Blue Ripple™

Blue Ripple™ is a prunina hybrid developing attractive clumps of broad, light blue foliage. Ideal for creating dramatic effect.
Full sun to part shade.
H 35cm x 30cm

Cassa Blue® DBB03(℗) is a caerulea cultivar with rich blue compact foliage and it is one of the longest flowering Dianellas available with purple and yellow flower spikes from Sept through Nov.
Full sun to part shade.
H 50cm x 40cm

Dianella are tough, popular Australian native grasses. They have blue flowers in Spring often followed by purple/blue berries. Once established they only require the occasional water during long dry spells and tolerate dry and cold conditions well.

They make excellent landscaping plants creating contrast in structural shapes. When choosing a Dianella consider foliage colour and how big they will grow to suit the site.

Blue Stream™ is a prunina cultivar. It is an attractive grower forming clumps of tall, broad, light blue foliage. Well suited to container planting.

Breeze® DCNC0(℗)

Breeze® DCNC0(℗) is a caerulea cultivar tidier than other forms with no messy canes. Quick to establish making it ideal for filling gaps and outcompeting weeds.

Cherry Red(℗) is a tasmanica cultivar featuring cherry red flower stems against broad, deep green leaves. A great variety for containers. Frost tolerant.

Wyeena® TAS300 (D)

Wyeena® TAS300 (D) is a tasmanica cultivar bred to have cleaner foliage than other variegated foliage varieties. It is a strong grower, outcompeting weeds and tolerating frost. Popular for both commercial and residential projects. H 90cm x 90cm



Revelation® DRG04 (D)

Revelation® DRG04 (D) is a revoluta cultivar with blue green strap like leaves. It's versatility sees it tolerate periodic wet feet, dry conditions and frost. H 50cm x 50cm



Little Rev™ DR5000 (D)

Little Rev™ DR5000 (D) is a revoluta cultivar with compact blue-grey foliage. It's modern, compact form make it well used for both residential and commercial applications. Coastal, drought and frost tolerant. H 30-40cm x 30-40cm

Kentlyn is a revoluta cultivar bred for it's upright habit and slim green foliage. It is tough and quick growing. Kentlyn is both tolerant to coastal conditions and drought. H 80cm x 80cm

Dianella revoluta is the original old favourite with strappy green foliage. It is a good spreading hardy variety that is well suited to covering larger areas. Clusters of bright blue flowers are followed by glossy blue berries in spring.
