How to Unpack, Plant and Be Successful



IMPORTANT

Please unpack, remove all boxing, plastic bags and packaging so that the plant and its pot are the only remining parts. Place the plant upright in a partially shaded place and water immediately with cool water. Avoid full sun and water daily until you are ready to plant. Avoid any freezing temperatures with any parts of the plants parts.

Proper Planting

- 1. Remove the plastic container from the plant carefully and allow the plants roots and soil to soak in water for 5 minutes prior to planting. Do not pull the plant out of the pot hold the plant upside down and gently tapping to remove the pot.
- 2. Prepare the area to be planted by adding fresh potting soil that is a good quality product if you are using this plant as a container component. Moisten the soil before planting your Hort Couture plant. If you choose to plant this plant into the earth in a garden bed, you must amend the ground with organic material to create aeration, water retention and nutrients. If using as a landscape plant, add a light layer of mulch to the area after planting.
- 3. Dig a hole slightly deeper and twice as wide as the plant's root ball. Plant the plant so the top of the root ball is level or slightly elevated above the surrounding soil level. Do not bury the stem or plant parts below the soil. After getting the plant depth correct, add soil around the root ball at the same level and then gently press it to hold the plant but not so firm that the air is removed from the soil.
- 4. After planting, add a slow releasing organic-based fertilizer around the base of the root ball not touching the stem with the fertilizer. Water the entire soil space thoroughly with a water that is not hot. Providing your plant with adequate water, great soil and well-balanced nutrients will make it happy and prosper in your garden!
- 5. Check your plants daily for water needs. This is a living thing that requires food and water just like you do!

Successful Growing

This plant requires little pruning unless you discover broken or dead branches as the plant matures. It will benefit from routine watering and applications of liquid fertilizer or organic manure tea.

BLUE ZEBRA PRIMROSE is happiest in dappled shade In shade the plant will bloom well or grow to its full size.

There are no major pest that effect this plant and we suggest not applying any pesticides to the plant. If aphids of other insects seem to be damaging the plant, consult your local garden experts for possible treatments.

Freezing temperatures will not kill the plant. It is not an easy plant to bring in as a houseplant but can be overwintered in a covered greenhouse if available. In growing zones 6-8 it will be a perennial plant that can live for many years with proper drainage and care

This is NOT edible in any way. Do not eat this plant.
