Tree types: standard trees | **Topiary on stem:** roof-trained, vase, pleached

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: corymbose, striking, scented | **Flower colour:** daffodil | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, dentate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, green | **Fruits:** discrete, drupe | **Fruit colour:** grey-green | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** red-brown, green | **Twigs:** bare
