



# Catalogue Hazelnuts The genus *Corylus*





# Hazelnoten / Het geslacht Corylus

The hazel can be 8m high, depending on the growth power of the variety. The growth can be steep, wide, open or closed. Mostly with several stems per shrub, therefore the vase shape is suitable.

Therefore there will be easy formed wild shoots; these should be removed at least once a year.

## Soil type

The hazel is growing at its best on a peaty moist eutrophic soil and a ph of 4 till 7.

The pruning should be focused on sufficient penetration of light in the shrub.

Therefore weeding out is a good method.



# Corylus avellana 'Merveille de Bollwiller'

This is a good cross-pollinator.

The big tasty fruit are two centimetre big nuts which are ripe in September/October.

Cross-pollination is necessary



# Corylus avellana 'Cosford'

This is a good cross-pollinator.

The big tasty fruit are till two centimetre big nuts which are ripe in September/October.

Cross pollination is necessary.

They are surrounded by a cup-shaped dentate leaf covering.





# Corylus avellana 'Hallische Riesen' / 'Geant de Halle'

The variety Hallische Riesen is originating from Germany.

Has a big wide conical tasty fruit. Tasty when roasted.

Is at a younger age productive.

The Hallische Riesen produces better if there are planted more varieties of the hazelnut.



# Corylus avellana 'Fruhe von Frauenhof'

The variety 'Fruhe von Frauenhof' is originating from Germany.

Has medium size tasty fruit.

Is at a younger age productive.

Growing shape: shrub shape (or vase shape at stem)

The 'Fruhe von Frauenhof' produces better if there are planted more varieties of the hazelnut.





# Corylus avellana 'Einoa nr. 1'

The variety 'Einoa nr. 1' is a breeding from Edmont Kwanten and is originating from Groningen.

Has medium size tasty fruit and is very productive and a fertile variety.

A strong grower, shrub shape 'Fruehe von Frauenhof' produces better if there are planted more varieties of the hazelnut.





# Corylus avellana 'Lange Spaanse'

The Corylus Avellana 'Long Spanish' is a well-known hazel.

The hazelnuts are oblong and big, very good taste.

The shrub grows out wide, and remains carrying fruits for a long time.

The variety is very fertile, produces better if there are planted more varieties of the hazelnut.





# Corylus avellana 'Nottingham Fruehe'

The hazelnut 'Vroege van Nottingham' is a good big fruity hazelnut with well filled nuts. The shrub grows out wide, and remains carrying fruits for a long time. The variety is very fertile, produces better if there are planted more varieties of the hazelnut.





# Corylus avellana 'Purpurea'

Corylus avellana 'Purpurea' is a red leaf hazel.

The variety produces fruit with a red coloured cupule but is not very fertile and therefore is mostly planted as an ornamental hazel.

A strong grower, shrub shaped, produces better if there are planted more varieties of the hazelnut.





# Corylus avellana 'Rode Zellernoot'

The *Corylus avellana* 'Rode Zellernoot' gets in spring beautiful red/brown leaves. It's a pretty productive shrub with well filled nuts. This is a special species of the *Corylus* species.
