G. 'Adam'..... A fantastic new offering from the garden of Veronica Cross with the outers marked heavily in green from top to bottom. Named after Adam Greathead.	\$240
G. 'Anne Baring' ..... A newer hybrid selection with an unusual bold dark green inner mark, consisting of a heavy basal mark that just touches a thin apical mark. Nicely textured bright white outers.	\$40
G. 'Ballerina' ..... A pretty and very tidy double flower found by Phil Cornish in Gloucestershire in 1991.	\$40
G. 'Barnes' ..... A very nice fall-blooming <i>G. elwesii</i> selection which dates to 1928. Nicely shaped flowers and a bold inner mark.	\$25
G. 'Baytop' ..... This is larger and showier than typical <i>G. rizehensis</i> , but equally early and often at its best by mid-late January. It was first distributed by Richard Nutt at one of his Snowdrop Lunches.	\$25
G. 'Belles Etoiles' ..... Six equal segments with the tips marked in green. A stunning <i>G. nivalis</i> selection by Johan Mens.	\$140
G. 'Bess' ..... A large vigorous hybrid selected by Daphne Chappell from the garden of Helen Milford. The inner segment mark is a broad 'V' slightly upturned at the ends.	\$25
G. 'Big Bertha' ..... A fine recent selection of <i>G. elwesii</i> from Gill Richardson, this has very large flowers with green tips and a full inner mark.	\$60
G. 'Bill Bishop' ..... This is one of the sought after large-flowered snowdrops with huge and thickly sculptured outer petals, so heavy that they often bend the stems back close to the ground. Early flowering. Bill Bishop was a superintendent of the Harrogate Parks department in the 1980's.	\$20
G. 'Blonde Inge' ..... A single <i>G. nivalis</i> with a yellow inner mark and green ovary. Found in Germany and a good grower.	\$20
G. 'Bryan Hewitt' ..... A poculiform <i>G. plicatus</i> found at Mydellton House. Rarely offered.	\$70
G. 'Das Gelbe Vom Ei'..... From Hagen Englemann, this form of <i>G. nivalis</i> has an intense golden yellow mark on the inner segment.	\$240
G. 'David Culp' ..... We are very pleased to offer this rare and beautiful yellow <i>G. gracilis</i> seedling. Named for its finder and a favorite at Brandywine Cottage. Not easy to grow well.... but beauty has its price!	\$300
G. 'Double Orange Star' ..... A double form of 'Orange Star' from Olivier Vico. Quite rare.	\$100
G. 'Ecusson d' Or' ..... A wonderful find by Mark Brown in 2002, one of the most desirable maybe even the Holy Grail of snowdropping, combining yellow tips to inner and outer segments. Ecusson is a tiny hamlet of four houses in Normandy, and French for shield.	\$60

G. 'Emma Thick' ..... A very nice, green-tipped variety found by and named for the galanthophile Emma Thick.	\$50
G. 'Eric Fisher' ..... From John Morley at North Green, this large-flowered form of <i>G. plicatus</i> has 4 outer and 4 inner segments when established, most enchanting and showy as a clump.	\$90
G. 'Foghorn Leghorn' ..... A large form, as the name suggests, of <i>G. elwesii</i> selected by Stephen Jackson.	\$90
G. 'Golden Fleece' ..... The first yellow-marked inverse poculiform bred by Joe Sharman of Monksilver Nursery. Spectacular!	\$180
G. <i>gracilis</i> ..... A good form of this small species snowdrop. Charming.	\$30
G. 'Green Tear' ..... Found in Holland, this amazing <i>G. nivalis</i> has many longitudinal veins on the outer segment each brushed with pale green.	\$160
G. 'Hill Poe' ..... A large-flowered, tidy double found in Ireland in the early 1900s. This often has five outer segments.	\$30
G. 'Hughes Emerald' ..... An early flowering <i>G. elwesii</i> with large, green-tipped outers. Selected in New Zealand and named for the plantsman Stan Hughes.	\$100
G. 'Joe Sharman' ..... A beautiful virescent form of <i>G. plicatus</i> with an all-green inner segment. Early and vigorous.	\$300
G. 'John Gray' ..... A hybrid that flowers in January most years. The large flower with a beautiful inner segment mark is carried on a long pedicel. An elegant favorite of many galanthophiles.	\$25
G. 'Kermode Bear' ..... A beautiful, large-flowered poculiform <i>G. elwesii</i> from Cal Mateer in Canada.	\$150
G. 'Laubfrosch' ..... An early flowering form of <i>G. elwesii</i> with bright green (rather than glaucous) leaves. The name is German for tree frog.	\$180
G. 'Little Greeny' ..... A strong growing hybrid of <i>G. nivalis</i> and <i>G. plicatus</i> with a green inner segment. Quickly makes a fine clump.	\$30
G. 'Margaret Biddulph' ..... A lovely virescent <i>G. elwesii</i> from Rodmarton Manor. Rarely offered.	\$130
G. 'Miss Prissy' ..... A charming <i>G. elwesii</i> double with pointed, narrow outers and neat, frilly inners.	\$50
G. 'Mrs. Thompson' ..... A robust and erratic hybrid. From season to season this may have three, four, or five outers. Or two flowers to a scape. Always striking.	\$30

G. 'Northern Lights' ..... A newer virescent hybrid in which the whole flower glows a pale green. A very special selection by the renowned galanthophile and plantsman, Andy Byfield.	\$160
G. 'Orange Star' ..... Ruben Billiet and Olivier Vico's stunning discovery from Northern France combines two features for the first time. The flowers have variably three, four or five narrowed outer segments but most extraordinarily, the inner segments are converted to enlarged versions of anthers which together with the flower form, inspired the name.	\$80
G. 'Peardrop' ..... A tall, single hybrid with a fine fragrance from the late plantsman Cliff Curtis. The outers develop long "claws" as the flower ages. Vigorous.	\$30
G. 'Percy Picton' ..... A <i>G. plicatus</i> selection with a very long pedicel and large flowers with nicely marked inner segments. A good grower, it often produces two flower scapes per bulb.	\$20
G. 'Phil Cornish' ..... A lovely selection from the garden of the great galanthophile Phil Cornish. Wonderful all green inners with outers heavily marked with bright green.	\$70
G. 'Pieces of Eight' ..... Found together with Long John Silver, this is more buried treasure from Veronica Cross' garden. A vigorous plant with paddle shaped outer petals, nicely slimmed at the base to show the darkly marked inner segments but wide below to accommodate the broad flash of green. The flowers hang gracefully from a nicely arched pedicel. Perfection?	\$110
G. 'Pumpot' ..... The first inverse poculiform <i>G. nivalis</i> , this was found in 1995 by Joerg Lebsa as an isolated example in a stand of its species in Dresden Botanic Garden. Since then, 'Pumpot' which is named after a green-garbed character in Sorb mythology, has been passed between collectors. This slender snowdrop is a perfect example of its floral morphology, the outer segments showing a solid apical V to U-shaped marking over a shallow sinus whilst their inner surface shows the green lines running to the base. The inner segments are similarly marked and slightly shorter.	\$100
G. 'Rev. Hailstone' ..... A tall, early flowering hybrid with large, elongated flowers. A strong grower with good garden presence early in the season.	\$20
G. 'Rising Sun' ..... A special early flowering <i>G. elwesii</i> with bold green marks at the tips of the outer segments.	\$160
G. 'Rodmarton Arcturus' ..... Selected at Rodmarton Manor, this quality snowdrop has very large, rounded flowers held on short scapes. Clumps up quickly.	\$40
G. 'Rosemary Burnham' ..... Originally from British Columbia where <i>G. elwesii</i> has become naturalized in a few estate gardens, this received much acclaim when first exhibited in 1998. This amazing virescent form is so covered in pale green lines on the outer petals that the effect is of a pale green wash.	\$70
G. 'Saraband' ..... A fine hybrid selection from Brian Ellis that produces two flowers per scape once established.	\$120

G. 'Smaragdsplitter' ..... An amazing early flowering from of <i>G. elwesii</i> , the added attraction are the unusual green flashes on the outer segments.	\$80
G. 'Straffan' ..... An old hybrid found in Ireland in 1858. Relatively easy to grow, it often produces two flowers from a bulb very late in the season. The inner segment mark is often described as being like a Chinese bridge.	\$25
G. 'Turncoat' ..... A tall inverse poculiform seedling from Richard Bashford and Valerie Bexley. Large, green-marked outer segments turn upwards and outwards.	\$70
G. 'Walker Canada' ..... A large, substantial flower discovered in the garden of the late Richard Nutt after his death. Its earlier origins are a mystery.	\$40
G. 'Welsh Whiskers' ..... This playful selection from Wales produces extra petals from above and below the ovary.	\$25
G. 'Wilhelm Bauer' ..... A <i>G. nivalis</i> selection from Rudi Bauer and named for his father this has an elongated flower with the apical half of the outers shaded green.	\$60
G. 'Wind Turbine' ..... An unusual seedling from Jo Hynes in Devon. This has widely flared outer segments, hence the name, and two separate inner green marks.	\$120
G. 'Wol Staines' ..... A fabulous newer snowdrop from Glen Chantry with outers unusually marked in green. A most handsome snowdrop that featured on the cover of Anne Repnow's book and was praised in her presentation at the 2021 Galanthus Gala.	\$190
G. 'Wonston Double' ..... A <i>G. nivalis</i> with small, late double flowers packed full of inner segments. From Lewis Palmer's garden.	\$30
