Getty White has dense clusters of white flowers on erect 36cm stems that rise above the evergreen foliage. The plant forms large clumps of bulbs that eventually produce multiple stems of flowers. 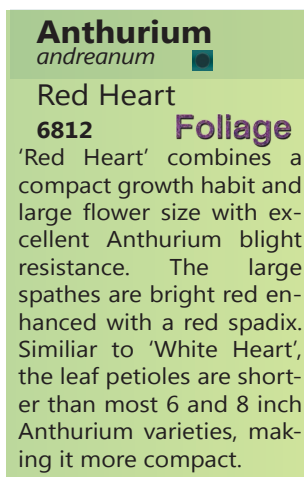

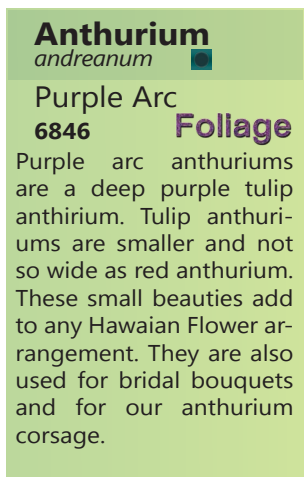

Medium sized flowers. The Snow King® has beautiful snow white flowers that contrast greatly against the nearly black/green leaf. A very unique and most desired colour combination. The flower keeps its white colour for a long time and as it ages, pink veins develop around the base of the spadix. Later on the flowers get a sort of pink/green dotted pattern.

The roots develop bulbs filled with water that allows the plant to survive drier periods.

Highsun is committed to maintaining the highest level of customer service and product quality. If you have an issue with our products, we want to know about it as soon as possible so that we can work to resolve the issues both internally and with our vendors and distribution channels.

**Please determine the type of claim/claims you would like to make and follow instructions below:**

**Delivery:** A delivery claim may include late or non-delivery of product, visible damage to a shipping container, material damaged by temperature, missing items, trays or cartons, unordered material included in a shipment or any other delivery issues

- Contact Highsun within 24 hours of receipt
- Include:
  - Photos clearly identifying the issue
  - Batch and item number of the goods
  - Con-note number and/or delivery time
  - Order or Invoice number

**Invoice:** An invoice claim may include incorrect pricing, incorrect freight charge, incorrect miscellaneous charge or other price or invoice issue.

- Contact Highsun within 48 hours of receipt of invoice

## Plugs Quality and Growing Claims

**Quality:** A quality claim may include suspected disease issue, suspected fertility issue, poor root development, incorrect plant size or tray size, pest issue or any additional quality issues

- Contact Highsun within 48 hours of receipt
- Include:

  - Batch and item number of the goods
  - Con-note number and/or delivery time
  - Order or Invoice number

**Growing:** A growing complaint may include plants not performing to type, incorrect or deformed flowering or other growing issue which appears after the initial receipt of the goods.

- Contact Highsun as soon as the problem becomes apparent
- We will request that photos are provided to help diagnose the problem as best as possible
- Issues to be discussed at the time of lodging the complaint:
  - Conditions of the growing area
  - Environment of the growing area
  - Water quality and media quality
- We may require further plant or media testing to help determine the growing problem at hand

## Seeds Quality Claims

**Quality:** A quality claim may include poor germination or vigour, incorrect plant type to the variety ordered, or other quality issue

- Contact Highsun as soon as the problem becomes apparent.
- Time limits may apply:
  - Vigour and Germ: Up to 3 months from the delivery date
- We may request that photos and samples from the product in question are provided to help diagnose the problem as best as possible
- Issues to be discussed at the time of lodging the complaint:
  - Conditions of the seed storage
  - Some particulars on growing conditions

## Proptec Quality Claims

**Quality:** A quality claim may include suspected disease issue, suspected fertility issue, poor expansion of coir, or any additional quality issues

- Contact Highsun as soon as the problem becomes apparent.
- Time limits may apply:
  - Jiffy disc expansion: Up to 6 months from delivery date
  - Papertec Fertiliser and Media quality: Up to 2 months from delivery date
- We may request that photos and samples from the product in question are provided to help diagnose the problem as best as possible
- Issues to be discussed at the time of lodging the complaint:
  - Conditions of the storage area

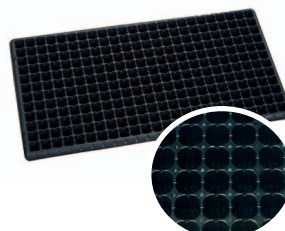

# Highsun Express Plugs & Seed - Terms and Conditions of Sale.

## Ordering:

Place all orders in writing, where possible order by email [info@highsun.com.au](mailto:info@highsun.com.au) or free fax 1800 644 015, stating product tray size, quantity and date required. A two week lead time from placement of order to seeding is required to ensure timely scheduling and planting of your order. You may change your order (in writing) up to the time of seed purchase.

## Minimum Seed Order Quantity:

The sum of the individual items must be equal to or greater than \$50 nett. Individual varieties are offered as a minimum nett \$20. Where the quantity ordered does not meet the minimum required, Highsun Express reserves the right to supply and charge for a greater quantity to meet the minimum stated.

## Deposits Confirmation:

In some cases, deposits will be required. e.g. custom seeding, new customers and large orders. Upon processing of your order, an "Order Confirmation" will be forwarded. Orders should not be taken as accepted unless an "Order Confirmation" is received, whereupon the terms and conditions of trade shall be deemed to have been accepted and understood. All information you will need when making an inquiry into an existing order will be found on the Order Confirmation. Due date is approximate only. Please allow for this when ordering.

## Order Cancellation:

You may cancel prior to the seed date only if the seed has NOT been purchased and only with the consent of the seller. Under no circumstances will cancellations be permitted after the seed date, as listed in the "Order Confirmation" has passed. An invoice will be raised for the amount as shown on the "Order Confirmation", once your plants are ready. **ALL CHANGES / CANCELLATIONS MUST BE IN WRITING.**

By customer request, Highsun will endeavour to "On Sell" plants on the customers behalf. **The customer will incur an "administrative fee" of 15% of all goods on sold for this service.**

## Substitutions:

Substitution could occur in the event of seed supply problems, **UNLESS WE ARE ADVISED OTHERWISE.**

## Shipping Information:

Freight is added to the invoice. We arrange shipment by air, road or rail. In some cases the customer is required to arrange pickup from the airport/depot to nursery. All shipments go forth at customer's risk.

## Seed Shipping Information:

Orders under \$400, freight will be added to the invoice. We will arrange shipment via Express Post. All shipments go forth at customer's risk.

## Seed Freight Liability:

Highsun Express accepts no responsibility for damage or delay following delivery to the original carrier. We will however, claim on the customers' behalf, the cost value of the damaged goods, provided Insurance has been taken out.

## Customers Responsibilities:

Respond within 24 hours to the call from the transport company to pick up the goods. It is a good precaution to contact the transport company if you have not heard from them within 48 hours of stock having left our company. In the event of a missing consignment, 1st contact should be made to your receiving depot, advising them of the consignment note number and date the goods left the nursery. Receive shipment and sign for it. Inspect shipment in carrier's presence; If damage is evident, contact Highsun Express within 24 hours.

## Highsun Express Responsibilities:

Your plants, seeds and propagation supplies will be packaged to the best of our ability to withstand handling and movements on regular transport routes to all major centres in Australia.

## Property & Risk:

Property in and title to the goods shall remain with Highsun Express which reserves the right to dispose of the goods until such time that all moneys owing by the Buyer to Highsun Express from time to time and at any time have been paid in full. The risk in the goods purchased shall, unless otherwise agreed in writing, pass to the Buyer immediately upon the goods leaving Highsun Express premises.

## Pick Up:

Orders may be picked up if you prefer. Please allow 24 hours lead-time.

## Pick Up hours are:
