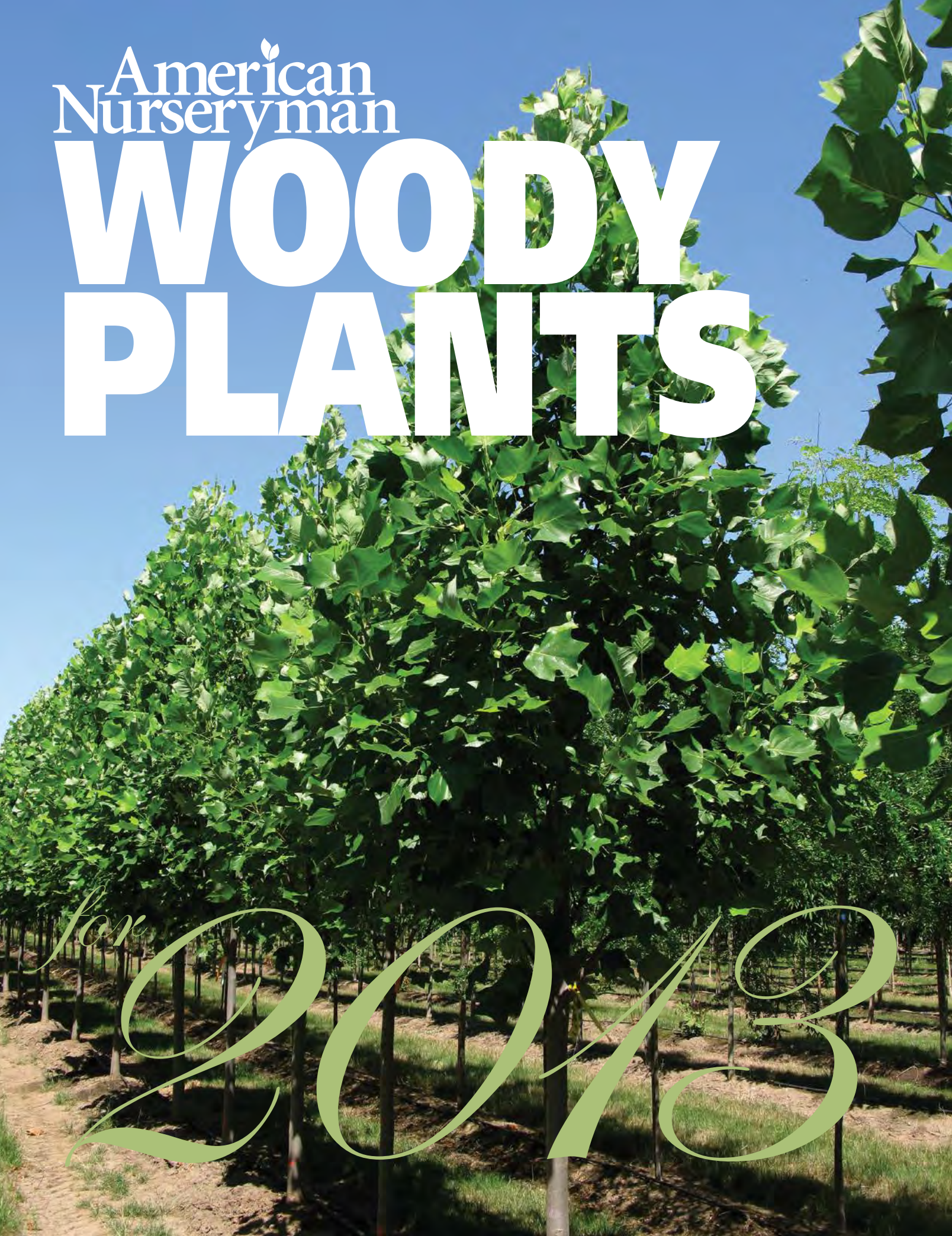

Common name: Forever Red mountain laurel

Trademark: Not applicable

Introduced by: Richard A. Jaynes, Broken Arrow Nursery, Hamden, Conn.

Hardiness: Zones 5 to 8

Ornamental features: An exciting new selection of mountain laurel that showcases intense red flower buds backed by deep green, glossy foliage; the flower buds develop approximately a week later than the straight species and never fully open; since the buds never open the pollination/fertilization process doesn't progress normally and no stimulus is generated to trigger the flowers to senesce; as a result, the flower buds persist and remain ornamentally attractive far longer than other standard forms. It is not uncommon for this breakthrough selection to display color into early July, far beyond the typical bloom period for the species

Habit and growth rate: 2.5 feet tall and wide in 10 years

Culture: Same as straight species

Pest/disease problems or unique resistance: Same as straight species

Rubus cockburniana 'Razzle Dazzle'

***Rubus cockburniana* 'Razzle Dazzle'**

Common name: Razzle Dazzle ghost bramble

Trademark: Not applicable

Introduced by: Broken Arrow Nursery, Hamden, Conn.

Hardiness: Zones 5 to 9

Ornamental features: A vigorous, ornamental raspberry discovered as a chance branch sport; plants showcase delicate, dissected, blue-green, fern-like leaves that are prominently highlighted with showy pink, cream and gold variegation; the foliage resists sun scald and scorch and remains colorful throughout the growing season; a graceful, fountain-like habit of arching, white canes and small purple flowers provide added seasonal interest

Habit and growth rate: 4 feet tall by 6 feet wide in 10 years; fast-growing with an arching framework

Culture: Full sun; rich, well-drained soil; annual coppicing is recommended to maintain form and to encourage best stem coloration

Pest/disease problems or unique resistance: Same as straight species

***Stewartia rostrata* 'Pink Satin'**

Common name: Pink Satin beaked stewartia

Trademark: Not applicable

Introduced by: Broken Arrow Nursery, Hamden, Conn.

Hardiness: Zones 6 to 8

Ornamental features: A small specimen tree or large stature, upright shrub showcasing pale, shell pink flowers backed by a ring of burgundy-purple bracts; flowering commences in mid-May in Connecticut and continues for a 2 to 3 week period; each blossom is approximately 1.5 inches in diameter with pigment coloration that radiates throughout each petal. Large, 1-inch immature fruits add ornamental appeal with a rich, pinkish-red blush that stands apart from the glossy green foliage; new growth emerges in spring with a burgundy overtone and develops attractive scarlet tones in autumn; plants are well formed, developing a distinctive pyramidal canopy when young and averaging 6 to 12 inches of growth annually

Habit and growth rate: 13 feet tall by 6 feet wide in 13 years; pyramidal growth form

Culture: Full sun to part shade; rich, well-drained soil

Pest/disease problems or unique resistance: Same as straight species

Royalties: Not applicable

***Acer saccharum* 'Morton'**

Common name: Sugar maple **Trademark:** Crescendo™

Introduced by: Chicagoland Grows® Inc., Glencoe, Ill.

Hardiness: Zones 5 to 7

Ornamental features: The thick and durable foliage is dark green all summer, and reliably turns to a brilliant orange-red every autumn; an attractive tree with a uniform oval habit

Habit and growth rate: A uniformly branched deciduous tree with a broadly oval habit; a more attractive and uniform habit compared to many other sugar maples; grows to 20 to 25 feet in height with a 15- to 20-foot spread in 10 to 15 years; mature size will approach 40 to 45 feet tall and 30 to 35 feet wide; moderate growth rate

Culture: Grows best in full sun on a moderately moist, rich, well-drained acidic to slightly alkaline soil; tolerant of heat and drought once established; more drought-tolerant than many Midwestern grown sugar maple selections; like most sugar maples, do not use on sites with compacted or restricted soils, or in areas with significant salt spray or run-off

Pest/disease problems or unique resistance: Notable heat and drought tolerance; like other sugar maples, it does not tolerate compacted soils, areas with high air pollution or significant salt spray or run-off; no significant disease or pest problems

***Syringa pekinensis* 'Zhang Zniming'**

Common name: Peking tree lilac

Trademark: Beijing Gold™

Introduced by: Chicagoland Grows® Inc., Glencoe, Ill.

Hardiness: Zones 4 to 7

Ornamental features: This selection exhibits multiple seasons of interest, from its panicles of fragrant, primrose-yellow flowers in early summer to its dark green foliage that can turn an eye-catching yellow in autumn. The ornamental, cherry-like cinnamon-colored bark is attractive year-around; an upright habit and finer branches than most tree lilacs completes the package

Habit and growth rate: A deciduous small tree to large shrub, this selection can be grown either single- or multi-stemmed; more upright in habit and less coarsely branched than most tree lilacs; grows to 20 feet in height with a 15-foot spread; moderate growth rate of around 1 foot per year

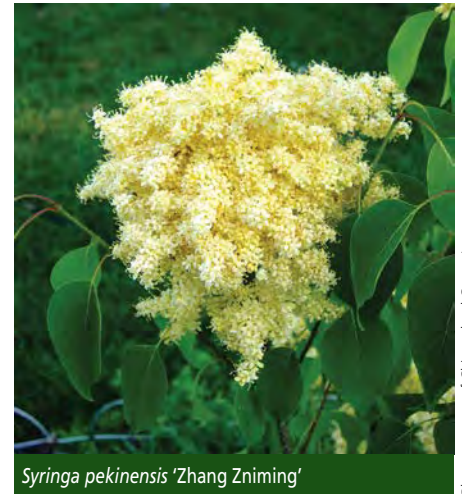
Culture: Best grown in full sun on a well-drained, reasonably moist soil, which can be acidic to alkaline; drought-tolerant once established; prune if necessary immediately after blooming. Since it has a better branching habit than most tree lilacs, there is less of a need for corrective shape pruning

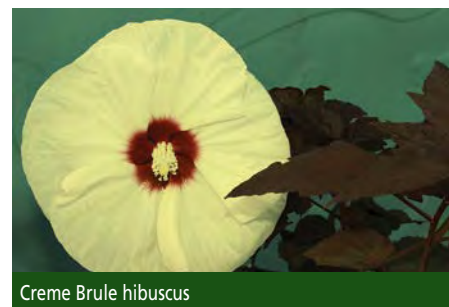

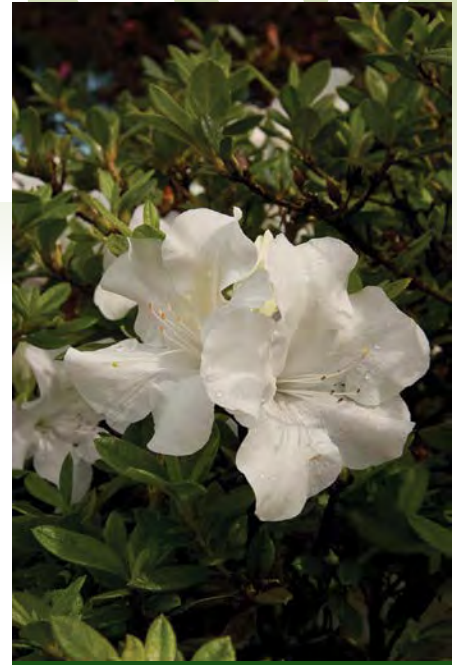

Habit and growth rate: Bushes are low-growing and compact, with dense flowers and foliage; mature height 23 to 31 inches; mature width 40 inches

Culture: For best blooms, grow in full sun (grows well in partial shade: 4 to 5 hours/day, with fewer blooms); in areas of intense sun/heat, provide semi-shade/filtered light. Best performance when soils are well-drained/friable with added organic matter but can thrive in a variety of soils. Tolerant of dry conditions when established (water in well till established in hot conditions)

Pest/disease problems or unique resistance: Very tolerant of common rose blights like black spot and mildew; requires no routine chemical spraying in the landscape
