24-26 inches Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Echinacea p.</i> 'Meringue'</p>	<p>White Coneflower</p>	<p>White double flowers with yellowish centers. Long tubular disk florets. Blooms July & August Full sun 18-20 inches Zones 5-9</p>	
<p><i>Echinacea p.</i> 'Ruby Star'</p>	<p>Purple Coneflower</p>	<p>Intense carmine-lavender petals emerge from the cone in a flat plane. Blooms July to September Full sun 36-40 inches Zones 4-9</p>	





<p><i>Echinops b.</i> 'Blue Glow'</p>	<p>Globe Thistle</p>	<p>A clumpy perennial that is very easy to grow, but not invasive. Intense blue 1.5 inch spheres appear on tall stems. Hairy silver greens leaves and unbranched stems. Blooms early to late summer Full to part sun. 3-4 ft tall Deer and rabbit resistant. Zones 3-8</p>	
<p>FERN <i>Athyrium f.</i> 'Lady in Red'</p>	<p>Lady Fern</p>	<p>Dark green upright fronds with deep burgundy stems. Shade to part shade. 30-36 inches Rabbit resistant Zones 2-8</p>	
<p>FERN <i>Dryopteris e.</i> 'Brilliance'</p>	<p>Brilliance Autumn Fern</p>	<p>Lustrous young orange fronds light up against the glossy deeper green coloring of the mature fronds. Part sun to full shade. 2 ft tall Rabbit and deer resistant. Zones 5-9</p>	
<p><i>Geranium</i> 'Anne Thompson'</p>	<p>Geranium</p>	<p>Remarkable radiant gold tinted foliage. 1 inch large vibrant dark magenta flowers with dark eye zones. Easy care perennial. Shade to part shade. 16 inches Zones 4-8</p>	





<i>Geum coccineum</i>	Boris Avens	Orange flowers with yellow centers above textured, velvety foliage. Blooms May to June Full sun 9-15 inches Zones 4-9	
<i>Geum r.</i> 'Flames of Passion'	Avens	Compact plant, red flowers with orange hint on deep wine red stems. Blooms April/May Full sun 12-15 inches Zones 5-9	
<i>Geum</i> 'Totally Tangerine'	Avens	Large bright orange flowers bloom April to July. Full to part sun 24-30 inches Zones 4-8	
<i>Gillenia trifoliata</i> (Native)	Bowman's Root	Lacy white flowers, nice filler. Easy to grow native for bright shade or partial sun. Tolerates tree root competition if there is a nice layer of organic mulch. Blooms late spring. Part sun to full shade. 2-3 ft tall Deer resistant. Zones 4-8	
GRASS <i>Schizachyrium s.</i> 'Blue Paradise' Native Cultivar	Little Blue Stem (Native Cultivar)	Upright and columnar habit stays upright all season. Silvery blue leaves in summer, deep wine fall color. Full sun. 3-3.5 ft tall Deer resistant. Zones 3-9	





<p>GRASS <i>Sporobolus heterolepis</i> (Native)</p>	<p>Prairie Drop Seed (Native)</p>	<p>Refined native prairie grass with a soft, fountain like look. Thread like green leaves turn golden orange in fall. Fragrant pinkish brown flowers that appear atop tall arching stems. Full sun 2-3 ft tall Heat and drought tolerant. Winter interest. Zones 3-8</p>	
<p><i>Helianthus</i> 'Sombrero'</p>	<p>Helen's Flower, AKA Sneezeweed</p>	<p>Bright yellow cone and even brighter yellow ray petals contrast with the dark green foliage. Blooms mid-summer to early fall. Full sun 20 inches Attracts butterflies and other pollinators Zones 3-9</p>	
<p><i>Helleborus</i> 'Blushing Bridesmaid'</p>	<p>Lenten Rose</p>	<p>2-2.5 inch double white flowers with raspberry pink veining and picotee edge. Blooms early to mid-spring. Shade to part shade. 18-24 inches Deer and rabbit resistant Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Helleborus</i> 'Maid of Honor'</p>	<p>Lenten Rose</p>	<p>2-3 inch double flowers range from light to dark pink. Blooms early to mid-spring Shade to part shade. 18-24 inches Deer and rabbit resistant. Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Helleborus</i> 'Sandy Shores'</p>	<p>Lenten Rose</p>	<p>2.5-3 inch single pale apricot flowers with a lovely rosy pink color on the backs. Blooms early to mid-spring Shade to part shade 18-24 inches Deer and rabbit resistance. Zones 4-9</p>	





<p><i>Heuchera</i> 'Fire Alarm'</p>	<p>Coral Bells</p>	<p>One of the best reds to date. Unbelievable color!! Grows vigorously, forms a full dense clump of large rounded lobed leaves. Spring and fall color is fiery red mellowing slightly to mahogany red in summer. Dark red stems, pink flowers. Full sun, part sun, shade. 9-13 inches Attracts butterflies and other pollinators. Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Heuchera</i> 'Grape Expectations'</p>	<p>Coral Bells</p>	<p>Excellent grower with great hardiness for Michigan gardens. Forms a dense, upright mound of broad, thick durable vibrant grape purple leaves with black veins. Creamy white flowers. Full sun, part sun, to full shade. 12 inches Deer resistant; attracts butterflies. Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Heucherella</i> 'Gold Zebra'</p>	<p>Foamy Bells</p>	<p>Golden yellow leaves display a heavy smattering of bright red pigment that nearly covers the entire surface of the dissected leaves. Small white flowers. Full to part shade 10-18 inches Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Heucherella</i> 'Pink Fizz'</p>	<p>Foamy Bells</p>	<p>Durable perennial for sun or shade. Large deeply lobed soft green leaves, are lightly silvered with prominent purple veins. Pure pink flowers pop open from hot pink buds on densely packed flower wands. Full to part sun to shade. 8-13 inches Zones 4-9</p>	





<i>Hibiscus</i> 'Vintage Wine'	Rose Mallow	<p>Near black buds open to huge 7 inch scarlet red flowers that simmer in the sun. Dark green heart shaped leaves form a densely upright columnar clump. Blooms late summer to early fall Full to part sun. 4-4.5 ft tall Deer resistant. Zones 4-9</p>	
<i>Hosta</i> 'Firn Line'	Hosta	<p>Heart shaped blue leaves with wide, white margins, lavender flowers. Full to part shade. 16 inches Zones 3-9</p>	
<i>Hosta</i> 'Lakeside Paisley Print'	Hosta	<p>Oval shaped yellow leaves with a wavy blue green margin the feathery pattern of the yellow center does make this hosta unique. Lilac flowers. Full to part sun. 16 inches Zones 3-8</p>	
<i>Hydrophyllum virginianum</i> (Native)	Virginia Waterleaf (Native)	<p>Spreads readily, makes a good ground cover in moist areas. White blooms in summer. Full sun to part shade. Less than 2 ft tall. Zones 4-9</p>	





<p><i>Iris sibirica</i> 'Butter and Sugar'</p>	<p>Siberian Iris</p>	<p>Yellow and white flowers. Full sun 28 inches Rabbit resistant Zones 3-9</p>	
<p><i>Iris sibirica</i> 'Concord Crush'</p>	<p>Siberian Iris</p>	<p>Double blue violet flowers with lighter center. Full sun 28 inches Rabbit resistant Zones 3-9</p>	
<p><i>Iris versicolor/virginiana</i> (Native)</p>	<p>Blue Flag Iris (Native)</p>	<p>An elegant and long lived perennial with blue-violet flowers Excellent for wet areas. Blooms in late spring Full to part sun. 2-3 ft tall Zones 2-7</p>	
<p><i>Iris</i> 'Willamette Mist'</p>	<p>Bearded Iris</p>	<p>Floriferous variety, 6 to 8 buds per stem. Soft blue ruffled flowers with deep blue centers. Full sun 39 inches Rabbit resistant. Zones 3-9</p>	





<p><i>Leucanthemum</i> 'Real Neat'</p>	<p>Shasta Daisy</p>	<p>Fluted white petals in multiple rows around a bright yellow center. Neat and Tidy. Full sun 14-16 inches Blooms June-July Zones 5-8</p>	
<p><i>Ligularia</i> 'Bottle Rocket'</p>	<p>Ligularia</p>	<p>Dense clump of thicker serrated green leaves with mustard yellow flower spikes held on chocolate stems just at the top of foliage. Blooms mid-summer Part sun 28-34 inches, Super tidy! Deer resistant; attracts butterflies and other pollinators. Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Ligularia</i> 'King Kong'</p>	<p>Big Leaf Ligularia</p>	<p>Dark foliage with leaves 16 inch across. New leaves are glossy black purple that mellow to burgundy purple. Golden daisy like flowers. Best in morning sun Blooms late summer-NEW! Part sun 3-4 ft tall Deer resistant; attracts butterflies and other pollinators. Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Lilium asiatic</i> 'Elgrado'</p>	<p>Asiatic Lily</p>	<p>Compact heavy blooming variety, upward facing fragrant flowers. Great for container or cut flower use. Very reliable and will multiply. Full to part sun. 18 inches Zones 3-8</p>	





<p><i>Lilium</i> (double oriental) 'Roselily Elena'</p>	<p>Oriental Lily</p>	<p>Dark pink fragrant flowers, with yellow green throat. Double!! Full to part sun 28 inches Zones 3-10</p>	
<p><i>Lobelia siphilitica</i> (Native)</p>	<p>Blue Lobelia (Native)</p>	<p>Blue flowers in late summer. Super tidy plant with long bloom time- self-seeds freely when given the chance. You won't regret this one!! Full sun to part shade 2-3 ft tall Attracts hummingbirds and pollinators. Zones 4-8</p>	
<p><i>Lupinus</i> 'Popsicle Series' Mixed</p>	<p>Lupine</p>	<p>A delightful mix of blue, purple, yellow, red, pink and bicolor flowers born on sturdy stems. Full to part sun 18-24 inches, Attracts butterflies & humming birds. Zones 3-9</p>	
<p><i>Monarda d.</i> 'Marshall's Delight'</p>	<p>Bee Balm</p>	<p>Mildew resistant, with bright pink blooms. Reliable standard in Monardas. Blooms June-July Full to part sun 30-36 inches Great pollinator plant! Zones 4-9</p>	





<p><i>Monarda</i> 'Grape Gumball'</p>	<p>Bee Balm</p>	<p>Vibrant magenta flowers and mildew resistant foliage. Super tidy. Full to part sun 20-24 inches Deer resistant; attracts bees, butterflies & humming birds Zones 4-9</p>	
<p><i>Monarda</i> 'Rockin Raspberry'</p>	<p>Bee Balm</p>	<p>Deep raspberry flowers and mildew resistant foliage. Full to part sun 20 inches Deer resistant; attracts pollinators, butterflies & humming birds Zones 4-9</p>
