TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, shade trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 15 - 20 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** red-violet | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, polished | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, winged, nut | **Fruit colour:** pale brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey
