Naturally Grown Natives

What is a native?

A native is an indigenous plant primarily grown from seed collected locally. This ensures genetic diversity for each species. Consequently, there is no standard for these plants and they are allowed to grow “naturally”. The Almighty Architect designs each one individually and without human intervention. Thus, beauty is in the eye of the beholder on this type of nursery stock.

Where to use a native?

Primary uses are for reforestation, wetlands mitigation, reclamation projects and natural landscapes. Other uses include habitat creation, biological corridors, nutrient management, carbon sequestration, erosion control, windbreaks, snow fence, water filtration, noise abatement, biomass and biofuel production, and nursery stock liners.

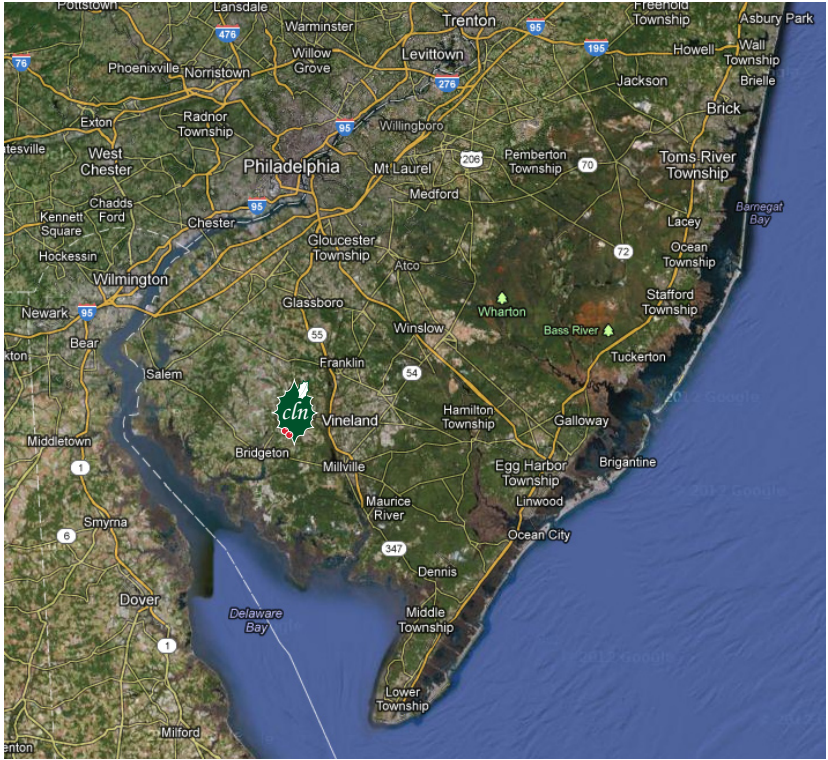
