Ice N' Roses Collection from HGC: The Snow Rose varieties from the Ice N' Roses® (Helleborus x glandorfensis) series owe their fascinating colors and robust nature to the fact that they are crosses between Snow Roses and Lenten Roses. More specifically, Ice N' Roses® is a cross between Helleborus x ericsmithii and a Lenten Rose (Helleborus x hybrida). Snow Roses and Lenten Roses were previously not considered to be crossable. The resulting varieties are extremely robust, long-lived and disease resistant. They thrive well even in sunny places and flower for an exceptionally long period of time with new blooms continuously replacing the aged ones. Some varieties of these Snow Roses start to flower as early as November. The beautiful large blooms are carried high above the leaves and look you right in the eye. Colors range from deep red, rose and white to bicolored varieties. The red varieties retain their color for a long time after they stop blooming.

Frostkiss® Hellebores are a unique group of hybrids that have both marbled foliage traditionally seen in *ericsmithii* types and rich colored blooms usually seen in *orientalis* types. Plant in filtered sun, full shade, partial shade, and partial sun. Keep soil lightly moist, but not soggy.

HELLEBORUS X LEMPERII - COLORFUL WINTER BLOOMERS: The new Helleborus x lemperii varieties from the Helleborus Gold Collection ® are a very special success for Helleborus breeding. They owe their colorful, particularly large flowers and the early flowering period to the cross between the spring rose (*Helleborus x hybridus*) and the classic Christmas rose (*Helleborus niger*). Just like Christmas roses and spring roses, the *Helleborus x lemperii* varieties also prefer a place in the light shade in the garden.

Helleborus x lemperii HGC® LEONA

The name Leona is derived from the Latin leo for "lion". It goes perfectly with this H. x lemperii variety, because the large, dark pink and upright-looking flowers stand gracefully on sturdy stems. Leona blooms from the beginning of December and accompanies us through the Christmas season until spring. Suitable companion plants are evergreen perennials and small conifers, which, like the compact Leona, feel comfortable in light shade. Striking large pink flowers on long stems add interest to the winter garden. CHRISTMAS ROSES (Helleborus niger) – THE QUEEN OF WINTER FLOWERERS: From November onwards, the first Christmas Rose varieties unfold their brilliant white flowers in the garden. Christmas Roses are one of the few plants that delight us with their flowers all winter long. Weather conditions allowing, they are also welcome honey plants for wild bees. Withstanding severe cold and snow, they decorate balconies and terraces as pot plants in winter.
