Introduction

- Floriferous and colourful in shiny pink with big flowers.
- Very long lasting in flowering (all through the spring and summer!).
- Easily overgrowing finished flowers, thus avoiding the general carnation look of finished flowers.
- Possible to grow as an early spring crop, as a normal summer bedding plant or as an autumn product.

Use

Suntory® Dianthus can be used as spring, summer and autumn patio or garden plant.

Flowering characteristics

Will flower naturally in spring and in the greenhouse after getting sufficient time/temperature.

Earliness

All cultural measures for pot carnations are applicable.

Young Plants

Start with certified clean material from one of the official Moerheim New Plant dealers.

Plant medium

Use a good quality bedding plant mixture that can contain enough moisture and has a good structure. Substrate-pH should between 5.5 and 6.o.

Potting

Potsizes of 10-13 cm can do with one plug. Bigger pots should have more plugs per pot.

Climate

- Temperature: This crop can be grown cold and is also resistant to cold, growing temperatures are 10-15 °C.
- Air humidity: Not too moist, especially under cold conditions
- Light: In general it can have the maximum amount of light.
- CO2: Unknown, but probably will react positive to higher CO2 levels.

Watering

Water regularly. Be careful with watering, especially under cold conditions.

Fertilising

Water regularly with a well balanced mixture containing all the elements, including micro elements (including chelated iron).

Crop protection

We have not seen fungus or insect problems on the Suntory® Dianthus Pink.

- · Growing cold will avoid stretching
- We use the tank-mix of Alar 3 gr/L and Cycocel 0,75 cc/L

Growth regulation

This carnation can stretch a bit more than most pot carnations, so growth regulating can be necessary.

Transport

No special precautions, plants are rather compact and easy to transport.

Marketing

The selling season can be early spring, spring, summer and autumn. Strong plant with excellent garden performance!

LOFOS® LOPHOSPERMUM HYBRIDS



Introduction

- Ornamental value especially as annual trailing plant
- · Show of long elegant trailing stems.
- · Interesting big white, pink, red-pink flowers.
- Continuous flowering whole summer through.
- Waterwise; does not need a lot of water.
- New compact types have improved dense branching and more flowers.
- Especially suited for (mixing in) baskets and balcony boxes.

Plant family, origin, owner

Lofos® is the registered trademark of this vegetative propagated species. The latin name of this species is Lophospermum erubescens and it belongs to the family of the Scrophulariaceae. Various synonyms occur with the best known to be Asarina erubescens and Maurandya erubescens.

The plant originates from the Mexican mountains where it grows on an altitude of around 2.000 meters. In its habitat it is a climbing plant with preference to open spaces.

Owner of this variety is Suntory® Flowers Ltd from Japan and the European marketing and distribution is done by Moerheim New plant The Netherlands and their licensees.

Use

Lofos® is an elegant hanging basket plant. Use it in window or balcony boxes or use it as a vine against a wall or trellis. Depending on the climate Lofos® is a tender or a half hardy plant. It can grow well in the warmth but will also just continue to grow and flower in the cooler season. It is moderate in water use. It is never full of flowers but it always has flowers. Rain, warmth, cold or whatever cannot stop this plant from growing and flowering.

Plantmaterial

Start with certified material from your official Moerheim New Plant dealer.

Flowering characteristics

Likes warmth and light. Do not water excessive to avoid vegetative growth. Not useful to plant them early under cold temperature regime.

Plantmedium

Use a good bedding plant mixture. pH range 5,5-6.

Potting

Use any pot-size as from 10 cm to big basket pots.

Climate

- Temperature: Grow in warmer temperature regime (18-20 °C) for more speed, otherwise anything between 10 and 20 °C will do.
- Air humidity: it does not need a moist environment.

 Just grow it quite dry.
- Light: Basically the more light the better. It can have full sun in the greenhouse and will tolerate shade at the consumer's.
- CO2: unknown, but will probably react positive on higher levels.

Watering

Lofos® is moderate in the use of water. Especially in the small pot or basket the grower will have to control the water amount and grow it dry. Lofos® is a vigorous plant that you will have to control by giving little water. Over watering will result in a vigorous growing crop that will be difficult to handle, pack, transport and sell.

Fertilising

Feed it continuously with 1.5-2 grams per liter water= EC 1.5-2 mS. of a well balanced mixture that contains all the elements

Growth regulating

- Regulate the water.
- Use cold morning strategy.
- We use the Alar+Cycocel tankmix (3 grams+0,75cc) on weekly basis but something stronger is also advisable
- Give plants enough space.

Crop protection

We have not seen any fungus or insects (only occasional white fly, thrips) on this plant. In very early stages it can be attacked by Botrytis, just keep the topsoil quite dry and keep an eye on your climate not being too moist.

Growing schedule

Potting:

Pinching (once/more):

Take these as guidelines depending where and when your are growing; do not grow cold.

10-15 cm pots:

Roughly as from week 8
Few weeks after potting

Culture time: Roughly: 2-3 months
Harvest: As from week 18 and later

hanging baskets: A bit earlier

Few weeks after potting 2-3 months/more

Roughly grow it as a Surfinia® but Lofos® is slower=more in need of warmth and less branched. Trellis: possible to pot in autumn as usual as other trellis plants

Introduction

- New style Diascia hybrids.
- Beautiful product for the garden with many flower spikes.
- Continuous flowering and emergence of new shoots.

Flowering characteristics

Sundiascia® flowers easily but will generally have a longer cultivation period than most other annuals. Pinching is needed to develop good branching. Sundiascia® can overwinter in countries with mild winters.

Cuttings

Start with certified clean cuttings from an official Moerheim New Plant supplier.

Potting compost

Use a good-quality potting compost with sufficient air, good structure and a pH between 5.2 and 6.0.

Potting

All pot sizes are possible: from 10 to 27 cm. Use 3 cuttings for larger pots.

Climate

- Temperature: there is a wide range of temperatures, from 12-20 °C. Because Sundiascia® has perennial properties, it tolerates lower temperatures well. However, a low temperature does slow down its growth.
- Light: Sundiascia® grows better under better light conditions.

Watering

Avoid excessive water in cold and low light conditions.

Feeding

When watering, maintain an EC of 1-1.5 mS (= 1-1.5 g/l) using a well-balanced mixture containing all necessary nutrients. Add chelated iron.

Keeping the plants compact

Sundiascia® is more vigorous than normal Diascia types. In addition, Sundiascia® will produce more and longer flower spikes at consumer level. However, the grower will have to put effort into keeping the plant compact. This can be done using the following measures:

- Start with a compact and preferably pinched young plant.
- Use a negative DIF or cold morning strategy if necessary.
- When spraying growth regulators, a mixture of 0.75 ml of Cycocel + 2 g of Alar per litre can be used.
- · Do not over-water.
- Give plants enough space and keep the environment dry.

Crop protection

- Fungal diseases have not been observed in Sundiascia®.
- Pests: thrips, etc.


