Vegetables



Endive Batavian, broad leaved Nuance



Nuance forms attractively compact heads with yellow heart. Suitable for early and late green-house cultivation and outdoors in summer. Suitable for early and late cultivation.



Turnip-tops



A vitamin rich spring leaf vegetable. More robust version of leaf vegetables and closely related to turnip tops. Sow thinly in lines in the garden from March to May. Do not thin out.



Celery, green Green Sleeves



Green stalks without string, which can be eaten raw and cooked. Crispier, less fibrous and more aromatic in flavour than the self-blanching varieties.



Endive Batavian Avantgarde



It is not very susceptible to rotting and so ideal for cultivating in the garden in the autumn and in a greenhouse early in the winter. Produces a firm, but juicy leaf.



Swede, Turnip Salad, green



Turnip tops are actually the young plants of turnips that have been sown close together. Of all the spring vegetables it is one that can be harvested the earliest.



Celery, Golden Self Blanching 2



Yellow-green stalks without string which can be eaten raw as well as cooked. Can be eaten raw and cooked. Celery has diuretic powers, is low in calories and very rich in vitamins.



Endive Batavian, broad leaved "Vijf 2"



Broad-leaved variety, large heads with a yellow heart. Suitable for cultivation in greenhouses and in gardens, in spring as well as in autumn. Tasty and vitamin-rich crop.





Eminence quickly forms exceptionally large, attractively compact heads. Good resistance to running to seed. Attractive yellow heart. Eminence is very winter hardy.



Leaf Chicory, Self-closing



Self-closing heads approx. 30 cm tall. With outer leaves the heads can be kept for several weeks in a cool storage place. Popular with amateur



Winter Purslane Miner's Lettuce, Cuban Spinach



Delicious and healthy addition to sandwiches, and salads. Contains plenty of vitamin C. Sow preferably in a greenhouse on account of the leaves turning red.



Brussels Witloof Atlas F1



Cultivation without casing soil from September to March. Sow on well worked soil. Thin out upon emergence. Harvest roots in late August. Forcing duration at 16°C is 4 to 5 weeks.
