

## STRAPPY LEAF PLANTS

## Breeze® Dianella is a tidy, 'no cane' variety of *Dianella caerulea*.

• Common Dianella has tall, messy canes that fall. The Breeze® plant doesn't have above ground messy canes.

• Breeze® Dianella is a tough ground cover plant that is 40% larger than Little Jess™ Dianella. The Little Jess™ and Lucia™ plants are more drought tolerant than Breeze® Dianella. It also needs more nutrition in the soil compared to Little Jess™ and Lucia™ Dianella.

• It will discolour less than most *Dianella caerulea* types in winter in Canberra.

• It is very fast establishing and may need trimming after 1-3 years, then every 4-6 years after the first trimming.

• Its underground rhizomes spread well, filling out gaps and outcompeting weeds.

• Breeze® Dianella is good for erosion control and tolerates humidity, cold and is moderately drought tolerant.

• It needs adequate water through the summer months in WA and SA.



Description	Free flowing, dark green foliage
Density	4–6 plants per m² 2–3 per linear metre
Height & Width	60-70cm x 60-70cm
Flowering	Pale blue flowers from Sep-Nov
Best Planting Time	March-October
Uses	Mass planting, grassy gardens
Position	Full sun to part shade; tolerates humidity, cold & moderate drought
Soil Type	Most soils, except poor types lacking nutrition
Care	Trim or remove older leaves after 1–3 years, then every 4–6 years after the first trimming
Where it Works	NSW, ACT, QLD, VIC, SA & WA
