### **Celebrating 45 Years**

Since our founding in 1972, we have continued to evolve to meet the ever changing needs of our community and our constituents. 2017 marked our first full year since our split from Sound Generations, and we forged a path forward with an emphasis on our local community needs.

### **Ensuring Financial Independence**

Our 2016 split from Sound Generations was finalized in November of 2017. Our new found independence means we have greater local control, but also a greater need for internal infrastructure. As we move into 2018, we'll be asking our donors to invest in our organization so the we can reach our financial and program goals.

### Attract And Retain Highest Quality Leadership

IFollowing an extensive search, we hired our first CEO. Brooke Knight joined our Northshore Senior Center team in September of 2017 and is making great strides in moving the organization forward. ### Innovate, Strengthen And Expand Programs

Over our 45 year history, our community's needs have evolved, and continue to change to meet them. Over the past year, we've partnered with Rock Steady Boxing to support individuals with Parkinson's Disease, and have secured funding from Evergreen Hospital to support a mental health professional.



# **Senior Centers**

With three senior centers serving the Northshore Region, our members can access programs and services at any of our locations. With a unique feel at each center, all three offer high quality programs designed to meet the needs of the local community.

### Mill Creek Senior Center

The Mill Creek Senior Center is the "university" of Mill Creek -- a place where older adults come to engage in lifelong learning with friends. At a new location since May of 2018, this beautiful space is well equipped to serve everyone in the local community.





### **Kenmore Senior Center**

Housed in Kenmore's beautiful Rhododendron Park, the Kenmore Senior Center is an intimate space often referred to as Northshore's "living room." Come by for a class, for tea or to just to chat with a small group of friends. Everyone is welcomed warmly.

### **Bothell Senior Center**

The largest of our three senior centers, our Bothell Senior Center is a vibrant community hub always buzzing with activity. From our lunch program, to our coffee bar, to our large space that can accommodate pickleball and other activities, there is something for everyone here.



# **Transportation**

In the Northshore community, transportation is a basic need. Without access to safe, reliable, efficient, and affordable transportation, older adults and people with disabilities may be unable to access medical care, groceries, or activities at our senior centers, which isolates these individuals and diminishes their quality of life.



Northshore Senior Center Transportation partners with King County Metro, WSDOT and other agencies to provide transportation options to our community. All Northshore Senior Center Transportation mini-buses are wheelchair lift equipped, and we hire, train and expect our drivers to live up to our transportation motto: Safety, Courtesy, Comfort.

"Since joining the Northshore Senior Center last spring I have come to appreciate the transportation department. I call 1-3 times a week for a ride. Each driver has been good-natured, kind and helpful. Rare to be off pick up times more than 5 minutes! I appreciate such outstanding service!! They are outstanding people."



# **Social Services and Wellness**

The Social Services and Wellness Programs provide education and training, information, resources, referral, and consultation to older adults and their families. Our staff is professionally trained in the fields of aging, mental health, physical health, and community resources. If you or someone you care about is experiencing difficulties – emotional, mental, physical, legal, or financial - we can connect you to helpful programs and services.

We are proud to offer several Evidence Based Programs to our community, meaning programs that have been evaluated as demonstrating significant positive impact on people who participate. We continue to look for ways to expand these services to meet the ever-changing needs of our community.

One 76-year old member was looking for ways to help improve her well-being. The retired psychologist lives with the limitations of peripheral neuropathy and the daily chronic pain it brings to her feet.

Northshore Senior Center's "Program to Encourage Active Rewarding Lives for Seniors," or PEARLS, caught her attention. The program gives seniors tools to improve their emotional well-being and address the symptoms of mild depression, which affects up to 20 percent of all older adults.

"I grew so much with this program. If you are trying to change something within yourself, it helps to have someone helping you along the way."

# **Adult Day Health**

Caring for someone who is frail or has a disability is a demanding job. Our center can provide caregivers with a much-deserved break, secure in the knowledge that family members are receiving excellent care.

We are a non-profit, state-approved Adult Day Health Program serving adults experiencing physical,



mental, or social problems associated with arthritis, diabetes, stroke, isolation, confusion, developmental disabilities, Alzheimer's disease, Parkinson's disease, and other conditions.

Based on individualized assessments, our interdisciplinary staff develops care plans to meet the specific needs of each participant. Participants join us for 5 hours per day and can attend up to 5 days a week, giving them the opportunity to meet new people, participate in challenging activities, and enjoy daily life in comforting surroundings. A nutritious lunch in a family-style setting is provided daily.

"My husband has a chance to be with others in a comfortable social setting. After his first month, when we was telling me about how he liked the day program, he added, "Nobody looks at me funny there." He has found a place of belonging and acceptance which the wider world no longer offers. Thank you so very much for your care of my dear husband over these past 2 years. Your welcoming smiles and acceptance provide him with something priceless—a chance to be accepted for who he is now. You also provide me with much needed relief from my caregiving duties, knowing he is in good hands."



# **Inclusion Program** (The "Wranglers")

Promoting "Fun For All", the Northshore Wranglers Inclusion Program provides inclusion, fun and friendships for individuals of all ages and abilities through year-round inclusion, recreation, skills and socialization opportunities, as well as advocacy and family support.

Founded in 1998 and serving Bothell, Woodinville, Kenmore and surrounding communities, programming is a non-profit service of the Health and Wellness Department operated by the Northshore Senior Center.




