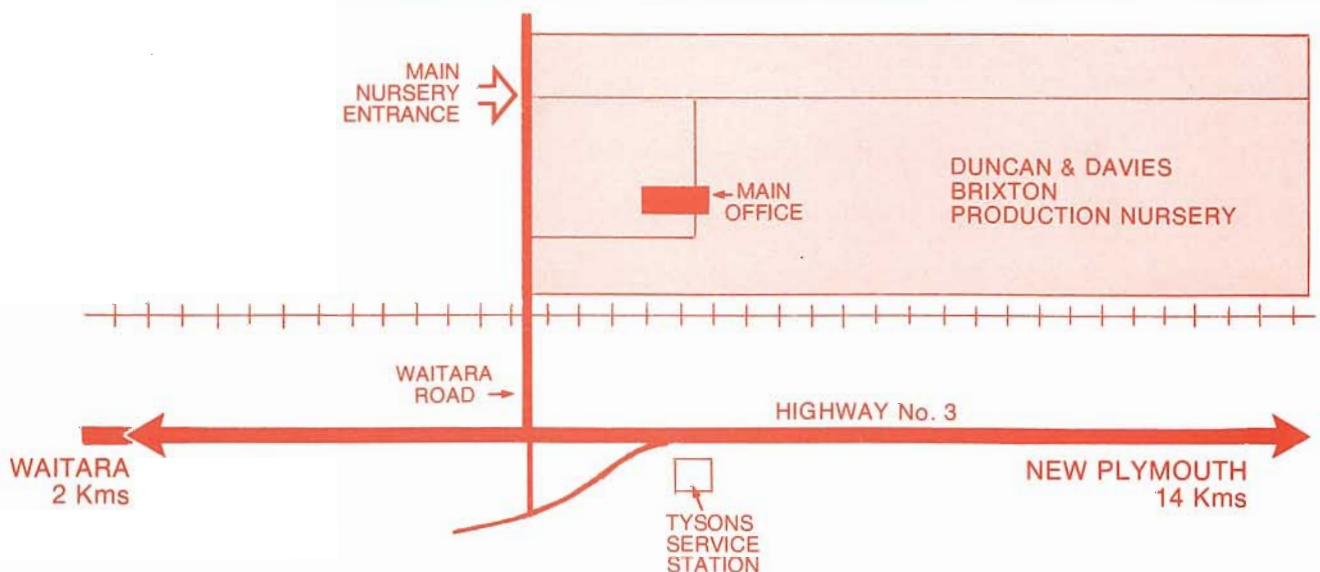

D & D HEDGING

For the farm, orchard, and country and city garden, hedging plants are of paramount importance in New Zealand. Wind being our greatest adversary, we need to protect our animals, crops and homes from these often present turbulent forces. Nothing adds more to the general neat appearance of your home and land than effective well chosen hedging.

BANKSIA INTEGRIFOLIA

A superb pyramidal fast growing ornamental evergreen tree. Marvellous foliage - leaves are shiny olive green with a silver reverse. Cones are tall and slim and bright lemon yellow, shining like candles among the foliage through the autumn/winter months.

Happy in a wide range of soil conditions as long as free draining, but performs superbly on light, free draining, sandy loam. Exceedingly wind hardy, resisting salt laden wind and drought conditions.

A first rate coastal shelter tree.

Will withstand temperatures up to -4°C , but avoid planting in areas subject to heavy and persistent frosts.

This tree will provide HIGH SHELTER UP TO 12m and can be effectively trimmed to 1.2m in width. Hedges of this calibre can be viewed on our nursery now.

Suggested planting stations dependent upon shelter required:
0.75m to 3.0m apart.

Plants are of superior quality - multi-trimmed and very bushy.

CASUARINA CUNNINGHAMIANA

A tall upright growing tree with pendula branching habit with long feathery evergreen foliage. Grows well in most soils and will effectively withstand damp root conditions. Hardy to wind and will tolerate some salt in the wind. Can withstand temperatures up to -4°C , but avoid planting in areas subject to heavy and persistent frost. CASUARINAS are specially affected by severe frosts when young and some protection may be required during such periods.

This tree will provide HIGH SHELTER UP TO 10m in height.

Suggested planting stations: 3m to 4m apart.

Hedges of this tree can be kept trimmed down to 2.5m in height.

Suggested planting stations: 0.50m to 1m apart.

CASUARINA GLAUCA

A stiffly pyramidal form with feathery evergreen foliage. Growing and climatic conditions are the same as for CASUARINA CUNNINGHAMIANA except that CASUARINA GLAUCA will stand more salt in the wind and even the soil water.

The biggest and best grade plants.

CRYPTOMERIA JAPONICA

A tall growing pyramidal conifer with dark green foliage that colours russet brown and purple in winter. Makes a large and effective hardy wind shelter.

Very cold and wind resistant. Grows well under most soil conditions.

This tree will provide HIGH SHELTER UP TO 20m in height.

Suggested planting stations: 2.5m to 4m apart.

A superior grade in size, shape and root content.

CUPRESSOCYPARIS LEYLANDII CASTLEWELLAN GOLD

A little slower in growth than for LEIGHTON GREEN and NAYLOR'S BLUE, but still fast when compared with other conifer shelter. Bright lemon-gold foliage throughout the year, makes this a stand-out hedging on farm, orchard or garden. Try installing this hedge within view of your home and incorporate beauty and utility.

Very cold resistant and wind hardy, but some care may be required when exposing to salt winds. Grows well under most soil conditions, but cannot stand wet feet for any length of time.

This tree will provide HIGH SHELTER UP TO 15m in height.
Suggested planting stations: 2.5m to 4m apart.

A very suitable ornamental plant for the city garden scene.

Hedges of this tree can be kept trimmed down to 2.5m in height.
Suggested planting stations: 0.75m to 2m apart.

CUPRESSOCYPARIS LEYLANDII LEIGHTON GREEN

This tree is a bi-generic hybrid between CUPRESSUS MACROCARPA X CHAMAECYPARIS NOOTKATENSIS.

The LEYLAND CYPRESS is a very fast and vigorous growing conifer.

LEIGHTON GREEN (Clone II) forms a tall dense column of green foliage that forms a most effective wind shelter screen. Hardy to frost, cold and wind, and is tolerant to salt winds. Grows well under almost all soil conditions, but cannot stand wet feet for any length of time.

This tree will provide HIGH SHELTER UP TO 20m in height.
Suggested planting stations: 2.5m to 5m apart.

Hedges of this tree can be kept trimmed down to 2.5m in height.
Suggested planting stations: 0.75m to 2m apart.

CUPRESSOCYPARIS LEYLANDII NAYLOR'S BLUE

Fast and vigorous growing, pyramidal in form with a graceful pendulous branching habit, most notably blue in winter.

Growing conditions as for other clones mentioned.

Height and planting stations: as for LEIGHTON GREEN.

FEIJOA MAGNIFICA (seedlings)

Makes an excellent ornamental and useful low to medium high hedge, thriving well in any reasonable quality soil, having good drainage. Will stand up fairly well to wind and once established will easily withstand temperatures of -5°C .

We offer seedlings raised from a selected large and heavy fruiting form and could be usefully employed to cross pollinate with named varieties.

Will grow to approximately 4m in height, dependent upon soil and climatic conditions.

Suggested planting stations: 1m to 2.5m apart.

Very bushy strong plants.

POPULUS FLEVO

This very fast growing upright pyramidal shaped POPLAR has quickly proven itself to be a good hedge and shelter tree, and the demand has risen rapidly since its introduction some years ago.

Very wide, heart-shaped, leathery, dark green coloured leaves on long stalks, ideal foliage for filtering wind and effectively breaking the wind force, but at the same time allowing the air to flow and filter. We can say, at the present time this clone appears to be rust resistant.

This tree will provide HIGH SHELTER UP TO 15m in height.

Suggested planting stations: 1m to 3m apart.

POPULUS TRICHOCARPA

A native POPLAR of western North America, prolific in British Columbia, Washington and Oregon, and known there as the Black Cottonwood. POPULUS TRICHOCARPA is undoubtedly the finest of the balsam poplars and may be said to be the best of all the poplars. Coming from the Pacific North-West it is well adapted to our oceanic climate and can be expected to perform highly under our climatic and soil conditions. It is extremely tolerant to both excessively acid or alkaline type soils, but performs to optimum under slightly above neutral pH.

A tall, fast growing tree with a handsome slender, pyramidal habit and smooth grey bark. Big, broad, wedge-shaped leaves becoming pointed

from the wide base, and can be up to 25cms in length on the vigorous fast growing leading shoots. However, leaves tend to become smaller and more heart-shaped on older lateral twigs. Displays good leaf colour - dark lustrous green above and silvery-white beneath, making this tree look very ornamental in the landscape. As the leaves unfold in spring, they give off the delicious fragrance associated with all the balsam type poplars. We can say, at the present time this clone appears to be rust resistant.

A fine new POPLAR, with tremendous hedge and shelter potential in New Zealand.

This tree will provide HIGH SHELTER UP TO 15m in height.

Suggested planting stations: 1m to 3m apart.

SALIX MATSUDANA X ALBA Clone 1002

Now named SALIX MATSUDANA AOKAUTERE.

A hybrid WILLOW and new to the hedge and shelter scene, and presently receiving some good notices in the Waikato area. This fast growing willow makes an elegant looking tree of tall conical habit with slender branches, drooping at the tips. Long, narrow, pointed leaves densely crowd the upright branches and the blue-green silvery colour provides a landscape feature. This will undoubtedly be a much sought after hedge and shelter tree in the years to come.

This tree will provide HIGH SHELTER UP TO 12m in height.

Suggested planting stations: 2.5m to 6m apart.

Hedges of this tree can be kept trimmed down to 3m in height.

Suggested planting stations: 0.5m to 1.5m apart.

SALIX MATSUDANA

Known as the PEKIN WILLOW, makes a medium sized fast growing tree of pyramidal habit with upright slender stems and dense long narrow slender pointed leaves. This tree is suitable for most soil conditions growing well anywhere in NZ and of course doing particularly well in wet or damp conditions. Hardy to all cold, frost and wind, and will tolerate salt winds to some extent. A well proven hedge and shelter tree for NZ conditions.

This tree will provide HIGH SHELTER UP TO 12m in height.

Suggested planting stations: 2.5m to 6m apart.

Hedges of this tree can be kept trimmed down to 3m in height.

Suggested planting stations: 0.5m to 1.5m apart.
